विषय: Diversion of 63.6807 ha. of forest land in favour of National Highways Authority of India PIU Hanumangarh for construction of approach road for construction of 4/6 lane road from Choutala in Sirsa district in the state of Haryana to Rasiser in Bikaner district in the state of Rajasthan from CH(0.300) km to 252.500 km. this is a part of Amritsar to Kandla express way under Bharatmala Pariyojna.

सन्दर्भ:-आपका पत्रांक प.1(40)वन/2020 पार्ट-I दिनांक 10.08.2020

महोदय,

उपरोक्त विषयक शासन सचिव, वन विभाग, जयपुर के पत्रांक प.1(40)वन/2020 दिनांक 01.07.2020 का आशय ग्रहण करने का कष्ट करें जिसके द्वारा विषयांकित प्रकरण में वन (संरक्षण) अधिनियम, 1980 की धारा (2) के अन्तर्गत भारत सरकार की स्वीकृति माँगी थी।

प्रकरण को दिनांक 25.08.2020 को आहूत की गयी क्षेत्रीय सशक्त समिति (REC) की बैठक में (REC Agenda item 49.3-RAJ) शामिल किया गया था, बैठक में प्रकरण को स्वीकृति प्रदान की गयी है। क्षेत्रीय सशक्त समिति की स्वीकृति उपरान्त मुझे आपको यह सूचित करने का निर्देश हुआ है कि केन्द्र सरकार उपरोक्त विषयांकित परियोजना हेतु 63.6807 हे० वनभूमि के प्रत्यावर्तन एवं 9096 वृक्षों के पातन की सैद्धान्तिक स्वीकृति निम्नलिखित शर्तों पर प्रदान करती है:-

1. Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 127.5152 ha degraded forest land (Compartment/ Khasra No.1, Village Chak 329.700 RD & 244 RD, Tehsil Lunkaransar, District-Bikaner), (Compartment/ Khasra No.1, Village Sonari Meghsinghpura, Tehsil Nohar, District Hanumangarh), (Compartment/ Khasra No.3PPN, Village 3PPN, Tehsil Suratgarh, District Sriganganagar) at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
3. The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.
4. The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 63.6807 ha. forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the user agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in IA No. 566 in WP (C) No. 202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No. 5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II) dated 18/09/2003, as well as letter No. 5-2/2006-FC dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007-FC dated 05/02/2009 in this regard.

5. Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
6. User agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
7. As far as possible maximum number of trees shall be translocated according to detailed scheme for translocation of suitable plants prepared in consultation with the State Forest Department and the cost for the same shall be borne by the user Agency.
8. Road side plantation shall be done according to a scheme for Road side plantation as per IRC norms prepared in consultation with the State Forest Department and the cost for the same shall be borne by the user Agency.
9. The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.
10. User agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road as per the IRC norms.
11. Speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Protected Areas/ Forest Areas.
12. The user agency shall provide suitable under/over pass in Protected Area/Forest Area as per recommendations of CWLW / NBWL / FAC / REC.
13. User Agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.
14. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
15. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
16. Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
17. The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
18. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
19. The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less.
20. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
21. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Govt. of India.
22. DFO should submit a certificate, certifying that no work has been executed in violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in the said proposal.
23. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guideline F. No. 11-42/2017-FC dt 29/01/2018.
24. Before the sanction of this project, user agency must take approval from State Government as per Aravali Notification dated 07.05.1992.
25. The Project Proponent (NHAI) must allow free movement of vehicles of the Forest Department on official duty.

26. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
27. All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/ deposited to CAMPA fund only through **e-portal** (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>).
28. The compliance report shall be uploaded on **e-portal** (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>).

After receipt of the compliance report from the State Government on fulfillment of the conditions mentioned above, final/stage-II approval of the Central Government, in accordance with Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, will be accorded.
