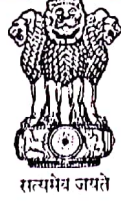

The undersigned is directed to refer Government of Maharashtra letter No. FLD-3121/C.R.165/F-10 dated 21.09.2021 and APCCF & Nodal Officer (FCA), Maharashtra vide his letter No. Desk-17/NODAL/AMRAVATI/ID-11993/698/20-21 dated 04.08.2021 on the above subject seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and APCCF & Nodal Officer (FCA), Maharashtra letter No. Desk-17/Nodal/Amravati/ID-11993/2435/2021-2022 dated 16.02.2022 forwarding additional information as sought vide this office letter of even number dated 30.11.2021 and to say that the said proposal has been examined in the Integrated Regional Office in light of the relevant provisions of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and Guidelines issued thereunder and approved by the Regional Empowered Committee constituted under Section- 4 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

After careful examination of the proposal of the State Government, Maharashtra and on the basis of the approval of the proposal by the Regional Empowered Committee, the Central Government hereby accords 'in-principle' under Section - 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 9.33 ha Reserved Forest land in favour of Irrigation Project & Water Resources, Investigation Division, Amravati for construction of Patiya Minor Irrigation Tank at Village- Patiya, Taluka- Dharani, District- Amravati in the State of Maharashtra subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:

- i. Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged;
- ii. **Compensatory afforestation**
  - a. Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 9.33 ha non forest land in Survey/ Gut. No. 60 at Village- Baslapur, Taluka- Chandur Railway, District- Amravati at the cost of the User Agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species along with 10% RET species of Amravati District shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided. Atleast two water bodies shall be constructed in the form of tank/ stop dams etc if the same are not available in the area or in nearby vicinity;

- b. The non-forest land proposed for CA shall be transferred and mutated in the name of Forest Department and notified as RF/PF prior to Stage-II approval. A copy of the original notification declaring the non-forest land under Section 4 or Section 29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927, or under the relevant section of the State Forest Act as the case may be, will be submitted by the State Government prior to Stage-II approval;
- iii. The cost of Compensatory Afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years;
- iv. NPV:
- a. The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 9.33 ha forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in IA No. 566 in WP (C) No. 202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No. 5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II) dated 18/09/2003, as well as letter No. 5-2/2006-FC dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007-FC dated 05/02/2009 in this regard;
- b. Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect;
- v. The cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department;
- vi. Copy of approved Catchment Area Treatment (CAT) Plan shall be submitted in accordance to para no. 4.8 (i) of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 Handbook, if applicable;
- vii. All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/ deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>);
- viii. The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector;
- ix. Complete enumeration list trees proposed to be felled in the proposal is not submitted along with the reply. Girth wise complete enumeration list of trees along with species names shall be submitted along with Stage- I compliance report;
- x. Details of employment potential in terms of man days of skilled, semiskilled and unskilled persons on permanent (direct and indirect) and temporary (direct and indirect) basis have not been provided. The same needs to be submitted along with Stage- I compliance report;
- xi. To improve the Forest/ Tree cover and to reduce pollution in the State, as mandated in National Forest Policy, 1988 and Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 respectively, the User Agency with involvement of Joint Forest Management Committees (JFMC's) and in consultation with local DCF shall raise at least 15,000 seedlings of



forestry species along with bamboo, fruit bearing, medicinal, ornamental and indigenous/local for 10 years. At least 50% of seedlings shall be planted in the vicinity of project area and remaining 50% of seedlings shall be distributed among villagers as per choice of villagers. The concerned JFMC's shall maintain record of plantation/ seedling distribution to villagers;

xii. The State Government and User Agency shall ensure complete compliance of following recommendation of Standing Committee of NBWL:

- a. Soil Moisture Conservation works for the Catchment Area Treatment within and adjoining Forest areas.
- b. 2% of the project cost shall be deposited with Melghat Tiger Conservation Foundation for conservation activities.
- c. Water will be provided to Forest Department free of cost.

