
Sir,

With reference to the memo cited above on the captioned subject, this is to inform that, the Site-Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan in respect of the aforementioned project of M/S Jindal Steel & Power Limited for diversion of 1.99 ha. of forest land (0.744 ha in Keonjhar Forest Division and 1.246 ha. in Deogarh Forest Division) has been technically approved by the PCCF (WL) & CWLW, Odisha, Bhubaneswar with a financial outlay of Rs.208.300 lakhs for the activities to be implemented by the DFO, Deogarh Forest Division in the Project impact area. Further, the Elephant Anti-depredation Scheme in respect of Deogarh Forest Division has been technically approved by the PCCF (WL) & CWLW, Odisha, Bhubaneswar with a financial outlay of Rs.423.468 lakhs for Deogarh Forest Division.

In this regard, you are hereby requested to deposit the Cost of Rs.631.768 lakhs (208.300 lakhs towards SSWCP +423.468 lakhs towards Elephant Anti-depredation Scheme) only in respect of Deogarh Forest Division in the State CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in>) of MoEF & CC and submit the deposit particulars to this office at an early date for taking necessary action at this end.

Further, it is also requested to submit the undertakings regarding the following conditions for future compliance:

1. The Site-Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan and Elephant Anti-depredation Scheme shall be revisited after 5 years or as and when required and the User Agency shall give the

undertaking to contribute towards the revised cost of the Site-Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan and Elephant Anti-depredation Scheme till the project period, if any.

2. If there would be need for Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan after expiry of the present plan period, the User Agency will have to submit another such plan at least one year before the expiry of the existing Conservation Plan and deposit the amount upon its approval. In case of delay, it will be dealt as per law for violations of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
3. The User Agency has to give an undertaking to bear the differential cost in case of enhancement of wage rate during implementation of this plan.

With reference to the above cited memo on the captioned subject, this is to intimate that, the Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan in respect of the aforementioned project of M/s Jindal Steel & Power Ltd. for diversion of 1.99 ha forest land (0.744 ha in Keonjhar Forest Division and 1.246 ha in Deogarh Division) has been technically approved by the PCCF (WL) & CWLW, Odisha with a financial outlay of Rs.151.284 lakhs for activities to be implemented by the DFO, Keonjhar Division in the project impact area. Further, the Elephant Anti Depradation Scheme in respect of Keonjhar Division has been technically approved with a financial outlay of Rs.33.00 lakh for Keonjhar Division.

2. Should there be need for Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan after expiry of the present plan period, the user agency shall submit another such plan at least one year before the expiry of the present Conservation Plan and deposit the outlay amount upon its approval. In case of delay, it will be dealt as per law for violations of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
3. The User Agency shall give an undertaking to bear the differential cost in case of enhancement of wage rate at the time of implementation of this plan.


