It is to inform that, the Government of Telangana vide reference 1st cited has accorded Stage - I(final) approval for diversion of 1.3237 Ha. of Forest land in favour of M/s Jio Digital Fiber Private Ltd, Hyderabad for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the roads and within the existing Right of Way subject to fulfillment of certain conditions stipulated therein. The Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests(Head of Forest Force), TS, Hyderabad have issued instructions to raise the demand notice with the user agency by the District Forest Officer, Bhadradri-Kothagudem, vide reference 2nd cited, in consultation with the Chief Conservator of Forests, Kothagudem after approval from Nodal Officer (FCA), for making payment of compensatory levies by the M/s Jio Digital Fiber Private Ltd, Hyderabad (User Agency) and obtain the compliance report from the User Agency and furnish through Chief Conservator of Forests, Kothagudem for obtaining Stage-II (in-principle) approval from the Government.

The User agency is requested to make the payment against the demand notice raised and furnish the details of payment along with the UTR number, date, amount transferred etc., to this office at the earliest.

Further, the User Agency is requested to comply with the following in accordance with the MoEF&CC, GoI instructions issued vide F.No.7-23-2012-FC, dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide Prl.Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF) Hyderabad Rc.No.45921/2001/F4, dt.23.08.2013:

- Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the condition and safe-guards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspaper one is vernacular language and the other in English granted to the Project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes.
- The copies of the forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

Further the User Agency is requested to furnish the condition wise compliance report along with undertakings and documents as per the conditions stipulated in the Stage-II (final) approval.

Further the User Agency is informed that the transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final approval stage-II (final) clearance and no work in violation shall be carried out.
