The Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Nodal Officer, Maharashtra State has submitted Proposal for diversion of 0.0785 ha. Forest land under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in favour of Mr. Laxman Kondu Chate for laying of pipeline for agricultural irrigation purpose. The details of forest land proposed for diversion are as follows:-

- The proposal is initiated by Mr. Laxman Kondu Chate for diversion of 0.0785 ha. Forest Land for laying of pipeline for agricultural irrigation. The total length of pipeline is 1970 Rmt. from which 1570 Rmt is passing through forest land.
- The area belongs to Eco-value class-III and having density greater than 0.2.
- The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Buldhana has certified that the forest land required is the barest minimum.
- There is no cutting and felling of trees involved in this project.
- The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Buldhana has certified that the proposed project is beyond 10 kms from the boundary of Protected Area (Sanctuary and National Park).
- The User Agency has submitted an undertaking to defray the cost of Net Present Value and Compensatory Afforestation.
- The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Buldhana has certified that proposed project is not likely to affect monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archaeological or recreational importance.

9. The User Agency has submitted the undertaking for certificate of Collector, Buldhana under Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dweller's (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006.
10. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Buldhana has certified that there is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980.
11. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Maharashtra State, Nagpur has recommended the proposal subject to the conditions, given in his specific recommendations, under Section-2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. His specific recommendations are enclosed in the proposal.
12. In the circumstances explained in aforesaid paragraphs and enclosures, the State Government recommends that the said Forest land may be allowed to be diverted subject to the conditions proposed by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Maharashtra State, Nagpur. The matter may kindly be placed before the Government of India for its approval under Section-2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, be obtained and communicated to this Government.
