Special Secretary to Govt. vide letter under reference (i) has observed three conditions out of which condition No. (ii) is read as follows:

"(ii) Mining lease has been granted by erstwhile Mining and Geology Department vide Proceeding No.9054 dt. 5.7.1979 and lease deed has been executed on 25.4.1981. Since the ML area is entirely forest land, execution of lease deed without prior permission of GoI, MoEF under Forest Conservation Act, 1980 is a violation of the Act. Copy of ML grant order dt.5.7.1979 may be furnished. The application of OMC Ltd. filing 1st RML application dt. 8.4.2001 may also be furnished. Since the 1st RML application is reportedly filed on 8.4.2001 i.e. not more than one year prior to expiry of original ML period, it may be indicated if the Steel & Mines Department have condemned the delay in filing 1st RML application. Also present status of disposal of 1st RML application as per MMDR Amendment Act, 2015, if any shall be furnished."

OMC vide letter under reference (ii) had complied all the observations through DFO, Keonjhar. APCCF (N) vide letter under reference (iii) has asked to furnish complete compliance particularly in respect to point no.(ii). In this regard the following are submitted for necessary recommendation to APCCF (N):

1. Copy of the ML grant order dt 05.07.1979 is enclosed.
2. The copy of the 1st RML application filed by OMC on dt 18.04.2000 over 78.711 ha is enclosed.

3. The statement that "*The application of OMC Ltd. filing 1st RML application dt. 8.4.2001 may also be furnished*" is not correct.
4. Since OMC has filed application on dt 18.04.2000 as indicated at Sl.No.2 above, which is one year prior to expiry of the original ML period, the question of delay in filing 1st RML application does not arise. Hence there is no need for Steel & Mines Department to condemn the delay.
5. As per the MMDR Amendment Ordinance, 2015, the lease period stands extended vide Govt. of India F. No. 1/2/2015-M.VI dt.06.02.2015, till 31.03.2020.

It is requested to kindly forward the above compliance to APCCF (N) through RCCF, Rourkela for onward submission to the State Government for necessary approval.
