i) A copy of the Record of Rights are attached.

- ii) Map indicating boundary and adjoining land use in suitable scale is not attached. However, geo-referenced (Digital GPS Map) boundary in shape file has submitted by the User Agency.
- iii) Form A containing part I, II III and IV u/s 6 of the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003 is enclosed with the proposal.
- iv) Site Inspection Reports: -
 - a) Joint Site Inspection Reports (JSIR – I) of Circle Officer of the District Administration and Forester from Forest Department are enclosed with the proposal on page no.
 - b) Joint Site Inspection Reports (JSIR – II) of Tahsildar Saoner and Range Forest Officer khapa and Kalmeshwar for 5% of the forest land (Zudpi Jungle) proposed for diversion are enclosed on page no. --- to ---- for the following area:
 - 1. Village – Rampuri, Taluka saoner Dist. Nagpur Area – 1.62 ha.).
 - 2. Village - Chatrapur, Taluka saoner Dist. Nagpur (Area – 0.96 ha.).
 - v) The certificate of Collector under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 are attached and the copies of Gram Sabha / Ward Committee Resolutions are attached.

- 3) Density of forest is 0.1 and Eco class value III. Southern tropical dry deciduous forests as per Site Inspection Report of Deputy Conservator Forests, Nagpur Forest Division Nagpur.
- 4) Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nagpur Forest Division and Chief Conservator of Forests (T) Nagpur Circle have recommended the proposal for diversion of 60.40 ha. Zudpi Jungle land of 42 villages in saoner City Taluka, Dist. Nagpur under Category-II {Encroachment (excluding commercial purpose) prior to 12/12/1996 using simplified procedure} in consolidated form under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
- 5) Deputy Conservator of forest Nagpur Forest Division, Nagpur has certified that the proposed project is within 10 km (Badegaon, Chorkhairy, Hingna, Kirnapur, Maherkund, Pendhari, Ramdongri) & rest of villages are beyond 10 km from the boundary of Protected Area. (Sanctuary and National Park).
- 6) The map showing distance if these villages from Eco-sensitive zone of these sanctuary is attached.
- 7) There are 690 trees in the area are standing in proposed area for diversion in Nagpur Forest Division, Nagpur; girth & class wise abstract is as follows:-

Thereby a total of 690 trees are enlisted in the 40 villages.

- 8) Site inspection report of The Chief Conservator of Forests (T), Nagpur Circle, Nagpur and Deputy Conservator of Forest, Nagpur Division, Nagpur is enclosed.
- 9) The Deputy Conservator of Forest, Nagpur Division, Nagpur have certified that no suitable alternate land is available and the zudpi forest land required is the barest minimum.
- 10) There is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980, as certified by The Deputy Conservator of Forest, Nagpur Division, Nagpur.
- 11) The proposed area involved in the project does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Nature Reserve etc as certified by The Deputy Conservator of Forest, Nagpur Division, Nagpur.
- 12) The Deputy Conservator of Forest, Nagpur Division, Nagpur has certified that there is no cutting and felling of trees involved in the project.
- 13) The Deputy Conservator of Forest, Nagpur Division, Nagpur has certified that the proposal does not affect any monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archeological or recreational importance.
- 14) The User Agency has submitted the certificate of Collector, Nagpur under Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dweller's (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006 issued vide letter No. Rev/B-I-a/C.R.76/W.s.1117/2016, dt. 08/08/2017 in prescribed format Form- II. User Agency has submitted the copies of Gram Sabha/Ward Committee Resolutions are attached.
- 15) The User Agency has not submitted demarcation certificate of the proposed area.


- 16) The User Agency has submitted consolidated digital maps with proposal.
- 17) The Government of Maharashtra has requested Government of India for exemption of Net Present Value for the regularization of these lands in view of the pre-1980 stand & since they have been erroneously classified as forest these lands are under use of agriculture/non-forest/village/Government use etc. hence need to be regularized included the status of forest also, needs to be withdrawn.

In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under section - 2 (ii) of FCA-1980 subject to the following conditions: --

- i. Legal status of the land will be revenue land.
- ii. The revenue land shall not be used for any purpose other than specified in the project.
- iii. The user agency is exempted from paying NPV for the land to be diverted as per the latest orders in this regard.
- iv. The User Agency shall submit the Geo digital map in any suitable scale with geo-reference boundary & shape file prepared by using total stations or differential GPS and also indicating forest land, non-forest land & adjoining land proposed for diversion in different colors duly signed by the Deputy Conservator of Forests concerned and User Agency, as per the Government of India letter No. F.No.11-9/98-FC, dt.8/7/2011.
- v. All other conditions as may be mandatory under relevant Acts, Rules and guidelines shall be complied with by the user agency.

It is therefore, requested that Government of India may kindly be moved for approving the proposal for diversion of 60.40ha. Zudpi Jungle land of 42 villages in Nagpur City of Saoner Taluka, Dist. Nagpur under Category- li { Zudpi Jungle for Encroachment (excluding commercial propose) prior to 12/12/1996 using simplified procedure} in consolidated form under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in accordance with the procedure prescribed as per Government of India, Ministry of Environment & Forest's letter No. No.8-33/2001-Fc,dt.04/03/2014, under 2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
