Sub: Proposal for diversion of 51.783 ha of forest land for construction of Turi-Guntat medium Irrigation Project in Nabarangpur Block of Nabarangpur District, Odisha.

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- 1. The State Government of Odisha vide their letter No. 10F (Cons) 256/2016/22291/F&E dated 30.11.2016 submitted the above mentioned proposal seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Sectin-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
- 2. The facts related to the proposal as contained in the State Government's letter dated 30.11.2016 are given below in the form of fact sheet:

- 3. After examination of the above facts of the proposal, the following shortcomings found:
- (i) Two FRA certificates for 20.775 ha + 31.010 ha =51.785 ha (pg-240&241/c) have been given. However, the certificate for Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 for an area of 20.775 ha. is not in the prescribed format (pg-240/c) and without Gram Sabha resolution. Thus, the compliance on FRA is in-complete.
- (ii) It is reported by Project Proponent that the Dam project has a free Catchment of 612 sq. km. and preparation of Catchment Area Treatment Plan is under process and will be finalized in due course in consultation with Forest Department (pg-368-408/c). The approved CAT plan is not given.
- **4.** Accordingly, the State Government requested vide this Ministry's letter dated 18.04.2017(**Pg.429/c**) to provide the information as indicated in para (3) above for further consideration of the proposal in the Ministry.
- 5. The State Government of Odisha vide their letter No. 10F (Cons) 256/2016/9852/F&E dated 12.05.2017 (**Pg.430-486/c**) submitted a point-wise reply on the Ministry's letter dated 18.04.2017 and the reply is reproduced below.
- (i) This irrigation project has two components i.e. canal (linear) and barrage pond (non-linear) for which user agency has filed this proposal online as a HYBRID project and accordingly the relevant fields were filled/uploaded by the project proponent in the portal of the Ministry and the same was processed accordingly by the State Government. As regards compliances of Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 guidelines of the Ministry's dated 03.08.2009/05.07.2013, it is stated that the Collector, Nabarangpur has issued certificate pertaining to entire 51.783 ha of forest land for this irrigation project in two phases i.e. for 20.775 ha for construction of canal (linear) in the prescribed format in Form I (Pg.433/c) and for 31.010 ha, for construction of Barage (non-linear) in the prescribed format in Form II(Pg.434/c). Since linear projects are exempted from having Gram Sabhas and other related documents, no such documents were provided by the Collector pertaining 20.775 ha. of forest land proposed for diversion for canal project. However, the Collector had furnished the copy of proceedings of DLC (dt. 28.01.2016: **Pg.444-445/c**)) and SDLC meeting (dt. 28.01.2016: Pg.446-447/c) and Gram Sabhas held at villages Chatahandi (dt. 18.12.2015), Bikarampur (18.12.2013), Dangriguda (dt. 19.12.2013, Teliguda (dt. 18.12.2013 Chikili (dt. 12.09.2015), Gumaguda (dt. 10.09.2015) Saranpur (30.12.2013) and Palpur (dt. 05.10.2015) in Odia language along with their English version pertaining to forest land coming under Barrage area of this project i.e. 31.010 ha. All these documents were furnished in the Forest Diversion proposal. As required now, the relevant two no. of certificates in original issued by the Collector, Nabarangpur, as provided by Chief Engineer (PPF&I) vide his letter no. 1858 dt. 11.05.2017 are enclosed herewith.
- (ii) With regard to approved CAT Plan, it is reported by the State Govt. that while forwarding the diversion proposal to the Ministry, Catchment Area Treatment Plan for this irrigation project duly approved by Addl. PCCF (Forest Diversion) & Nodal Officer, FC Act with an estimated

cost of Rs. 2,58,37,200/- at current wage rate of Rs. 200/- per man-day was furnished. Copy of approved CATP for the project was enclosed in the DP, and available in file at **page 364-405/c**.

In view of above, it is proposed that the proposal for **diversion of 51.783 ha of forest land** for construction of **Turi-Guntat medium Irrigation Project** in Nabarangpur Block of Nabarangpur District, Odisha may be placed before FAC in its meeting to be held on 16.05.2017 as **additional agenda.**
