Sub:- Diversion of 72.177 ha of forest land in Sy. No. 1/1 of Bhutaramanahatti village, Belgaum Taluk and District for Establishment of Rani Chennamma University in favour of the Registrar, Rani Chennamma University, Belgaum-reg. (online Proposal No. FP/ KA /SCH/ 20566/2016).

The Government of Karnataka vide their letter No. FEE 101 FLL 2016 dated 04.10.2016 submitted the above subject proposal to Regional Office, Bangalore. The Regional Office, Bangalore vide their letter no. 4-KRA 1099/2016-BAN/1012 dated 15.11.2016 forwarded this proposal for Establishment of Rani Chennamma University in favour of the Registrar, Rani Chennamma University, Belgaum to Forest Conservation Division of MoEF&CC, New Delhi for processing this proposal. 4. Summary of Ranni Chennamma University, Belgavi

i. The proposal has been taken to FAC three times (on 26.12.2016, 15.06.2017 and 19.06.2018).

Recommendations FAC in the three Fac meeting is given below:

• 26.12.2016:

- **i.** Regional Office shall carry out inspection and submit Site inspection report (SIR). The matter stands deferred till such time.
- **ii.** State Government to explain the circumstances under which reserve forest was considered as gomel land and lease was executed in violation of provision of Forest Conservation Act, 1980.
- **iii.** State Government shall fix the responsibility of officials for carrying out violation of provision of Forest Conservation Act, 1980.

• 15.06.2017:

FAC after through deliberation and interaction with User Agency observed that there appears to be a no. of violations perhaps deliberately, in the past. Therefore the proposal is deferred to next FAC meeting. It is desired that the ACS(Forests) to govt. of Karnataka , PCCF(HoFF), Karnataka and Nodal Officer (FCA) Karnataka will be requested to attend the next FAC meeting in New Delhi and clarify these issues.

19.06.2018:

i. State Government shall initiate action for violation as per provisions of Govt. of India Guidelines 11-42/2017-FC dt 29.01.2018.

- **ii.** State Govt shall explore possibility of establishing the University Campus in the alternative nonforest land. Detail analysis of at least three possible sites may be submitted.
- iii. On analysis in DSS, it is observed that, the actual change in land use is restricted to a small portion of the forest area. State Govt. shall demarcate the area and submit details of actual forest area under non-forest use at present. The shape file of the same shall be submitted.
- **ii.** The land is part of area, which was declared as reserved Forest in 1960.
- **iii.** In 1990 the forest area was given on lease to the University. At that time, it was conveyed that the land is a forest land, and requires to be dealt under FC Act. But State Govt directed PCCF not to interfere in establishment of the University.
- **iv.** Two FIRs have been lodged against the Registrar of the University by the State Forest Deptt (in 1991 and 2014).
- **v.** In 2004, University authorities sold part of this forest land in 2004 to NHAI (9.24 acres) at a cost of Rs 30 lakhs.
- vi. Since there was a proposal for expansion of infrastructure for the University, the state Government initiated a proposal under FC Act in October, 2016 for ex-post facto approval of 72.18 ha land.
- **vii.** Site Inspection by Regional Office, Bangalore of MoEF&CC has also been done (in March, 2017). The Regional Office has confirmed violation under FC Act. (can be seen at parivesh.nic.in)
- **viii.** This is a case of violation under FC Act and the requisite information/action from the State Government has not been obtained. As a result, no further action by Ministry has been taken.
 - ix. The Addl. Chief Secretary (Forest) received on 29.01.2020. Ministry vide its letter dated 20.04.2020 sought the following shortcomings after the examination of reply forwarded by the Govt. of Karnataka vide in its letter dated 29.01.2020
 - **a.** The State Government has not provided the details of action initiated against the officials for violation as per the provisions of Government of India guidelines 11-42/2017-FC dated 29.01.2018.
 - **b.** The details of three possible sites for establishing the University campus on alternate non-forest land has not been identified by the State Government.
 - **c.** A black and white demarcation maps has been submitted with letter, it would be appreciable if KML file of the forest area is submitted.

The reply from the State Government is still awaited.

5. Now a DO letter received from Hon'ble Chief Minister; SS Yediyurappa addressed to Hon'ble Minister, EF&CC vide DO no. CM/318/GoI/2020 dt 11-09-2020 in which it was requested to kindly consider providing post facto FC clearance to the University in the interest of providing education to the students of the backward border regions.

In view of above, the facts related to the above proposal may be placed before FAC in its upcoming meeting scheduled to be held on 21.10.2020 for their examination and appropriate recommendation.
