(v)	The DFO, Golaghat Division has demarcated the proposed forest land for diversion on ground by erecting 4' high cement concrete pillars duly numbered with forward and backward bearing and distance from pillar to pillar written on them. The fund for demarcation and erection of boundary pillars has been provided by the user agency. The certificate of the Conservator of Forests, Eastern Assam Circle, Jorhat verifying the demarcation of the boundary and fixing of boundary pillars on the proposed forest area is enclosed herewith as Annex - II. The GPS coordinates & photograph are enclosed herewith as Annex - III & IV respectively. The project does not require Environmental Clearance.
(vi)	The charges for felling, logging and transportation of project affected trees have been deposited by the user agency with the DFO Golaghat Division, Golaghat.
(vii)	The DFO, Golaghat Division has submitted the certificate regarding the payment in respect of condition Nos. (v) and (vi) by the user agency (copy enclosed <b>Annex-V</b> ).
(viii)	The project does not require Environmental Clearance.
(ix)	The user agency has submitted Undertaking that no labour camp shall be established in the diverted forest land (copy enclosed <b>Annex-VI</b> ).
(x)	The tree felling will be carried out under strict supervision of the Forest Department and will be reduced to the barest minimum.
(xi)	The user Agency has submitted the undertaking for sufficient quantity of firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, will be provided by User Agency to the labours after purchasing from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal agency, department or person (copy enclosed <b>Annex-VI</b> ).
(xii)	The user Agency has submitted the undertaking for forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal and under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department of person (copy enclosed <b>Annex-VI</b> ).
(xiii)	The user agency has submitted the undertaking for lay out plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government (copy enclosed <b>Annex-VI</b> ).
(xiv)	The user agency has submitted the undertaking for obtain the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 clearance for stone, river sand, river boulders in forest land (copy enclosed <b>Annex-VI</b> ).
(xv)	The user agency has submitted the undertaking that the compliance of stipulated conditions will be fulfilled as per Ministry's letter No. 1-30/96-FC(Pt), dated 14.9.2001 (copy enclosed <b>Annex-VI</b> ).
(xvi)	The user agency has submitted the undertaking for all the clearance/NOC under different applicable rules/regulation/local laws and under Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 as required vide MoEF, New Delhi guideline No. 11-9/1998-FC(Pt) dated 3.8.2009 (copy enclosed <b>Annex-VI</b> ).
