Adverting to the subject and references cited, it is informed that, the Government of India, MoEF, Chennai vide reference 1st cited, has accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval for "Diversion of 3.1346 ha Forest Land in Nalgonda District for laying of pipeline/jack Well/ Pump House, etc., for Nellikal Lift Irrigation Scheme in favour of EE, TSIDC, Miryalaguda" subject to conditions stipulated therein; which has been communicated in ref 2nd cited by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF) with instructions to raise the demand notice to the user agency for making payment of compensatory levies for deposition into respective accounts in consultation with the Nodal Officer (FCA): and to obtain the compliance on the conditions stipulated from the user agency and furnish for onward submission to the Government for obtaining Stage - II approval.

Accordingly, the demand notice is prepared and issued to User agency by the then FDO, WLM Nagarjunasagar vide reference 5th cited for an amount of Rs.1,94,83,891/- towards Compensatory Afforestation, Rs.14,98,423/- towards extraction charges & Boundary pillars and Rs.30,00,000/- towards Wildlife Mitigation measures.

Further it is submitted that, through the reference 6th cited above, the Executive Engineer, Irrigation Division No.2, Miryalaguda had requested to issue revised demand notice for making payment of compensatory levies. Accordingly, vide this office reference 7th cited above, instructions were issued to the FDO, WLM Nagarjunasagar to submit the detailed CA scheme along with soil suitability certificate for taking further necessary action.

Accordingly, through the reference 8th cited above, FDO, WLM Nagarjunasagar had submitted the revised demand notice. As per the demand notice prepared by the FDO, WLM Nagarjunasagar, vide reference 10th cited above, a draft demand notice was submitted to the Conservator of Forests/ FDPT, ATR Circle, Achampet for approval/vetting.

Accordingly, vide reference 11th cited above, Conservator of Forests/FDPT, ATR Circle, Achampet had accorded permission with instructions to issue to the demand notice to the UA as detailed below:

In this regard, the user agency is directed to deposit an amount of Rs. **3,71,27,423/-** in the Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) saving bank account through online mode only, through e-portal method at MoEF & CC, GOI, New Delhi portal i.e., <http://parivesh.nic.in>, by generating the challan in consultation with Nodal Officer, Telangana State Forest Department. The User agency need to upload the demand notice against the Project for approval by Nodal Officer (FCA), Telangana and generate challan after approval. The payment to be made against the challan number and the challan is valid for one week. A step- by-step process is available at <http://parivesh.nic.in>.

Further the User Agency is directed to deposit the other compensatory levies into respective accounts as indicated in Table I.

The user agency is also requested to comply with the following in accordance with the Gol instructions issued vide F.No. 7-23-2012-FC, Dt: 24.07.2013 communicated vide Prl.CCF, AP, Hyd Rc.No. 45921/2001-F4, dt: 23.08.2013, at the cost of the Project proponent:

1. Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safe guard imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers one in vernacular language and the other in English language so as to make people aware of permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non-forest purposes.

2. The copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayaths and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

Further the UA is requested to comply with the other conditions along with the undertakings wherever required as directed in ref 1st and 2nd cited and other conditions stipulated by NBWL, Part II/III/IV/V and submit compliance report on the conditions stipulated by the Govt. for obtaining Stage-II (final) approval.

Further the UA is informed that, after receipt of the compliance report on the above-mentioned conditions the proposals will be considered for final approval. Transfer of forest land to the user agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final approval. This in-principal approval is valid for the period of (5) years. In the event of noncompliance of the above conditions, this in-principal approval shall automatically stand revoked after (5) years.