xiii. The live stock in vicinity of project area shall be vaccinated for common contagious diseases of live stocks by State Government utilizing funds earmarked for conservation activities;

xiv. The State Forest Department shall take comprehensive mitigation measures to reduce man-animal conflicts from the funds earmarked for conservation activities;


xv. User Agency shall take all necessary measures to prevent nearby villagers from practicing agriculture in drawdown area of tank during dry season to reduce man-animal conflicts;

xvi. The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>);

After receipt of a report on the compliance of conditions no ii (b), iii, iv (a), vii, viii, ix, x and undertakings, duly authenticated by the competent authority in the State Government, in respect of all other conditions, from the State Government, formal approval will be considered in this regard under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.





Collective forest rights proposal from Mouja : Patiya Tq. Dharni / Chikhaldhara gram Sabha / forest rights committee has been received by the Sub-Divisional level committee.

After considering all the documentary evidence, documents attached to the case, the Sub-Divisional level committee Dharni is making recommendations for granting collective forest rights in forest compartment no. 691 area 224.60 hectare to Mouja- patiya Tah.. Dharni / chikhaldhara gram Sabha / tribal community,

1. Collection of traditionally collected by-products (non timber), their use or disposal ("Forest by-product") means as per section 2(z) of scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Residents (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006".
2. Aquatic fish and other products, grazing, use of traditional seasonal resources.
3. Conservation of social forest resources - traditionally conserved and nurtured for sustainable use, regeneration, conservation or management.
4. The right to access biodiversity and the collective right to acquire intellectual property and traditional knowledge related to biodiversity and cultural diversity.

**The collective forest rights recommended above will be subject to the following terms and conditions.**

1. The entire responsibility for conservation of forest in forest compartment, which is classified as a collective right, from fire, illegal logging and illegal grazing rests with the Gram Sabha and the committee specially selected by the Gram Sabha.
2. Forest by-products will be disposed of in a sustainable manner and can be used only for daily subsistence.
3. Pursuant to section 4(d) of the scheduled tribes and Other traditional Forest Residents (recognition of Forest Rights) rules 2006, the provisions of section 5 of the Scheduled Tribes and Other traditional Forest Residents (Recognition of Forest Rights) act 2006 have been implemented. Collective right will come into force only after a committee is formed to protect wildlife, forest and biodiversity.
4. The trees will not be injured while removing secondary forest produce.

5. Removal of bamboo will be done as per scientific rules and subject to action plan. Only three year old mature bamboo can be removed and in doing so it will be necessary to keep the middle mature bamboo required for cobble bamboo.

6. Disposal and transportation of forest by-product can only be done by head, bicycle and handcart.

(Sustainable eviction would mean the same as the biodiversity act 2002).

Under section 5 of the Scheduled tribes and Other traditional Forest residents (recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006, the duties of the forest rights holder shall be as follows:

1. To protect wildlife, forests and biodiversity.
2. Ensure that adjacent watersheds, water resources and other ecologically sensitive areas are adequately protected,
3. The forest dwellers will ensure that the habitats of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional forest dwellers are protected from any kind of destructive practices that could harm their cultural and natural heritage in any way.
4. It will ensure that the decisions taken by the gram Sabha are complied with in order to regulate the access to resources of social forests and to stop any action that adversely affects the wildlife, forest and biodiversity.

Mouja - Patiya Tq. Dharni Collective forest rights case from Sub-Divisional level committee Dharni has received by District level committee.

After considering all the documents, evidences and documents attached to the case, the gram Sabha / tribal community of Mouja- patiya Tah. Dharni has been allotted compartment no.691 area-224.6 ha. In this, the Sub-Divisional level committee is recommending retention for granting collective forest rights as follows.

- i. Collection of traditionally collected by-products (non timber), their use or disposal ("Forest by-product" means as per section 2(z) of scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Residents (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act,2006)..
- ii. Grazing, use of traditional seasonal resources.
- iii. Conservation, regeneration, conservation or management of social forest resources that have been traditionally protected and conserved for sustainable use.
- iv. The right to access biodiversity and the collective right to acquire intellectual property and traditional knowledge related to biodiversity and cultural diversity.

