## **Demand Notice**

It is informed that, in the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, the Government of Andhra Pradesh have issued a memo where in the Government of India, MoEF & CC, IRO, Vijayawada have accorded in principal (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 2.24 ha of forest land for Rehabilitation and up-gradation to two lane with paved shoulder configuration of Paderu to Araku Section of NH-516Ein the State of Andhra Pradesh from Km 2.400 to Km 51.722 in Compt. No. 69 and 70, Arama RF and Compt. No. 62 of Kuridi RF in Araku Range of Paderu Division in favour of Project Director, (MORTH) Project Implementation Unit, Araku subject to fulfillment of approval under section certain conditions as stipulated therein.

Hence, the Project Director, (MORTH), PIU, Araku is requested to go through the conditions stipulated from i to xxiii in the Govt. Memo no. 2922/Section.II/2022/1919419, EFS & T (Section-II) Dept., dated: 19.01.2023 as per reference 2nd cited and also follow the instructions issued by the Prl.Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF) A.P. Guntur without any deviation as given below.

1) Publish the entire forest clearance granted in verbatim along with the condition and safe guads imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers, one in vernacular language and another in English language so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non-forestry purpose. 2) The copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Muncipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn have to display the same for 30 days.

Further per the condition no (V)the user agency shall pay the Net Present Value of the diverted forest land measuring 2.24 ha from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA Nos. 826 in 566 with related IA's in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202/1995 and Ministry's guideline No. 5-3/2011-FC (Vol-I) dated 06.01.2022 and clarification issued vide letter dated 19.0.2022 and 22.03.2022.

As per the condition no (VI) additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect. The NPV rates have been revised vide Gol, MoEF & CC, New Delhi File no.5-3/2011-FC(Vol-I), dt.06.01.2022 communicated in PCCF & HoFF, A.P., Guntur Ref.no.EFS02-15032/1/2022-FCA, dt.18.01.2022.

## I. (a) Procedure for e- challan generation:

- i. On issue of this demand notice, the user agency shall log in to <a href="www.parivesh.nic.in">www.parivesh.nic.in</a> to generate e-challan and make payment against the demand.
- ii. Agency shall fill all the details as per the format provided in the portal and submit to Nodal Officer for verification.

Once it is verified by Nodal Officer, Agency can generate e-challan from the portal. iii.

## I. (b) Procedure for Payment through RTGS:

- For payment through RTGS, the representative of the agency should visit his bank branch (RTGS enabled) of a Bank of his choice along with printed echallan with an Account Number printed on it.
- While tendering the e-challan at the bank, the agency must ensure that the unique account number mentioned in the challan should be correctly mentioned as the account number in which funds to be remitted.
- Upon executing the RTGS by the sender/ remitter bank, the amount collected will be vi. credited to relevant CAMPA state account with the Bank on real time basis.

Further, it is informed that if any payment is made by any other method, the same shall not be considered for compliance towards Stage I/II and also submit the receipts along with the compliance report as the conditions stipulated in the references cited point wise for onward submission to the Prl.Chief Conservator of Forests (HOFF) A.P. Guntur for further action in the matter. The condition-wise compliance report shall invariably be submitted in PARVESH portal too.
