EFS&T Department - Diversion of 0.52 Ha of forest land for rehabilitation and up-gradation of NH-221 (new NH-30) from Km 32.700 to Km 72.200 (Chandragudem to AP/TS Border Section) in the State of AP to two lanes with paved shoulders on EPC Mode, in krishnaraopalem RF (Compt. No. 80) of Krishna Division, in favour of PD, PIU, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Machilipatnam –Stage-II approval accorded - Orders issued.

ORDER:

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Head of Forest Force, Andhra Pradesh, in the letter 1st read above, has submitted a proposal under Section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, for diversion of 0.52 Ha of forest land for rehabilitation and up-gradation of NH-221 (new NH-30) from Km 32.700 to Km 72.200 (Chandragudem to AP/TS Border Section) in the State of AP to two lanes with paved shoulders on EPC Mode, in Krishnaraopalem RF (Compt. No. 80) of Krishna Division, in favour of Project Director, Project Implementation Unit (PIU), Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Machilipatnam and requested to accord approval in view of the guidelines issued time to time by Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, vide letter 2nd read above.

2. Accordingly, the Government in the reference 3rd read above have accorded (Stage-I) approval for the project, subject to fulfillment of certain conditions as stipulated therein.

3. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Head of Forest Force, Andhra Pradesh, in the letter 4th read above, has submitted the compliance report on the conditions stipulated in in-principle (Stage-I) approval and requested the Government to accord final approval for the project.

4. Government after careful examination of the proposal and in exercise of the powers delegated to State Government in the guidelines issued by Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, in the reference 2nd read above, hereby accord (Stage-II) approval for diversion of 0.52 Ha of forest land for rehabilitation and up-gradation of NH-221 (new NH-30) from Km 32.700 to Km 72.200 (Chandragudem to AP/TS Border Section) in the State of AP to two lanes with paved shoulders on EPC Mode, in Krishnaraopalem RF (Compt. No. 80) of Krishna Division, in favour of Project Director, Project Implementation Unit (PIU), Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Machilipatnam, subject to the following conditions:-

- i. The legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.
- ii. The demarcation of the forest area proposed for diversion shall be carried out by erecting cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of user agency.
- iii. The additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be paid by the user agency and deposited either in SB A/c No.SB01025198, Compensatory Afforestation Fund (CAF), Andhra Pradesh, Corporation Bank, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi-110 003 (RTGS/IFSC No.CORP0000371) or in SB A/c No.344902010105 407 - Andhra Pradesh CAMPA, Union Bank of India, Sundar Nagar, New Delhi-110003 (RTGS/IFSC No.UBINO534498).

- iv. Other conditions specified in the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change letters dated.13-2-2014 shall also be complied with by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Head of Forest Force, Andhra Pradesh, and user agency with which they are concerned.
 - v. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 0.52 Ha. In case the land is not taken over by the user agency or the same is not used for the stipulated purpose within a period of two years, then the area in question shall be taken back by the Forest Department.
5. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Head of Forest Force, Andhra Pradesh, is therefore directed to take further necessary action accordingly.
