Sub: Diversion of 1.9425 ha of Forest Land in favour of The Executive Engineer (B & C) Zila Parishad, Pune (South) for joining SH-121, Baramati-Indapur to MDR159 Nimgaon Ketaki-Bijawadi road named as village road no. 3 at Village-Gokhali and Tarangewadi, Tal- Indapur in Pune District in the State of Maharashtra – regarding

Sir,

The undersigned is directed to refer to the APCCF & Nodal Officer (FCA), Maharashtra letter No. Desk-17/NC/II/ID 12785/(20)/369/2020-21 dated 13.08.2020 on the above subject seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section – 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. After careful examination of the proposal of the State Government, '**in-principle**' approval was accorded by the Central Government vide its letter of even number dated 14.01.2021. The Addl. PCCF & Nodal Officer (FCA), Government of Maharashtra has now submitted a report on the compliance of conditions stipulated in the 'in-principle' approval and requested the Central Government to grant final approval to the proposal.

In this connection, I am directed to say that on the basis of compliance report submitted by the Addl. PCCF & Nodal Officer (FCA), Government of Maharashtra letter no. Desk-17/NC/2/ID-12647(66)/255/2021-22 dated 08.06.2021, letter no. Desk-17/Nodal/Pune/ID-12785(20)/1163/2021-22 dated 07.10.2021 and letter no. Desk-17/Nodal/Pune/ID-12785(20)/2426/21-22 dated 15.02.2022 forwarding additional information as sought vide this office letter dated 26.07.2021 and 22.12.2021, the Central Government hereby accords '**final approval**' under Section – 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 1.9425 ha of Forest Land in favour of The Executive Engineer (B & C) Zila Parishad, Pune (South) for joining SH-121, Baramati-Indapur to MDR159 Nimgaon Ketaki-Bijawadi road named as village road no. 3 at Village- Gokhali and Tarangewadi, Tal- Indapur in Pune District in the State of Maharashtra in the State of Maharashtra subject to following conditions:

- i. Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged;
- ii. Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over by the User Agency;
- iii. **Compensatory afforestation:**
 - a. Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 1.9425 ha non forest land of Gut No. 51 at Village– Pale N.M., Taluka- Maval,

District- Pune at the cost of the User Agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species along with 10% RET species of Pune District shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided. Atleast one water body shall be constructed in the form of tank/ stop dams etc if the same are not available in the area or in nearby vicinity;


- b. The non-forest land which has been transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department for the purpose of compensatory afforestation shall be declared as Reserved Forest under Section-4 or Protected Forest under Section-29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 or under the relevant Section(s) of the State Forest Act. The Nodal Officer, Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 may report compliance within a period of six (6) months from the date of grant of final approval and send a copy of the original notification declaring the non-forest land under Section 4 or Section 29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927, or under the relevant section of the State Forest Act as the case may be, to this Office for information and record;
- iv. No tree felling or cutting shall be permitted under instant proposal;
- v. The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector;
- vi. To improve the Forest/ Tree cover and to reduce pollution in the State, as mandated in National Forest Policy, 1988 and Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 respectively, the User Agency with involvement of Joint Forest Management Committees (JFMC's) and in consultation with local DCF shall raise at least 3,000 seedlings of forestry species along with bamboo, fruit bearing, medicinal, ornamental and indigenous/local for 10 years. At least 50% of seedlings shall be planted in the vicinity of project area and remaining 50% of seedlings shall be distributed among villagers as per choice of villagers. The concerned JFMC's shall maintain record of plantation/ seedling distribution to villagers;
- vii. State Forest Department shall undertake avenue plantation of 8 feet tall plants as per IRC norms at the cost of User Agency;
- viii. Speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Protected Areas/ Forest Areas;
- ix. The User Agency in consultation with Forest Department shall provide under/ over pass for safe passage of wild animals at suitable places as per Wildlife Institute of India's manual entitled "Eco-friendly Measures to Mitigate Impacts of Linear Infrastructure on Wildlife" published in 2016;
- x. User Agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable;
- xi. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government;
- xii. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land;
- xiii. Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel;
- xiv. The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer;



- xv. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work;
- xvi. The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less;
- xvii. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal;
- xviii. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Govt. of India;
- xix. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guideline F. No. 11-42/2017-FC dt 29/01/2018;
- xx. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife;


