Guidelines for diversion of forest land for non-forest purpose under the Forest Sub: (Conservation) Act, 1980-Not to recommend conditions which are beyond the control of the user agency-reg.

Sir,

I am directed to say that it has been observed that in this Ministry on the basis of the recommendations made by the Forest Advisory Committee and the Regional Offices in some of the approval accorded under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 (FC Act) has stipulated condition which are beyond the control of the user agency. Compliance of such conditions being beyond the control of the user agency, in majority of such cases grant of final approval under the FC Act and actual handing over of the forest land to the user agency is delayed.

After careful examination of the matter, I am directed to say that to mitigate impact of diversion of forest land for non-forest purpose Forest Advisory Committee (FAC) and Regional Offices of the Ministry may not recommend such conditions which are beyond the control of the user agency. However, in case the FAC or Regional Offices of this Ministry are of the view that State Government or Union Territory Administration needs to formulate a policy or change an existing policy, in the interest of conservation and development of flora and fauna, they may advise this Ministry to issue appropriate advisory to the concerned State Government or the Union Territory Administration. Issue and compliance to such advisory however, may not be linked to grant of approval under the FC Act for diversion of forest land to a specific project.
