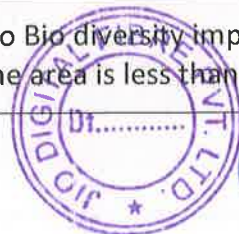

1	Project Details	:	<p>M/s Jio Digital Fibre Private Limited proposes to lay underground Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) from <b>Mallam to Chittamuru and Sullurpet to SHAR Centre</b> in Nellore District of Andhra Pradesh for a length of 46 Kms., out of which <b>30.303 Kms. passes through Pulicat Bird Sanctuary under Sullurpet WLM Division</b>. Objective of the project is to improve the Telemediation facilities in remote areas in line with the initiative of Govt. of India's Digital India policy. The Project provides employment to skilled and unskilled people during execution of the work and subsequently in Operation &amp; Maintenance of the OFC</p> <p>OFC is laid underground along the road by digging a trench of 0.50 Meters width and 1 to 1.65 meter in depth depending on the type of soil at edge of the road within the existing right of way. The trench is filled back and it is compacted immediately after the OFC is laid without causing any disturbance to wildlife and it doesn't involve any tree felling.</p> <p>It does not require any de-notification or diversion of the forest land but OFC is proposed to be laid in the existing Right of Way (RoW) granted to the Road Authorities. Permission is required from the Forest Authorities to lay the OFC within the existing RoW.</p>

## Project Report

M/s Jio Digital Fibre Private Limited (earlier known as Reliance Jio Infocomm Limited) proposes to lay underground Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) from Mallam to Chittamuru (and Sullurpeta to SHAR Centre in Nellore District of Andhra Pradesh for a length of 46 Kms., out of which 30.303 Kms. passes through Pulicat Bird Sanctuary under Sullurpeta WLM Division.

Objective of the project is to improve the communication facilities in remote villages along the Mallam to Chittamuru route and to SHAR Project in the State of Andhra Pradesh in line with the initiative of Govt. of India's Digital India policy. The Project provides employment to skilled and unskilled people during execution of the work and subsequently in Operation & Maintenance of the OFC.

Proposed OFC is laid underground along the road within the existing Right of Way of Duggarajapatnam Road and Sullurpeta to SHAR Road by digging a narrow trench of 0.5 Meters width and 1 to 1.65 meter in depth depending on the type of soil at edge of the road. The trench is filled back, and it is compacted immediately after the OFC is laid without causing any disturbance to wildlife and the project doesn't involve any tree felling. Total Area falling under Pulicat Bird Sanctuary is 1.33 Ha. (i.e. 30,303 m length x 0.5 m width). The cost of the Project is Rs. 300 lakhs. It does not require any de-notification or diversion of the forest land, but OFC is proposed to be laid in the existing Right of Way (RoW) granted to the Road Authorities. Permission is required from the Forest Authorities to lay the OFC within the existing RoW.

### Socio/Economical benefits of the Project:

Once the Project is completed, digital communication services like communication, Education, Entertainment, Healthcare and financial services to the local Panchayats, Schools, Hospitals, Public and various Government Departments like Forest, Police and Revenue.
