## OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: The Scheduled Tribes (Recognition of Forest Rights) Bill, 2005.

Ref: PMO U.O. No. 560/31/C/24/2000-ES.II dated 21.10.2005.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the discussions held with the Director General of Forests & Special Secretary (DGF&SS) on the subject mentioned above on 17.10.2005 and to say that the following were agreed in the said meeting:

- 1. The proposed Bill needs to be more comprehensive and should include non-tribal forest dwellers in addition to the tribals.
- 2. Vesting of forest land in each eligible family should be on equity basis and not as per the prescription of 2.5 ha of land for each family.
- 3. Decision making authority for vesting of forest land rights should not be given to Gram Sabha.
- 4. All National Parks and Sanctuaries need to be excluded from the ambit of the proposed Bill.
