Sub: Diversion of 41.05 ha. of forest land closed under section 4 & 5 of PLPA 1900 in favour of Head-Administration, Translational Health Science and Technology Institute, NCR-Biotech Science Cluster, Faridabad for setting up of Translation Research Teaching & Training in Biotechnology & Animal Research Laboratory, along Gurugram-Faridabad road, at village Bhankri Under Forest Division & Distt. Faridabad, Haryana.

On the subject mentioned above, the consolidated statement stating status of compliance to each condition stipulated in the in-principle approval accorded for diversion of above forest land by the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change is as follows:-

i.	Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.	Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.
ii.	The DGPS map of the area proposed for diversion and CA areas will be submitted before stage-II approval.	The DGPS map of the area proposed for diversion duly signed by user agency and DGP map of CA areas duly signed by DFO, Mahendergarh are enclosed herewith.
iii.	The Compensatory Afforestation shall be done over double degraded forest land to the forest area proposed to be diverted within a period of three years with effect from the date of the issue of Stage-II clearance and maintained thereafter in accordance with the approved plan in consultation with the State Forest Department at the cost of the user agency. At least 1000 saplings per hectares shall be planted over 96.618 ha. (96618 plants);	The compensatory afforestation will be done over degraded forest land, double the extent to the forest land being diverted, in RF Kanti, RF Mukundpura, RF Salimabad and RF Sohla under Forest Division Mahendergarh.


iv.	The User Agency shall provide additionally 25% of the CA cost towards Soil and Moisture Conservation measures in the proposed CA area as per site requirement and the said amount may be deposited in the account of Ad-hoc CAMPA of the concerned State through online e-portal only;	The Cost towards Soil and Moisture Conservation of Rs. 25256095/- has been deposited by user agency through challan generated online web portal.
v.	The land identified for the purpose of CA shall be clearly depicted on a Survey of India toposheet of 1:50,000 scale;	Toposheets indicating proposed CA sites duly signed by DFO Mahendergarh are enclosed herewith.
vi.	The User Agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory afforestation at the current wage rate in consultation with State Forest Department in the account of Ad-hoc CAMPA of the concerned State through online portal. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years;	The cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory afforestation of (Rs. CA : 84186982 + ACA :13533680) Total Rs. 97720662/- has been deposited by user agency through challan generated online web portal.
vii.	The User Agency shall transfer online, the Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted under this proposal, as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in Writ petition (Civil) No. 202/1995 and the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide its letter No. 5-3/2007-FC dated 05.02.2009. The requisite funds shall be transferred through online portal into Ad-hoc CAMPA account of the State Concerned;	Amount of Net Present Value (NPV) of Forest land being diverted of Rs. 36411350/- has been deposited by user agency through challan generated online, as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in Writ petition (Civil) No. 202/1995 and the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide its letter No. 5-3/2007-FC dated 05.02.2009.
viii.	The user agency should ensure that the compensatory levies (CA cost, NPV etc.) are deposited through challan generated online on web portal and deposited in appropriate bank online only. Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of the Stage-I clearance;	Total amount of Rs. 159475058/- (CA, ACA, SMC, Felling, NPV etc) has been deposited by user agency through challan generated online web portal.
ix.	At the time of payment on the Net Present Value (NPV) at the then prevailing rate, the USER Agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India;	An undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV has already been furnished by the User agency.
x.	The User agency shall obtain the Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if required;	The user agency has written that, in this regard action will be taken separately after the stage - II approval.


