DEMAND NOTICE

Sub:- TS - FCA - Forest Conservation Act - Proposals for diversion of forest land to an extent of 2.0025 Ha. in various Forest Divisions Viz. Gudur WL (1.362 Ha.), Mahabubabad (0.131 Ha.), Yellandu (0.344 Ha.) & Warangal Rural (0.1655 Ha.) in Mahabubabad, Kothagudem and Warangal Rural Districts respectively - For laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing right of way - In favour of M/s Jio Digital Fibre Private Limited (earlier M/s Reliance Jio Infocomm Limited) - In-Principle (Stage-I) approval - Issue of Demand Notice - Submitted for vetting - Regarding.

It is submitted that vide reference 3rd cited, the Stage Government has accorded stage -I (in-principle) approval for Diversion of Forest land to an extent of 2.0025 ha in various forest divisions viz Gudur WL (1.362 ha), Mahabubabad (0.131 ha), Yellandu (0.344 Ha) Warangal (Rural) (0.1655 ha) in Mahabubabad, Kothagudem and Warangal (Rural) Districts respectively for laying of optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing Right of way in favour of M/s Jio Digital Fiber Private limited (Earlier M/s Reliance Jio Infocomm Limited), subject to fulfillment of certain conditions stipulated therein. which has been communicated in ref 4th cited by the Prl.CCF(HoFF) for raising of demand notice to user agency for making payment of compensatory levies in consultation with the Nodal Officer (FCA) and to obtain the compliance report on the conditions stipulated by the Government, from the user Agency and furnish through Chief Conservator of Forests, Kothagudem for obtaining Stage II (final) approval.

Out of which the demand notice was issued for 0.1655 Ha. pertains to Warangal Rural District. Therefore, the Demand notice for 0.1655 Ha is as follows:

Out of the above, **Rs. 5,18,015/- (Rupees Five Lakhs eighteen Thousand Fifteen only)** the User Agency has to deposit in the Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) Saving Bank Account maintained in the Corporation Bank, CGO Complex, Lodi Road, New Delhi-110003, **through online mode only, through e-portal method at MoEF & CC, GOI, New Delhi portal i.e. <http://parivesh.nic.in> by generating the challan in consultation with Nodal Officer, Telangana State Forest Department. The User agency needs to upload the demand notice against the project for approval by Nodal Officer (FCA), Telangana and generate challan after approval. The payment to be made against the Challan number and the Challan is valid for one week. A step-by-step process is available at <http://parivesh.nic.in>.**

Further, the User Agency has to deposit amount of Rs. 2,64,400/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Sixty Four Thousands Four Hundred only) in favour of District Forest Officer, Warangal Rural bearing A/c. No. 39123522963, Nakkalagutta IFSC: SBIN0020150.

✓ The User Agency has to deposit an amount of Rs. 9,00,000/- (Rupees Nine Lakhs only) into BIOSOT account of CWLW in Andhra Bank, Pattabhi Bhawan Branch, Hyderabad bearing number 110310100030284 towards implementation of WL measures as approved by SBWL.

The User Agency has to deposit an amount of Rs. 23,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Three Lakhs only) into BIOSOT account of CWLW in Andhra Bank, Pattabhi Bhawan Branch, Hyderabad bearing number 110310100030284 towards implementation of WL measures as per Part II recommendations.

Transfer of Forest land to the User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final approval. This in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of 5 years. In the event of non-compliance of the above conditions, this in-principle approval shall automatically stand revoked after (5) years.

Further, the User Agency has to comply with following in accordance with the MoEF & CC, GOI instructions issued vide F.No. 7-23-2012-FC, dated 27.07.2013 communicated vide Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, AP, Hyderabad Rc.No. 45921/2001/F4, dated 23.08.2013.

1. Publish the entire Forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the condition and safeguards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspaper one in vernacular language and the other in English granted to the project proponent for the use of Forest land for the non-forest purposes.

2. The copies of the Forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

~~The user agency must be~~ requested to comply with the other conditions as directed in references 1st and 2nd cited and submit the compliance report along with all the required relevant information/documents etc. on the conditions stipulated by the Govt. in Stage-I approval for obtaining Stage-II approval.