**The collective forest rights recommended above will be subject to the following terms and conditions.**

- i. The entire responsibility for the conservation of forests in the forest area, which is classified as a collective right, from fire, illegal logging and illegal grazing will remain with the Gram Sabha and the gram conservation committee specially elected by the gram Sabha.
- ii. Secondary forest production will be disposed of in a sustainable manner and it can be used only for daily subsistence and subsistence. It cannot be used for commercial / commercial use..
- iii. With a view to implementing the provisions of section 4(d) of the scheduled tribes and Other traditional Forest Residents (recognition of Forest Rights) rules 2006, section 5 of the Scheduled Tribes and Other traditional Forest Residents (Recognition of Forest Rights) act 2006, wildlife, forest and biodiversity collective right will come into force only after a committee is formed to protect them.
- iv. The trees will not be injured while removing forest by-products.
- v. Removal of bamboo can be done as per scientific rules and subject to action plan. Only three year old mature bamboo can be removed and in doing so, it will be necessary to keep the required number of mature bamboos.

- xii. The district level committee shall take a decision with prior permission of the government, in case of relaxation or extension of other terms and conditions other than the above mentioned matters as per local conditions.

**Duties of the forest right holders under section 5 of the Scheduled tribes and Other traditional Forest residents (recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006 shall be as follows.**

1. To protect wildlife, forests and biodiversity.
2. Adjacent watersheds, water resources and other ecologically sensitive areas will be adequately protected.
3. The forest dwellers will ensure that the habitats of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional forest dwellers are protected from any kind of destructive practices that may interfere with their cultural and natural heritage in any way.
4. Ensure compliance with the decisions taken by the gramsabha to regulate the access to social forest resources and to stop any action that adversely affects wild life, forests and biodiversity.

Also, after considering all the documents, evidences and documents attached with the case, Mouja Patiya Tah. Dharni / chikhaldhara gram Sabha / tribal community has been allotted forest compartment no. 691 area 224.60 hectare considering the Sub-Divisional level committee Dharni holding recommendation for granting collective forests rights, the district level committee is approving the proposal.

The Collective forest rights recommended above will be subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The entire responsibility of conserving, rehabilitating and managing the forest in the forest area which is being classified as a collective right from fire, illegal logging and illegal grazing will remain with the Gramsabha and the Forest conservation committee specially elected by the Gram Sabha.
2. The Forest department will determine the above sanctioned forest land and the resources on it with the help and consent of the committee constituted under the provisions of the said act.
3. Disposal of "forest byproducts" will be done in a sustainable manner under the provision of this act.
4. With a view to implementing the provisions of rule 5 of the scheduled tribes and Traditional Forest Residents (Recognition of forest rights) Rule, 2008 as per rule 4(d) of the Scheduled Tribes and other traditional forest residents (recognitions of forest rights) Act, 2008, Collective rights will come into force only after a committee is formed to protect wildlife, forest and biodiversity.
5. Trees will not be injured while removing 'forest byproducts'.
6. Removal of bamboo will be done as per scientific rules and subject to action plan, only three year old mature bamboo can be removed and in doing so it will be necessary to keep the required number of mature bamboos for cobble bamboo.
7. Care should be taken to ensure that there is no deviation from the work plan of the forest department. Forest Conservation Act 1980, Indian forest Act 1972, wildlife Act 1972 and Forest Right Recognition Act 2006 and Rule 2008 and Government Resolution issued from time to time will be applicable.
8. As per the micro-action plan made by the concerned Deputy Conservator of forest with the concerned village joint forest management committee, it will be eligible for implementation in the year 2012-2022.
9. Area for which the Forest Right is given will be demarcated.
10. The responsibility of enforcing all the above conditions will rest with the Forest Management Committee approved by the Gram Sabha as per rule 4(d) of the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional forest residents (Recognition of forest Rights) Rules 2008.
11. The district level committee shall take a decision with prior permission of the government, in case of relaxation or extension of other terms and conditions other than the above mentioned matters as per local conditions


