

No 59/0 of Tuem village in Pernem Taluka is transferred to Forest Department, Goa vide order no 28/11/GL/PER/RB/2021 dated 15/06/2021 of the Collector, North Goa.</p>
3.	<p>The proper KML file of the area identified for Compensatory Afforestation, Survey Sketch of the CA area and Compensatory Afforestation scheme shall be made available prior to Stage -II approval.</p>	<p>Complied and submitted.</p>
4.	<p>The User Agency shall transfer the cost of rising and maintaining of compensatory Afforestation at the current wage rate in consultation with State Forest Department in the account of CAMPA of the concerned State through online portal. The scheme may include demarcation of non-forest land using chain link fencing with provisions for watering, planting of taller (18 month old) seedlings, SMC works and escalation costs for works scheduled in subsequent years.</p>	<p>As mentioned at Sl. 7.	The private forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government.	Agreed
8.	No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused	Agreed.
9.	The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.	Agreed.
10.	The concerned Divisional Forest Officer, will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in the surrounding area.	Agreed.
11.	Permission to use/handing over of the land under proposal may be effected after the completion of the land acquisition process or after the settlement of rights if any on the land.	Agreed.
12.	The User Agency shall submit the annual self- compliance report in respect of the above stated conditions to the State Government and Integrated Regional Office, Bangalore by end of March every year.	Agreed.
13.	The User Agency shall comply with all the provisons of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, Hon'ble Court Order (s) and NGT Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project	Agreed
