Sub: Proposal for seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section 2 (1) (ii) of the Van Sanrakshana Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 in favor of M/s. SCCL for non-forestry use of 649.3014 ha forest land in Ramavaram RF of Ramavaram Range of Kothagudem for grant of mining lease for proposed Venkateshkhani OCP from underground rights to surface rights in Kothagudem area in Bhadradri Kothagudem District (Online proposal No. FP/TG/MIN/44798/2020).-regarding.

## Madam/Sir

I am directed to refer to the Government of Telangana's letter No.232/For.I (1)/2021 dated 18.02.2021 and additional information submitted by the State Govt. vide letter No. 232/For.I(1)/2021 dated 16.07.2021, Vide letter dated 18.12.2021, vide letter No. 232/For.I (1)/2021 dated 24.05.2022, vide letter No.232/For. I (1)/2021 dated 27.07.2022, vide letter No.232/For.I (1)/2021 dated 14.03.2023, vide letter No.232/For.I (1)/2021 dated 31.07.2023, vide letter No. 232/For.I (1)/2021 dated 01.03.2024, vide letter No.232/For.I (1)/2021 dated 23.04.2024 and vide letter No. o.232/For.I (1)/2021 dated 01.07.2024 on the above mentioned subject, seeking prior approval of Central Government under Section 2 (1) (ii) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980, and to say that the said proposal has been examined by the Advisory Committee (AC) constituted by the Central Government under Section-3 of the aforesaid Act.

2. After careful consideration of the proposal of the Government of Telangana and on the basis of the recommendations of the Advisory Committee (AC), the Central Government hereby agrees *to accord* "*In-principle*" approval under Section 2 (1) (ii) of the Van (Sanrakshana Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 for non-forestry use of 649.3014 ha forest land in Ramavaram RF of Ramavaram Range of Kothagudem for grant of mining lease for proposed Venkateshkhani OCP from underground rights to surface rights in Kothagudem area in Bhadradri Kothagudem District, subject to the following conditions:-

- i. Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged;
- ii. Compensatory Afforestation:

- a. The User Agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory afforestation as per the approved CA Scheme at the current wage rate in consultation with State Forest Department in the account of National Authority CAMPA of the concerned State through online portal;
- b. The compensatory afforestation over identified non-forest land, equal in extent to the forest land being diverted i.e. 649.3014 ha. shall be raised by the State Forest Department at the project cost within two years from the date of grant of final approval.
- c. The balance seedling shall also be raised over identified 200 ha of degraded forest land, by the State Forest Department at the project cost within two years from the date of grant of final approval;
- d. The land identified for raising Compensatory Afforestation shall be notified by the State Government as RF under Section-4 or PF under Section-29 of the Indian Forest Act. 1927 or under the relevant Section (s) of the local Forest Act, as the case may be, before grant of final approval;
- e. The cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars, if required on the CA land, shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the user agency. The scheme may include afforestation of indigenous species with appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years, into the account of National Authority, CAMPA of the concerned State Government;
- f. The User agency either himself or through the State Forest Department shall undertake afforestation on degraded forest land, at project cost, one and half time in extent to the area used for safety zone;
- g. The land identified for the purpose of CA shall be clearly depicted on a Survey of India toposheet of 1:50,000 scale;
- iii. NPV:
  - a. The User Agency shall transfer the funds towards the cost of Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted under this proposal in accordance with the MoEF&CC's guidelines dated 06.01.2022 read with guidelines dated 22.03.2022 into the account of National Authority, CAMPA of the concerned State Govt.;
  - b. At the time of payment of the Net Present Value (NPV) at the present rate, the user agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India;
- iv. The area technically and biologically reclaimed shall be surrendered as per the details given below:

- iv. The State Government shall ensure that the already technically and biologically reclaimed areas of the GKOC-PH-II mine and GKOC Phase-III mine shall not be used for OB dump or any other purpose;
- v. The surrender schedule given for GKOC Ph.-I shall be complied with.
- vi. The biodiversity conservation plan and Wildlife conservation / Mitigation plan shall be implemented at the cost of the User Agency and all funds shall be deposited in the National Authority (CAMPA) account at New Delhi;
- vii. Since the instant proposal is linked with the proposal for land use change and change in CA sites for diversion of 154.96 ha of forest land for Gouthami Khani OCP phase-III in Ramavaram RF & Range of Kothagudem Division of Bhadradri Kothagudem District, Telangana State (Online proposal No.FP/TG/MIN/970/2005). The conditions imposed by the Advisory Committee in the instant proposal shall be complied by the user agency at the time of submission of compliance of conditions stipulated in the Stage-I approval for the instant proposal and assured by the Ministry while considering the instant proposal for final approval;
- viii. In addition, the instant proposal is also linked with the proposal for 0<sup>ft</sup> Renewal of diversion of 124 ha. (Surveyed 124.065 ha.) of forest land of GKOC Phase-II, Kothagudem for use of this de-coaled area for dumping of OB to be generated from adjoining mines in Ramavaram RF of Kothagudem Division, Bhadradri Kothagudem District, Telangana (Online Proposal No. FP/TG/MIN/32497/2018). The conditions imposed by the Advisory Committee in this proposal shall be complied by the user agency at the time submission of compliance of conditions stipulated in the Stage-I approval for the instant proposal and be assured by the Ministry while considering the instant proposal for final approval;
- ix. Following activities, as per approved plan / schemes, shall be undertaken in the lease area by the User Agency under the supervision of the State Forest Department. Approved scheme/plan shall be submitted to the Ministry along with compliance of the 'in-principle' approval:
  - a. Mitigative measures to minimize soil erosion and choking of stream shall be implemented within a period of three years with effect from the issue of Stage-II clearance in accordance with the approved Plan in consultation with the State Forest Department;
  - b. Planting of adequate drought hardy plant species and sowing of seeds, in the appropriate area within the mining lease to arrest soil erosion in

