Sub: TS – Forest (Conservation) Act – Proposal for diversion of 0.9999 Ha of forest land in Mulug Division of Mulug District for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road side within the existing Right of Way for execution of T-Fiber project in favour of M/s Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited, Hyderabad – In Principle (Stage-I) approval accorded – **Revised Demand notice issued** – Regarding.

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With reference to the subject cited above, the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) Telangana, Hyderabad vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited above has instructed to inspect the proposed diversion of 0.9999 Ha of forest land in Mulug Forest Division of Mulug District in favour of M/s Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited, Hyderabad.

Further the Government of Telangana vide reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited has issued In Principle (Stage-I) approval and the same is communicated by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF) Telangana, Hyderabad vide reference 5<sup>th</sup> cited above. Further the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF) Telangana, Hyderabad has also issued instructions to raise the demand notice to the M/s Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited, Hyderabad (User Agency) in consultation with the Chief Conservator of Forests, Warangal and the Nodal Officer (FCA) as per the conditions issued vide reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited above, and to obtain the compliance report from the User Agency and furnish through Chief Conservator of Forests, Warangal for obtaining Stage-II (final) approval.

Accordingly, the demand notice to be raised over the User Agency is prepared and the details are as follows:

The User Agency will be directed to deposit the compensatory levies towards CA, NPV etc., into the Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) saving bank Account maintained in the Corporation Bank, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi-110003, through online mode only, through e-portal method at MoEF&CC, GOI, New Delhi portal i.e., <http://parivesh.nic.in> by generating the challan in consultation with Nodal Officer, Telangana State Forest Department. The user agency needs to upload the demand notice against the project for approval by Nodal Officer (FCA), Telangana and generate challan after approval. The payment to be made against the Challan number and the Challan is valid for one week. A step-by-step process is available at <http://parivesh.nic.in>.

Further it is submitted that, as per the Circular instructions vide PCCF, TS HYD, Rc. No. 03/2015/FCA-1, 13.09.2017 erecting of Reinforced cement concrete pillars have been calculated and the charges has to be paid by the user agency in **Forest Divisional Officer, Mulug, SBH Mulug Ac. No. 39872722946 IFSC Code. SBHY0020157**. The details of demand notice is as shown below.

Further, the User Agency has to comply with following in accordance with the MoEF&CC, GoI instructions issued vide F.no.7-23-2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P. Hyderabad Rc.No.45921/2001/F4, Dt.23.08.2013:

- Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the condition and safe-guards imposed by the Central government in two widely circulated daily newspaper one is vernacular language and the other in English granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes.

b) The copies of the forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days. Further, the User Agency has to furnish the compliance on the conditions stipulated in the Stage I approval for onward submission to Government for obtaining Stage-II approval.

The transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final (Stage II) approval or working permission.

Therefore, the user agency i.e., M/s. Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited is requested to submit condition-wise compliance report with documentary evidence together with press clipping publishing the entire forest clearances granted to the project proponent and ensure that (4) sets of condition-wise compliance together with calculation sheet of payments details, undertakings, press clippings etc., shall be received in this office so as to forward the same to the higher authorities for obtaining Stage-II (final) approval from the competent authority.
