iii	a) Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 3.00 ha. non-forest land in Gut no. 199 & 286 at Village- Pukalewadi, Taluka-Maan, District Satara. Suitability certificate has been submitted by DCF concerned. Certificate to defray the cost of CA is also submitted by the User Agency at the cost of the User Agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species along with 10% RET species of Satara District shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided. Twenty-Four Lakh Forty-Two Thousand Three Hundred Forty only) in CAMPA Account.
	b) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.	User Agency should submit undertaking.

xvii	The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.	User Agency should submit undertaking.
Xviii	No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.	User Agency should submit undertaking.
Xix	Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel. shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.	User Agency should submit undertaking.
Xx	The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.	User Agency should submit undertaking.
Xxi	No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.	User Agency should submit undertaking.
Xxii	The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less.	User Agency should submit undertaking.
Xxiii	The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.	User Agency should submit undertaking.
Xxiv	The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Govt. of India.	User Agency should submit undertaking.
