विषय: Diversion of 13.015 ha of forest land in favour of NRSS XXXVI, Transmission Limited, New Delhi for construction of 400 KV D/C Babai (RRVPL)- Bhiwani (PGCIL) Transmission Line in Jhunjhunu District.

सन्दर्भ: शासन सचिव, वन विभाग, राजस्थान सरकार, जयपुर के पत्रांक प.1(20)वन/2018 दिनांक 22.03.2024 एवं समसंख्यक पत्र दिनांक 05.02.2026.

महोदय,

उपरोक्त विषयक शासन सचिव, वन विभाग, राजस्थान सरकार, जयपुर के पत्रांक प.1(20)वन/2018 दिनांक 03.07.2018 का आशय ग्रहण करने का कष्ट करें जिसके माध्यम से राज्य सरकार द्वारा विषयांकित प्रस्ताव पर केन्द्र सरकार से वन (संरक्षण एवं संवर्धन) अधिनियम, 1980 की धारा (2) के तहत स्वीकृति मांगी गयी थी।

प्रश्नगत प्रकरण में इस कार्यालय के समसंख्यक पत्र दिनांक 06.07.2018 एवं 14.02.2019 द्वारा सैद्धांतिक स्वीकृति प्रदान की गई थी जिसकी अनुपालना उपरोक्त संदर्भित पत्र द्वारा प्रेषित की गयी है। प्रस्तुत अनुपालना के अवलोकन पश्चात्, केन्द्र सरकार उपरोक्त विषयांकित परियोजना हेतु 13.015 हे० वनभूमि के प्रत्यावर्तन एवं 56 वृक्ष एवं 12 पोल के पातन की विधिवत् स्वीकृति (Final/ Stage-II Approval) निम्नलिखित शर्तों पर प्रदान करती है:-

1. Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 13.015 Ha and the forest area diverted shall not be used for any purpose other than those shown in the diversion proposal
3. Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 26.10 ha degraded forest land, Compartment No. 04, Range- Khetri, Forest Division- Jhunjhunu, Circle- Jaipur of Rajasthan at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
4. The compensatory afforestation scheme, as approved, shall be implemented by the State Forest Department at the project cost within a period of three years from the date of grant of 'Final' approval. The approved CA land and CA scheme shall not be changed by the State Government without taking prior approval of the Central Government
5. User agency has deposited Rs. 97,83,600/- towards CA, Rs. 2,68,07,198/- towards NPV and Rs. 85,12,083/- towards Medicinal

- Plantation in the State/UT CAMPA account.
6. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land and the User Agency shall provide firewood preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas;
 7. Permanent boundary demarcation pillars shall be fixed for the diverted forest land as prescribed in the Stage-I approval.
 8. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal;
 9. The User Agency shall ensure that because of this project, no damage is caused to the wildlife available in the area;
 10. The user agency shall explore the possibility of translocation of maximum number of trees identified to be felled and shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department;
 11. The layout plan of the proposal and the land use plan shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government;
 12. The forest land diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government;
 13. The User Agency shall implement the R & R Plan, if applicable, as per the R & R Policy of State Government in consonance with National R&R Policy, Government of India before the commencement of the project work and implementation. The said R & R Plan will be monitored by the State Government/Regional Office of MoEF&CC;
 14. Any other condition that the concerned Regional Office of this Ministry/State Govt may stipulate with the approval of competent authority in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife;
 15. The State Government, before issuing the final diversion order, shall ensure that the user agency has complied with all the provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, Hon'ble Court Order (s) and NGT Order (s), including compliance of Forest Rights Act, 2006, pertaining to this project, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project; and
 16. User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to 68 /minimum numbers in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
 17. The User Agency shall submit the annual self -compliance report in respect of the conditions stipulated to the State Government and the Regional Office by the end of March every year regularly;
 18. The State forest Department/ DFO shall monitor the conditions stipulated in the proposal on annual basis and submit report to the Regional Office.
 19. The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less
 20. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed in the Comprehensive Guidelines of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 as issued by the Ministry.

21. The User Agency shall comply with the guidelines for laying transmission lines through forest areas issued by Ministry vide letter No.7-25/2012-FC dated 05/05/2014 & 19/11/2014.
22. The user agency at its cost shall provide bird deflectors, which are to be fixed on conductors of transmission line at suitable intervals to avoid bird hits in consultation with the state forest department depending on the requirement
23. Width of right of way for the transmission line shall be limited to 46 m;
24. The user agency shall install circuit breakers at suitable places besides maintain necessary ground clearance to prevent electrocution of wild animals;
25. No approach road shall be constructed in the forest area for transportation of steel and other material required for the transmission line. As far as possible the User Agency shall use the existing road and the proposed RoW for the transportation of the material and in the event of non-availability of such facilities, the User Agency shall transport material manually/ through Drones without construction of any path in the forest land.
26. To minimize the felling for construction of transmission line, user agency shall comply with the following guidelines:
 - (a) Below each conductor, width clearance of 07 mts. would be permitted for carrying the tension stringing equipment. The trees on such strips may be felled but after stringing work is completed, the natural regeneration will be allowed to come up.
 - (b) One outer strip may be left clear to permit maintenance of the transmission line;
 - (c) In the remaining width the right of way felling/pollarding/pruning of trees will be done with the permission of the local forest officer whenever necessary to maintain the electrical clearance, trees shall be allowed to be felled or lopped to the extent required, for preventing electrical hazards by maintaining the minimum 07 meter clearance between conductors and trees. The sag and swing of the conductors are to be kept in view while working out the minimum clearance mentioned as above;
 - (d) User agency in consultation with the State Forest Department prepare a detailed scheme for creation and maintenance of plantation of dwarf species (preferably medicinal plants) in right of way under the transmission line, and provide funds for execution of the said scheme to the State Forest Department; and
 - (e) In case a portion of the transmission lines to be constructed is located in hilly areas, where adequate clearance is already available, trees shall not be cut;
27. **The User Agency shall provide CA in NFL area for compensatory afforestation in lieu of the forest area diverted, if applicable, based on the final outcome in the WP No.1164/2023, which is currently pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The State Forest Department shall ensure that an undertaking from the user agency is obtained in this regard.**
28. **All the conditions stipulated in para 52.3.5 of the minutes of the 52^d meeting of the Standing Committee of the National Board for Wildlife dated 10.01.2019 shall be ensured to be complied with.**
29. The trees with bird nests, reptiles and habitat of Wildlife was observed than

such tree shall be treated with special care for relocation in the forest land by Forest Department at the cost of User Agency.

30. All the conditions of Stage-I/ In-principle approval shall be strictly complied.
31. The state government shall realize the revised rate of NPV as applicable (if the realized NPV is at pre-revised rate) as the compliance is submitted after lapse of 5 years validity.