xi.	Layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government;	The user agency has written that instructions will be followed.
xii.	No construction of Buildings/labour camps/huts shall be allowed on the forest land;	The user agency has written that instructions will be followed.
xiii.	The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal and under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person;	The user agency has written that instructions will be followed.
xiv.	Any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department;	The user agency has written that instructions will be followed.
xv.	State Government shall complete settlement of rights, in terms of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006, if any, on the forest land to be diverted and submit the documentary evidence as prescribed by this Ministry in its letter No. 11-9/1998-FC(pt.) dated 03.08.2009 read with 05.07.2013 in support thereof;	Compliance of Schedule Tribes and other traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 issued by Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad has already been submitted with the proposal.
xvi.	The user agency shall provide alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas;	The user agency has written that instructions will be followed.
xvii.	Boundary of the forest land proposed to be diverted shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, forward and back bearing, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS co-ordinates;	The user agency has written that instructions will be followed.
xviii.	Any other condition that the concerned Regional Office of this Ministry may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests and wildlife;	The user agency has written that instructions will be followed.
xix.	The user agency shall submit the annual self-compliance report in respect of the above conditions to the State Government, concerned Regional Office and this Ministry by the end of March of every year regularly; and	The user agency has written that instructions will be followed.

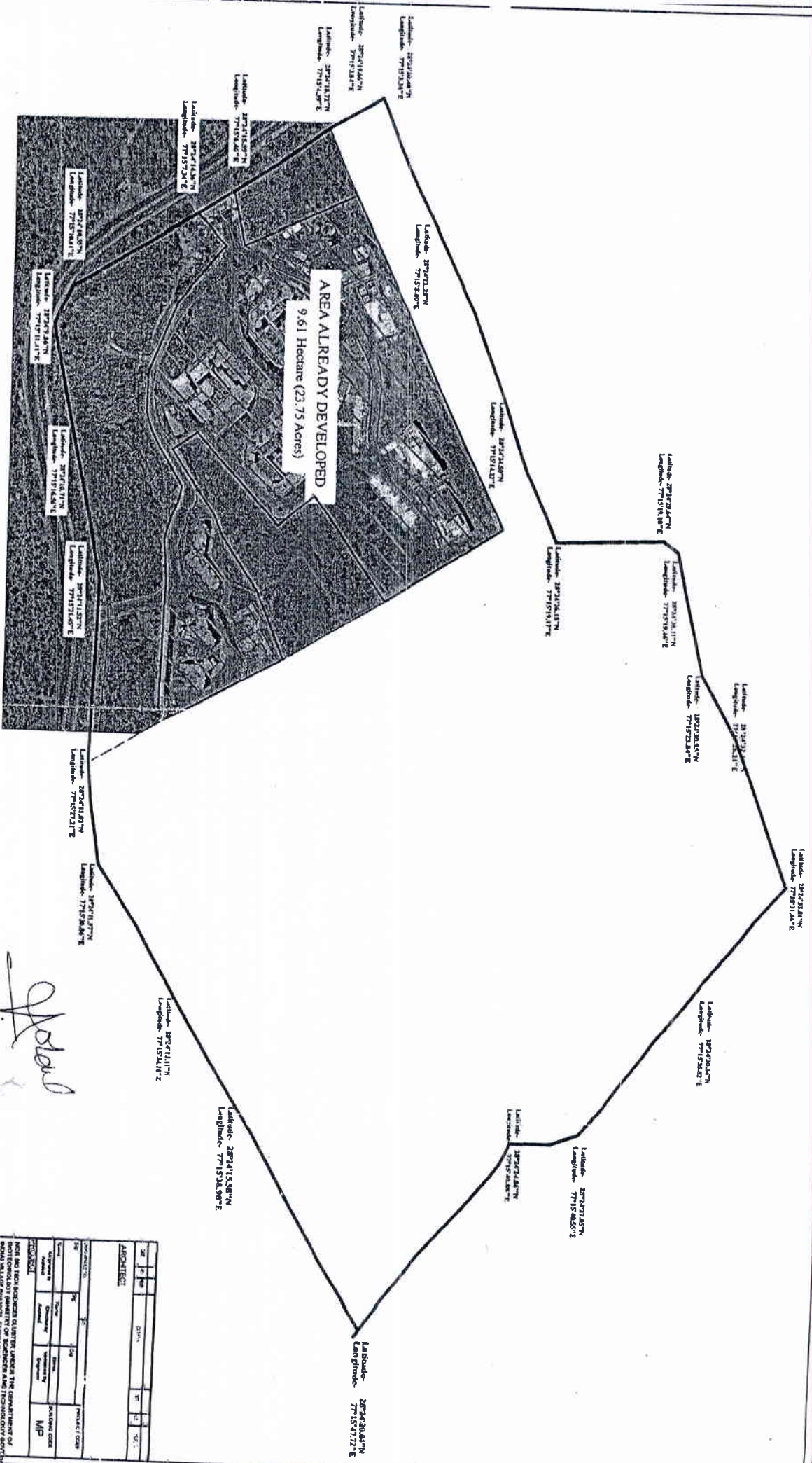

