May kindly peruse the letter No. NHAI/PIU-Surat(Expressway)/FR-02/2018/4499 dated 2308.2018 received from General Manager (T) & Project Director, National Highway, PIU- Surat (Expressway) regarding compliance of In-Principle Approval of Diversion of 0.54 Ha. of Protected Forest Land for the development of Vadodara –Mumbai Expressway(Phase- I) from 104 + 700 Km. to 378 + 722 Km. passing through States of Gujarat, Maharashtra and U.T. of Dadra & Nagar Haveli .

i.	The legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged i.e shall remain Reserve / Protected / Village/ other types if forests/forest as the case may be.	Agreed by User Agency
ii.	The project should not involve felling of more than fifty trees per hectare. Corresponding permissible limit of maximum number of the trees to be felled for the forest area diverted, shall be in proportion to the extent of the diverted areas.	Agreed by User Agency
iii.	Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up the by the Forest department at the cost of the user agency and the same shall be maintained for 10 years. Only indigenous forest tree species shall be used for such plantation. Trees, if planted on the diverted area, will not be felled without the permission of the Forest Department. iv.	The user agency shall pay the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land at the rates stipulated by the Ministry of the Environment and Forests from time to time. v.	Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert committee shall be charged by the State Government from the user agency . The User agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.	The undertaking for the same is submitted. May please be seen at page C/49.
vi.	The User agency shall be responsible for any loss to the flora/fauna in the surroundings and therefore, shall take all possible measures to conserve the same.	Agreed by the User Agency The best possible and strict measures shall be taken to conserve the flora/fauna during construction.
vii.	The User agency shall obtain the Environmental Clearance before the formal order if applicable.	Environmental Clearance is obtained as stated by User Agency.
viii.	All statutory provisions under various acts, Rule there under and guidelines applicable to this project shall be strictly adhered to.	Agreed by the User Agency.
ix.	All the fund received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred to the Ad-hoc Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management & Planning Agency (CAMPA) in Saving Bank A/c No. SB01025204 (CAF D&NH) in Corporation Bank , Lodhi Complex , New Delhi – 110003.	The payment has been transferred towards the details mentioned in the challan generated from the website.

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x.	The User agency has to pay Rs 5,07,060/- towards Net Present value of land and Rs. 11,04,929/- towards Compensatory Afforestation including maintenance for 10 years.	The payment has been transferred towards the details mentioned in the challan generated from the website.
xi.	The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.	Agreed by the User Agency.
