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iv) felling of trees shall be restricted to only 2,408 trees, throughout the length of the transmission line while remaining 3,171 trees will be kept intact by the User Agency. Any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department;

v) To minimize the felling for construction of transmission line, user agency shall comply with the following guidelines:

(a) Below each conductor, width clearance of 3 mts. would be permitted for carrying the tension stringing equipment. The trees on such strips may be felled but after stringing work is completed, the natural regeneration will be allowed to come up.

(b) One outer strip may be left clear to permit maintenance of the transmission line;

(c) In the remaining width the right of way felling /pollarding /pruning of trees will be done with the permission of the local forest officer whenever necessary to maintain the electrical clearance, trees shall be allowed to be felled or lopped to the extent required, for preventing electrical hazards by maintaining the minimum 4.6 meter clearance between conductors and trees. The sag and swing of the conductors are to be kept in view while working out the minimum clearance mentioned as above;

(d) User agency in consultation with the State Forest department prepare a detailed scheme for creation and maintenance of plantation of dwarf species (preferably medicinal plants) in right of way under the transmission line, and provide funds for execution of the said scheme to the State Forest Department ; and

(e) In case a portion of the transmission lines to be constructed is located in hilly areas, where adequate clearance is already available, trees shall not be cut;

Accepted. This is to undertake by the user agency that the felling of trees shall be restricted to only 2408 trees, throughout the length of transmission line while remaining 3171 trees will be kept intact by the user agency. Any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the state forest department.

Accepted. This is to undertake by the user agency that to minimize the felling for construction of transmission line, the user agency shall comply with the following guidelines:

(a) Below each conductor, width clearance of 3 mts. would be permitted for carrying the tension stringing equipment. The tree on such strips may be felled but after stringing work is completed the natural regeneration will be allowed to come up.

(b) One outer strip may be left clear to permit maintenance of the transmission line.

This is to undertake that the user agency shall submit six monthly self compliance report as on 1 st January and 1 st July of every year to MOEF as well as to the nodal officer of the state.
(xix)	The State Government shall monitor compliance of conditions of Forest Clearance and shall submit in this regard yearly report as on 31 st December of every year;	Accepted. This is pertains to the State Forest Department.
(xx)	Any other condition that the concerned Regional Office of this Ministry may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife;	Accepted. This is to undertake by the user agency that any other condition that the concern Regional Office of the Ministry may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation and development of forests and wildlife shall be fulfill by the user agency.
(xxi)	The User Agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project; and	Accepted.