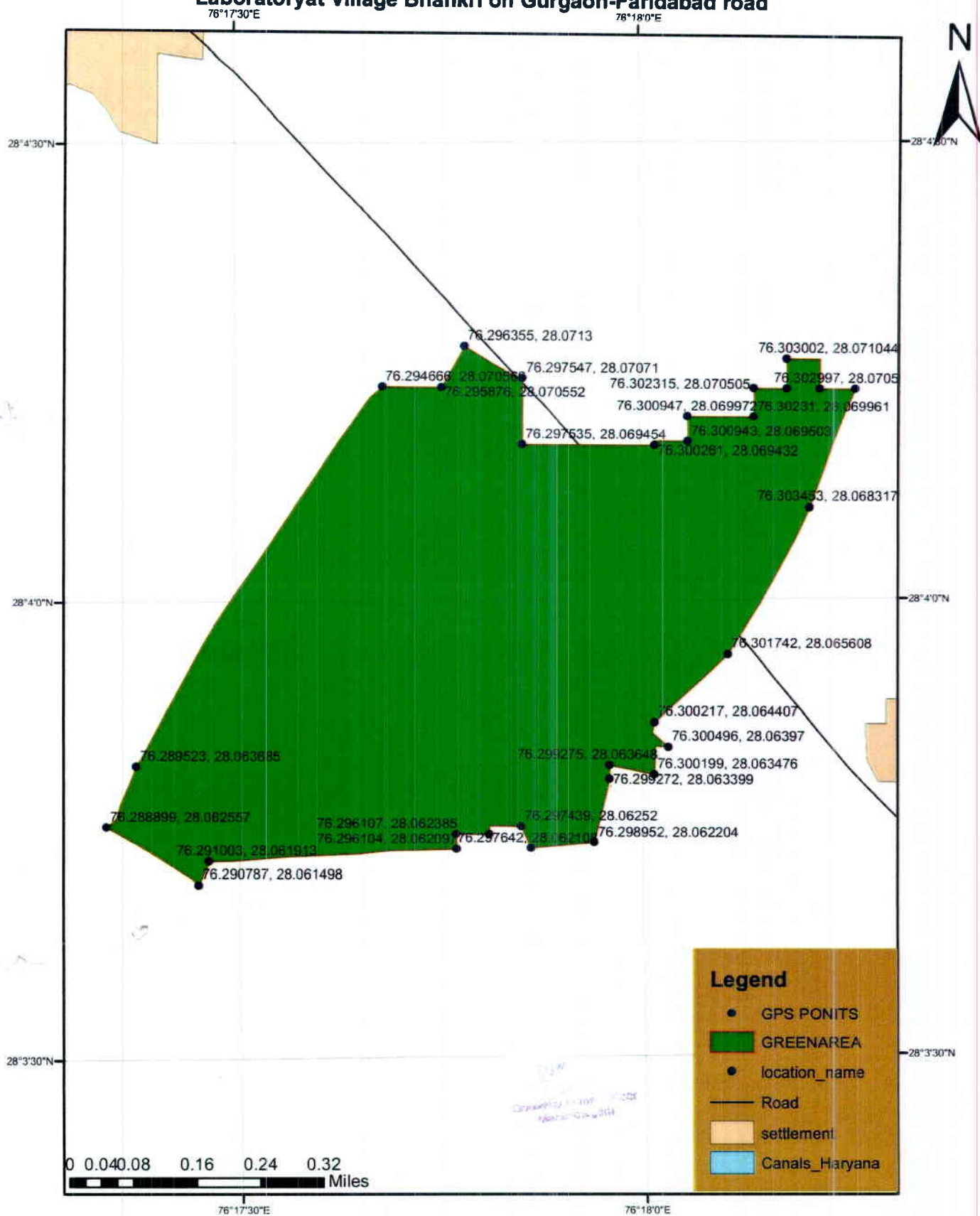

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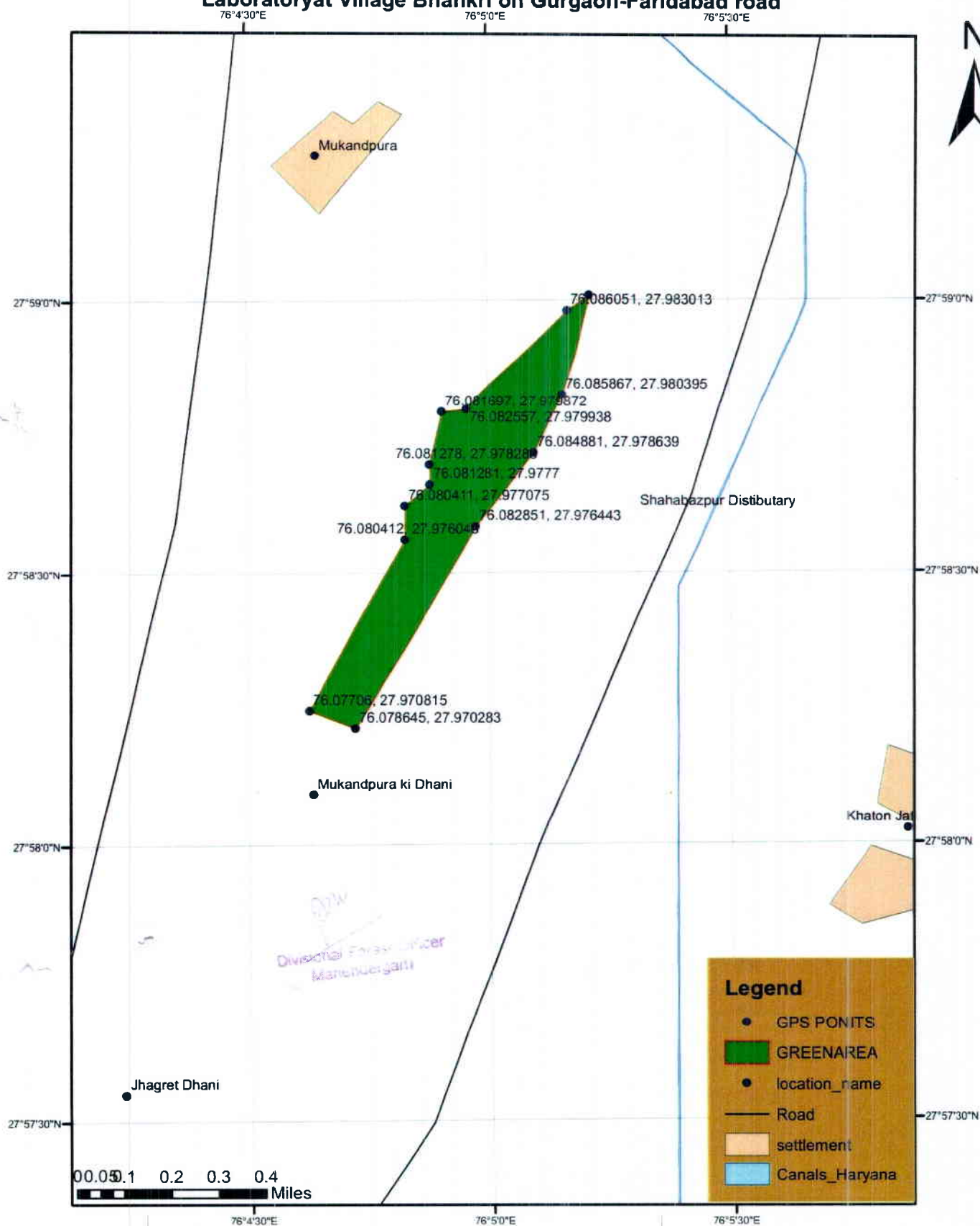
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PROJECT TITLE DOPE MAP SITE LAYOUT PLAN R1		DATE 2002

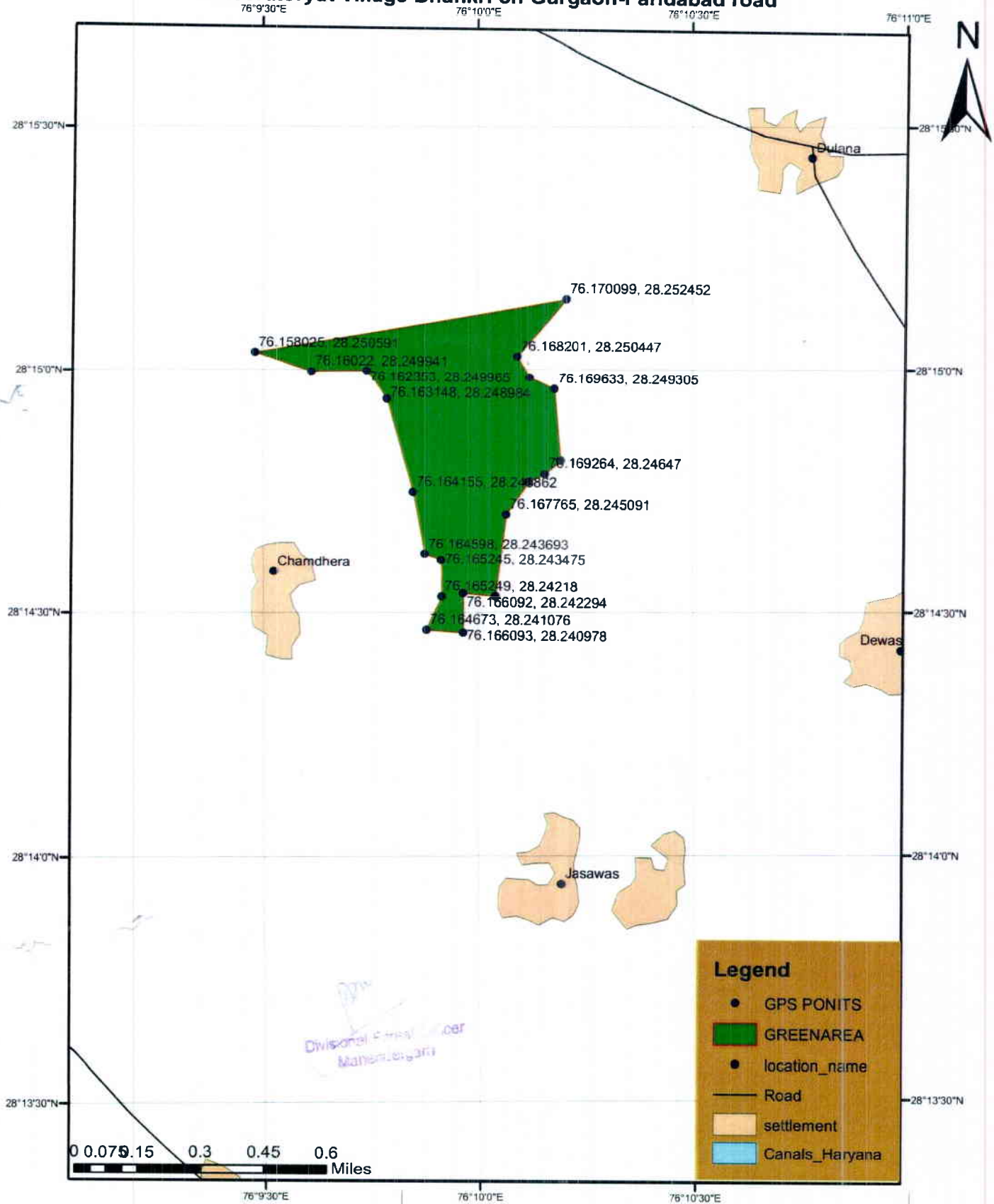

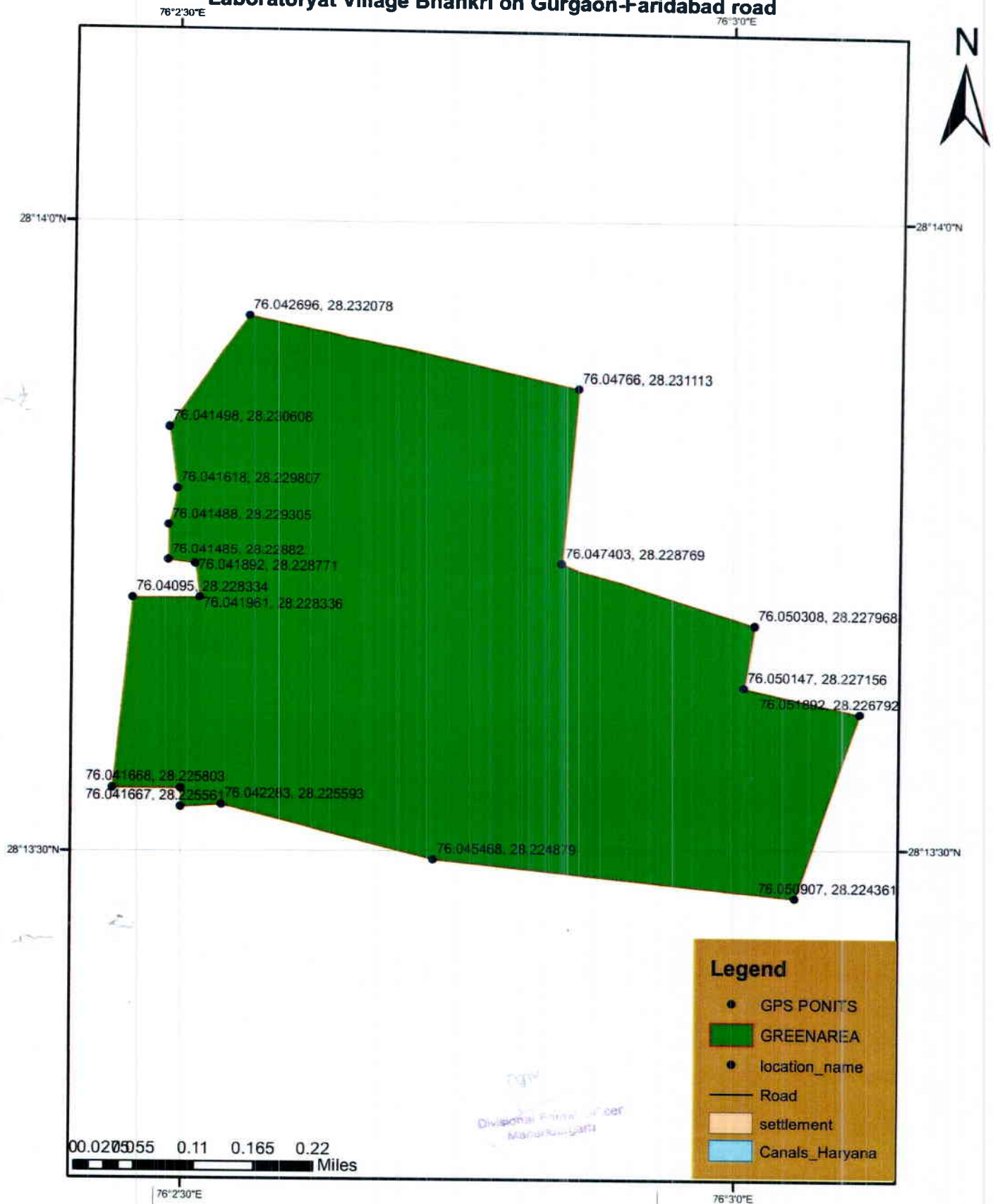
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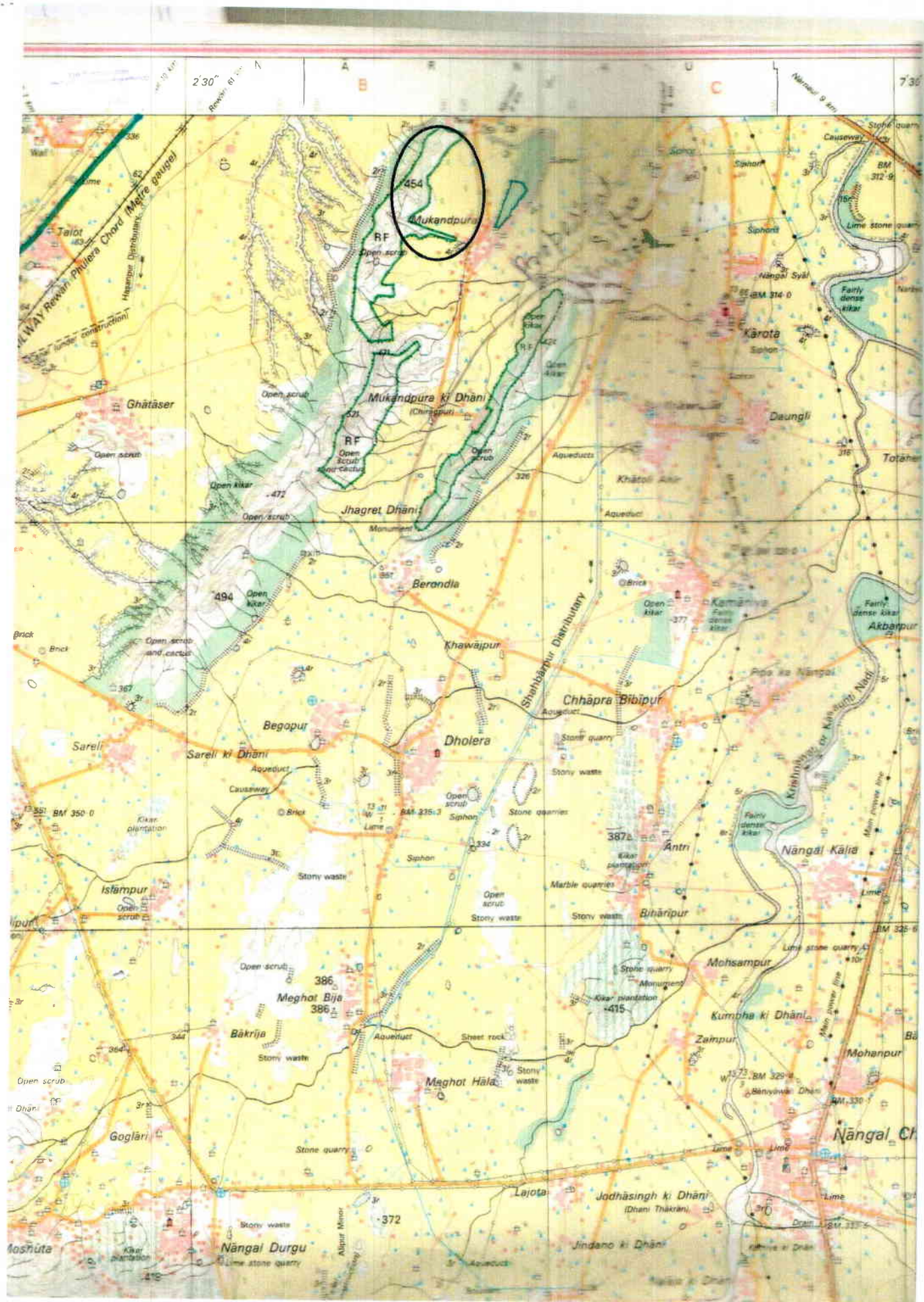
