MEMORANDUM

Sub: Proposed diversion of 0.497 ha. of Forest land in favour of POWERGRID Medinipur Jeerat Transmission Ltd. (Central PSU) for construction of Loop out of 400 KV D/C Chanditala-Kharagpur transmission line at 765/400 KV Medinipur Substation under Medinipur forest division.


In pursuance of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Govt. of India's letter No. 5-WBB107/2020-BHU, dtd. 6/3/2020, the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor is pleased to convey Stage-II/final approval under Sec 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, for diversion of 0.497 ha of Forest land in favour of POWERGRID Medinipur Jeerat Transmission Ltd. (Central PSU) for construction of Loop out of 400 KV D/C Chanditala-Kharagpur transmission line at 765/400 KV Medinipur Substation under Medinipur forest division subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- i) Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged and shall be subject to the provisions of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and the rules made thereunder;
- ii) Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the user agency;
- iii) Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up over 1.00 ha of degraded forest land identified in Mouza: Chandmura, JL No.451, RS Plot No.01, Beat Gopalband under Arabari Range of Medinipur Forest Division as per approved plan/scheme by the Forest Department at the cost of user agency within a period of three years with effect from the date of issue of approval and maintained thereafter in accordance with the approved Plan. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided;
- iv) The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificates from the concerned District Collector;
- v) The user agency at its cost shall provide bird deflectors, which are to be fixed on upper conductor of transmission line at suitable intervals to avoid bird hits;
- vi) The user agency shall comply with the guidelines for laying transmission lines through forest areas issued by Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India vide letter No.7-25/2012-FC dated 05.05.2014 and 19.11.2014;
- vii) The user agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable;
- viii) The user agency shall ensure minimum felling of trees and maximum height of towers in the forest area;
- ix) Any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable under strict supervision of the State Forest Department;
- x) In case of the transmission lines to be constructed in hilly areas, where adequate clearance is already available, trees will not be cut;
- xi) The State Forest Department shall implement the approved scheme for creation and maintenance of plantation of local dwarf species (preferably medicinal plants) in right of way under the transmission line;
- xii) The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government;
- xiii) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land;
- xiv) Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the user agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel;
- xv) The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the direction of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer;
- Xvi) No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work;
- xvii) Earth or any material shall neither be brought from nor the debris resulting during construction be disposed of in the adjoining forest area by the user agency;
- xviii) The user agency while executing works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner;

- xix) The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less;
- xx) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal;
- xxi) The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Govt. of India;
- xxii) The user agency shall submit annual self-monitoring report on compliance of stipulated conditions to be Nodal Officer (FCA) of the State and Eastern Regional Office of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India;
- xxiii) The user agency and the State Govt. shall ensure compliances of all the Court orders, provisions, rules, regulations and guidelines for the time being in force as applicable to the project;
- xxiv) Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife, shall be complied by the user agency;
- xxv) State Govt. shall upload the final/Stage-II approval in Parivesh web portal of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change before handing over of diverted forest land to user agency;

Violation of any of these conditions will be amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act,1980 and action would be taken as per Para 1.21 (iii) of Chapter-1 of Handbook of Guidelines issued under F.C. Act,1980 vide Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India letter No.5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.