accordance with the approved scheme;

- c. Construction of check dams, retention /toe walls to arrest sliding down of the excavated material along the contour in accordance with the approved scheme;
- d. Stabilize the overburden dumps by appropriate grading/benching, in accordance with the approved scheme, so as to ensure that angles of repose at any given place is less than 280; and
- x. **Safety Zone Management:** Following activities, at project cost, shall be undertaken by the user agency for the management of safety zone as per relevant guidelines issued by the Ministry's guidelines:
  - a. User agency shall ensure demarcation of safety zone (7.5-meter strip all along the inner boundary of the mining lease area), and its fencing, protection and regeneration by erecting adequate number of 6 feet high RCC boundary pillars inscribed with DGPS coordinates with barbed wire fencing and deploying adequate number of watchers under the supervision of the. State Forest Department;
  - b. Boundary of the safety zone of the mining lease, adjacent to habitation/roads, should be properly fenced by the user agency;
  - c. Safety zone shall be maintained as green belt around mining lease and to ensure dense canopy in the area, regeneration shall be taken up in this area by the user agency at project cost under the supervision of the State Forest Department;
  - d. The State Government and the user agency shall ensure that safety zone is maintained as per the prescribed norms;
- xi. No damage shall be caused to the top-soil and the user agency will follow the top soil management plan;
- xii. The User Agency shall undertake mining in a phased manner after taking due care for reclamation of the mined over area. The concurrent reclamation plan as per the approved mining plan shall be executed by the User Agency from the very first year, and an annual report on implementation thereof shall be submitted to the Nodal Officer, Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, in the concerned State Government and the concerned Regional Office of the Ministry. If it is found from the annual report that the activities indicated in the concurrent reclamation plan are not being executed by the User Agency, the Nodal Officer or the concern Addl. Principle Chief Conservator of Forests (Central) may direct that the mining activities shall remain suspended till such time, such reclamation activities area satisfactorily executed;
- xiii. The User Agency shall comply with the Hon'ble Supreme Court order on regrassing, and re-grass the mining area and any other areas which may have been disturbed due to mining to restore them to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora, fauna, etc. in a timely manner;
- xiv. The cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department;
- xv. The State Government shall upload KML files of the forest area proposed for diversion and identified for carried out CA on equivalent, NFL and for balance seedling over 200 ha of degraded forest area on the E-Green watch portal with all the requisite details prior to grant of final approval;
- xvi. The all compensatory levies to be realized from the User Agency under the

project shall be transferred/ deposited, through e-challan, in to the account of National Authority, CAMPA pertaining to the State concerned through e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/);

- xvii. The User agency shall obtain the Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if required;
- xviii. The user agency shall explore the possibility of translocation of maximum number of trees identified to be felled and shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department;
- xix. Period of diversion of the said forest land under this approval shall coterminus with the period of the mining lease granted under the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, as amended and the Rules framed there-under;
- xx. The compliance report shall be uploaded on *e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/);*
- xxi. The State Government shall complete settlement of rights, in term of the Scheduled Tribes and Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006, if any, on the forest land to be diverted as per the sub-rule (7) of Rule 11 of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rules, 2023;
- xxii. Layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government;
- xxiii. No construction of buildings / no labour camp shall be established on the forest land and the User Agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas;
- xxiv. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal and under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person;
- xxv. User agency in consultation with the State Forest Department shall create and maintain alternate habitat/home for the avifauna, whose nesting tress are to be cleared in this project. Bird nests artificially made out of eco-friendly materials shall be used in the area, including forest area and human settlements, adjoining the forest area being diverted for the project;
- xxvi. The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS coordinates;
- xxvii. No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused;
- xxviii. The User Agency shall submit the annual self -compliance report in respect of the above stated conditions to the State Government, concerned Regional Office and to this Ministry by the end of March every year regularly;
- xxix. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife shall be carried with by the State Government and user agency;
- xxx. The user agency shall comply all the provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, Hon'ble Court Order (s) and NGT Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project; and.
- xxxi. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and action would be

taken as prescribed in para 1.16 of Chapter 1 of the Handbook of comprehensive guidelines of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 as issued by this Ministry's letter No. 5-2/2017-FC dated 29.12.2023.

3. After receipt of compliance report on fulfillment of the conditions mentioned above, the proposal shall be considered for final approval under Section 2 (1) (ii) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980. Transfer of forest land shall not be affected till final approval is granted by the Central Government in this regard.
