Subject: Diversion of 0.1 ha of forest land in Kottiyoor Range of Kannur Forest Division for reconstruction of Chekkupalam on Thalassery-Irikkur Road in favour of the Assistant Engineer, Bridges Section, Thalassery Public Works Department - reg.

Sir,

Please refer to the State Government's letter No.C3/130/2019/F&WLD dated 13/11/2019 on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section '2' of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The in-principle (Stage-I) approval to the project was accorded by the Central Government vide letter of even number dated 18th December, 2019. The State Government vide letter No. No.C3/130/2019/F&WLD dated 29/01/2025 reported compliance to the conditions stipulated by the Central Government in the in-principle approval.

After careful consideration of the proposal of the State Government, I am directed to convey Central Government's final approval (Stage-II) under Section '2(1)' of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 for diversion of 0.1 ha. of forest land in Kottiyoor Range of Kannur Forest Division for reconstruction of Chekkupalam on Thalassery-Irikkur Road in favour of the Assistant Engineer, Bridges Section, Thalassery Public Works Department, subject to the following conditions:-

1. The legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost as per the directions of concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
3. Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from the user agency.

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4. Tree felling shall be restricted to the barest minimum possible and under confirmation from the local forest officials.
5. Compensatory Afforestation i.e ten times of no. of trees to be felled shall be carried out on land identified by the State Forest Department within 2 years from grant of final approval at the cost of user agency.
6. The KML file of the area diverted and CA plantation (ten times the no. of trees to be felled) shall be uploaded on the e-green watch portal with all requisite details before issue of final approval by the State Government.
7. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
8. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
9. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
10. No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused.
11. The forest area shall be used for the purpose for which it is granted. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 0.1 ha.
12. The area utilized for the old bridge shall be designated as forest in the Government records.
13. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, Department or person without prior approval of Government of India.
14. The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is lesser.
15. The concerned Divisional Forest Officer, will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forest in the surrounding area.
16. The User Agency shall submit the annual self-compliance report in respect of the above stated conditions to the State Government and Integrated Regional Office, Bangalore by the end of March every year.
17. The State Government and user agency shall comply the provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT order & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
18. Any other condition that the Regional Office of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Bengaluru may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of Forest and Wildlife.
19. The State Govt. shall ensure that the complete compliance of FRA 2006 as per the rule 11 (7) of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rules 2023
20. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed under the Act, Rules and Guidelines relevant.
