With reference to the FCA Proposal No. FCA Proposal No. FP/ML/TRANS/155408/2022 for Diversion of 31.588 Ha of Deemed Forest Land for Construction of 400 KV DC Bongaigaon Nangalbibra Transmission Line by Nangalbibra Bongaigaon Transmission Limited, it is to enclose herewith the MoEFCC letter under reference granting In-principal / Stage-I Approval for the same subject to the conditions mentioned in the letter under reference and this letter.

In this regard, you are requested to submit the compliance for all the conditions mentioned in the MoEFCC letter under reference and the conditions mentioned in this letter in order to process the final approval of the above-mentioned project.

- 1. No Breaking of Land/Felling of Trees shall be carried out prior to the final approval or the explicit work order or felling order from the competent authority.
- 2. The ownership of the deemed forest land measuring 31.588 Ha to be diverted for the proposal does not belong to the State Forest Department, thus the appropriate land acquisition and payment of compensation as per the extant provisions are to be made to the land owners of the deemed forest land prior to felling of trees.
- 3. As the deemed forest land is not under the control of the State Forest Department, you are requested to carry out felling of trees at the project cost, after the payment of royalty on trees due for Government and under the supervision of the State Forest Department.
- 4. The user agency shall make deposit of the Cost of Net Present Value, Compensatory Afforestation, Dwarf Plantation, Wildlife Mitigation Measures, Royalty on Trees, Cost of Tree Marking, Piece Marking and the Cost of Boundary Pillars, Approach Road at the CA Land as mentioned in the table below and submit the proof of payment to the office of undersigned, the calculation of the components mentioned below is enclosed as Annexure- I.

- 5. The boundary of the deemed forest land proposed for diversion shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost by erecting at least 4-foot-high angle iron post or the cement concrete pillars duly numbered forward and backward bearing and distance from pillar to pillar written on the pillars and DGPS coordinates to be inscribed on the post or pillars, the photographs showing post or pillar with GPS coordinates are to be submitted.
- 6. The user agency shall submit an undertaking stating that additional amount of NPV and CA of the diverted forest land, if any becoming due after finalization of the same shall be paid.
- 7. The user agency shall submit the certificate in regard to the compliance of Forest Rights Act, 2006 from the Deputy Commissioner of East Garo Hills and North Garo Hills District or undertaking regarding applicability of the FRA, 2006 in the deemed forest land.
- 8. The user agency shall submit an undertaking to ensure that any tree felling shall be resorted only at the proposed locations when it is unavoidable and will be felled under the supervision of the staff of the East & North Garo Hills (T) Division. Special care should be taken when felling in valley portion of the RoW to ensure that trees in such depression not interfering with the line should not be cleared except for stringing purpose.
- 9. The user agency shall submit and undertaking that the Three Layer Protection measures shall be adopted to ensure complete safety and minimum interference with fauna, The measures include but not limited to barbed fencing of tower area, special tower design having soft materials anti climbing guards and anti-climbing canopy which will restrict any arboreal animals from climbing on towers, and the Ground Clearance shall be minimum of 15 meters and to provide bird deflectors which are to be fixed on upper conductor of transmission line at suitable intervals to avoid bird hits and to comply with the guidelines for laying of transmission line through forest areas issued by Ministry vide letter No.7-25/2012-FC dated 05.05.2014 and 19.11.2014.
- The user agency shall submit a copy of Environmental Clearance obtained under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 or undertaking regarding applicability of Environmental Clearance for the project.

- 11. The user agency shall submit an undertaking that no labour camp will be established inside the forest land and sufficient quantity of firewood, preferably an alternate fuel shall be provided by the user agency to the labourers while implementing the project.
- 12. The user agency shall submit an undertaking that no Stone boulder, Earth, Sand or any Minor minerals or Forest produce will be extracted/transported/utilised from the Forest Land.
- 13. The user agency shall submit an undertaking that proper drainage and retaining wall will be made for stabilization of the slope, wherever applicable.
- 14. The user agency shall submit an undertaking that the Forest land will not be used for any other purpose other than specified in the proposal and under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or a person.
- 15. The user agency shall not make any additional or new path inside the reserve forest for transportation of men and materials and the layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the competent authority.
- 16. The Legal Status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.
- 17. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 and appropriate action would be initiated.
- 18. The user agency shall submit the compliance report on the above-mentioned points and all the conditions stipulated in the Stage-I approval under reference within 30 days and the same shall be uploaded on e-portal (<u>https://parivesh.nic.in</u>).

### NET PRESENT VALUE (NPV)

The Forest area being diverted falls under the Eco Class – I – Very Dense Forest, thus as per the MoEFCC File No.5-3/2011-FC(Vol-I) dated 06.01.2022, the rate of NPV is Rs. 15,95,790/- per Ha and the NPV for 31.588 Ha is Rs.15,95,790 x 31.588 Ha = Rs. 5,04,07,815/- (Rupees Five Crore Four Lakh Seven Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifteen only).

### COMPENSATORY AFFORESTATION (CA)

As per Chapter 2.3(i) of the Handbook on FCA Guidelines, The Compensatory Afforestation with 10 years of maintenance is to be carried out in 32 Ha of Non-Forest Land located at Koknal A'king handed over by the use agency on 14<sup>th</sup> February, 2023. The CA is calculated at the rate approved vide GoM letter No.FOR.47/2020/41 dt 23.07.2021 at the rate of 2375 Mandays per Ha and additionally since the CA land is the Non-Forest Land, 2 (Two) Nos of Staff Quarters are proposed to be constructed at the CA Land for permanent station of the Forest staff.

### **DWARF PLANTATION**

As per the Part - C, Para - I (9) of the Handbook on FCA Guidelines, the Dwarf plantation the dwarf species shall be planted in the Right of Way of the Transmission Line,

The Cost of Plantation for 31.588 Ha of Dwarf Plantation as per the State Plantation Norms is Rs. 2,28,529/- per Ha.

### WILDLIFE MITIGATION MEASURES

### ROYALTY ON TREES

As the 31.588 Ha of Deemed Forest Land proposed to be diverted does not fall under the Reserve Forest or Protected Forests and the ownership of the land does not belong to the State Forest Department and the ownership might vest with the Community or an Individual, the tree felling is to be carried out by the user agency at their own cost under the supervision of the State Forest Department after depositing the Royalty.

Transmission Line does not pass through the Reserve Forest, the team has to mobilised to the felling spot and the maximum and minimum distance from the felling spot to the Division HQ is 160 Kms and 45 Kms both ways and the Mileage Allowance for the team is calculated at the rate of Rs. 12 per Kms.
