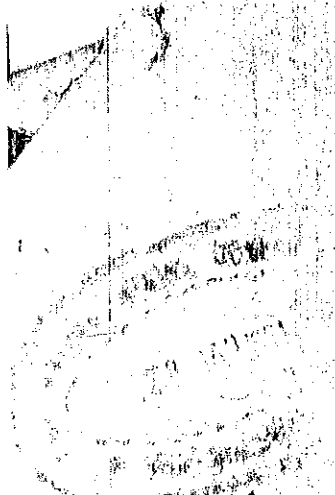

Grant of Mining Lease in the district of Keonjhar.

Application presented on 14.5.76 by M/s. O.M.C. Ltd., for grant of a Mining Lease for Manganese over an area of 171.42 hectares in Parulipada village in Keonjhar district.

ORDER:

Whereas M/s. Orissa Mining Corporation Ltd. have applied to the State Government for grant of a Mining Lease by their application read above ;

Whereas the mineral in the land in respect of which the mining lease has been applied for belongs to Government and the land is at their disposal ;

Whereas the applicant holds a valid certificate of approval from the State Government ;

Whereas the applicant being a limited company ;

Whereas the Government of India in their letter No.5/94/76-MS dated 23.5.79 have relaxed the provision of section 6 (i)9b) of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957 as the mining leases for Iron and Manganese (including this area held by the party is more than 10 sq.kms. and attracts the provision of the 6(1) of the Act.

Whereas the Government of India have conveyed their approval to the grant of Mining lease under section 5(2) of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act, 1957 and also in exercise of the powers conferred by section 30 of the said Act, directed the State Government to take into consideration this application and pass orders thereon within three months from 23.5.79 .

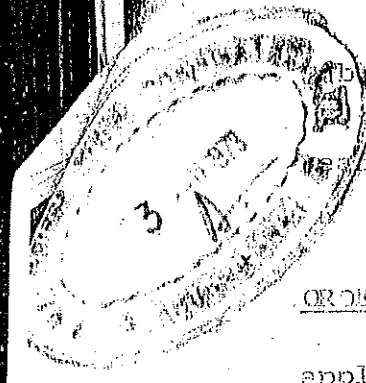
Whereas the Government of India in their letter No.5/94/76-MS dated 23.5.79 have relaxed the Rule 58(1) of the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960 a-s the area has not been thrown open for regrant ;

Whereas the party was asked in Mining and Geology Department letter No.6832 MS dated 5.6.79 to accept the terms and conditions under which the mining lease was proposed to be considered for grant and the party in his letter No.12908/OMC dated 8.6.79 accepted these conditions ;

Sub: Extension of validity period of Mining Lease for Manganese ore of M/s OMC Ltd. over an area of 104.86 Ha in Village Parullipada in Keonjhar district.

ORDER:

Whereas a mining lease was granted for Manganese in favour of M/s. OMC Ltd. over an area of 104.86 Ha in Village Parullipada in Keonjhar district for a period of 20 years w.e.f 25.04.1981.

Whereas the said lease expired on 24.04.2001;

Whereas OMC surrendered an area of 65.31 hecets out of the total area.

Whereas the 1st RML application was filed on 22.04.2000 over an area of 104.86 hecets in due time.


Whereas Section 8A(8) of MMDR Amendment Act 2015 Ministry of Mines, Govt. of India, speaks as follows.

"Notwithstanding anything contained in this Section, the period of mining lease, including existing mining leases of Government Companies or Corporations shall be such as may be prescribed by the central Government".

Whereas Ministry of Mines Government of India in their order dated 06.02.2015 have clarified that the tenure of mining leases of all Government companies or corporations whose mining leases have expired and renewal applications have been made in time or which are due to expire on or before 31.03.2020 will stand to be extended till 31.03.2020.

Therefore, the State Government are hereby pleased to order that in terms of letter No.F. No.1/2/2015 M.VI dated 06.02.2015 of the Ministry of Mines, Government of India, the period of validity of the Mining Lease for (Chromite) of M/s OMC Ltd. over an area of 104.86 Ha in Village Parullipada in Keonjhar district is extended till 31.03.2020 subject to execution of a supplementary lease deed extending the period of validity of the original lease till 31.03.2020.




