Sub:- Essential Document Sought (EDS) with reference to the proposal submitted for diversion of 8.361 ha. of forest land in the allotted 279 acres of land to M/s Shyam Metalics & Energy Ltd. for establishment of Industry in the village Pandloi & Nislanbhang of Rengali Tahasil in Sambalpur- Proposal No.I P/OR/IND/36821/2018 State SI No.OR-063/2018 dt.06.11.2018.


On scrutiny of the part-I of Form-A for the above mentioned Forest Diversion Proposal submitted you alongwith other maps and documents the following essential documents are found missing / incomplete.

- (i) In the above proposal total area mentioned is of 279 acres but in the non-forest land required for this project is written '0'. In Annexure (xvi) submitted alongwith Diversion Proposal, recommendation of 237 acres of land in favour of M/s Shyam Metalics & Energy Ltd. is mentioned in addition to earlier recommended 193.87 acre by IPICOL vide letter No.2821 dt.17.09.2008. The corrected total land acquired for the project and its break up (Forest land and non-forest land) may be submitted.
- (ii) The land schedule of entire project area covering both forest and non-forest land duly authenticated by the concerned Tahasildar with a certificate that there is no forest land including DLC forest except 8.361 ha. as submitted is involved in the project as on 25.10.1980. Plotwise land to be acquired in different kism of land duly authenticated from concerned Tahasildar to be submitted.
- (iii) Details of land schedule with map for the diversion of forest land already submitted and acquired previously for the project must be submitted.
- (iv) Component wise break up for forest land and non-forest land must be submitted with proposal land use map.
- (v) Details of cost-benefit analysis for the project must be submitted as per now revised guidelines.
- (vi) Copy of the environment clearance under Environmental (protection) Act 1986 must be submitted. If the project does not require the Environmental clearance the required certificate from the competent authority must be submitted.

- (vii) The required FRA certificate for the entire forest land from the competent authority must be submitted.
- (viii) Details of land identified for compensatory Afforestation with detailed project at the current wage rate and required maps and documents must be prepared and submitted.
- (ix) The joint tree enumeration list in forest and non-forest land duly authenticated by the concerned forest and revenue officials must be submitted.
- (x) All the required documents, maps and certificate duly authenticated by the competent authority must be annexed properly with page number in the check-list for the processing of the diversion proposal and site inspection.


It is therefore the diversion proposal submitted in hand copies is hereby returned to you for the necessary compliance and re-submission after annexing all the essential required documents at the earliest.
