1. Adverting to the subject and references cited, It is to submit that Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate change, Integrated Regional Office Hyderabad vide reference 1st cited has accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 4.739 Ha. (revised from 4.971 Ha) of Forest land for widening of single lane to double lane road for connecting Mandal Head Quarter to District Head Quarter from Sirikonda to Vemulawada road of Nizamabad District in favour of Executive Engineer, R&B Division, Nizamabad, subject to the compliance of the certain conditions mentioned therein and which has been communicated by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Telangana, Hyderabad, vide reference 2nd cited for raising of demand notice to user agency for making payment of compensatory, levies in consultation with the Nodal Officer (ECA) and to obtain the compliance report on the conditions stipulated in stage-I (in-principle) approval by the MoEF & CC, GoI, from the user Agency and furnish through Chief Conservator of Forests, Nizamabad Circle, Nizamabad for obtaining Stage II (final) approval.

2. The Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad has further requested the District Forest Officers to issue the demand notice to the User Agency in consultation with Nodal Officer for Forests (Conservation) Act, 1980 for payment of Net Present Value (NPV), Cost of CA and Cost of Construction of Boundary pillars etc., and issue the demand notice to the User Agency only after vetting by the Nodal Officer.

Accordingly, after consultation with the Nodal Officer (FCA) o/o PCCF Telangana the following amount estimated towards compensatory levies to be paid by the User Agency and is submitted for vetting.

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- 2.b) In Part-II due to problems of encroachment/smuggling and inter district border the Forest Monitoring and Protection with Base Camp Watchers was proposed for Rs.72.622 lakhs and this may be additionally imposed after getting clearance from the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, (HoFF), T.S. Hyderabad / Regional Officer, MoEF. This was also clearly mentioned in the Inspection Notes of Deputy Conservator of Forests/District Forest Officer, Nizamabad.
- 4. Further, the User Agency will also be requested comply with the following in accordance with the MoEF & CC, GoI instructions issued vide F.No.4-TSB262/2022-HYD/423,Dt.06.04.2022 communicated *vide* PCCF, Hyderabad Rc.No.12925/2020/FCA-1, Dt: 07.04.2022.
- a) Publish the entire forest clearances granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purpose in verbatim along with the conditions and safe-guards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspaper i.e., one in vernacular language and the other in English.
- b) The copies of the clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days from the date of receipt of this reference.

The transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final-(Stage II) approval or working permission, whichever is earlier.

In view of the above, it is requested to kindly accord permission to raise the above demand notice to the user agency for further necessary action.
