ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR: MANIPUR

No.20/42/2021-For&Envt: In pursuance of the letter No.7/274/2021/Forests/276, dated 21/04/2021 from Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Manipur, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to accord general approval (stage –1) under section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act 1980 for the diversion of 0.37 ha of forest land for construction of Water Supply Scheme at Lamlongei, Manipur under DFO/Central Forest Division, Imphal West, Manipur subject to the following conditions:-

- 1) The legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.
- 2) The User Agency shall physically demarcate the diverted forest area by constructing RCC boundary pillars, Protection walls/Retaining walls shall be constructed at the project costs at vulnerable points to prevent land slides and soil erosion.
- 3) The User Agency shall take adequate fire protection measures during the dry seasons.
- 4) Unauthorised establishment of labour camps/huts etc shall not be allowed inside and adjoining forest areas.
- 5) The project involve felling of trees as reported by the Divisional Forest Officer, Central Forest Division and USER Agency shall pay the costs of extraction of the trees to be affected (As indicated at FORM-A: Part-III).
- 6) The concerned Divisional Forest Officer has assessed the bare minimum requirement of the forest land for the project.
- 7) The Nodal Officer, FCA shall submit monthly report to the Regional Office of MoEF & CC, Shillong regarding approval of the project.
- 8) User Agency shall be responsible for any loss of the flora and fauna in the surrounding area and therefore, shall take all possible measures to conserve the same.
- 9) User Agency shall pay the Net Present Value (NPV)/additional Net present value for the diverted forest land at the rates stipulated by the Ministry of Environment and Forests from time to time.
- 10) The permission granted by the state Government shall be subject to the monitoring by the concerned Regional Office of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.
- 11) The Forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal. Any change in the land use without prior permission of the Central/State Government shall amount to the violation of Forest (Conservation) Act,1980. Request for such change shall be made to the Regional Office by the Nodal Officer, FCA, Manipur.

12) Certificate for settlement of rights has been obtained under FRA 2006.

- 13) The project does not affect recognised rights of the primitive tribal communities and pre agricultural communities.
- 14) The state Forest Department shall upload the forest diversion order/letter issued by the state government to the website of the Forest Department (www.manipurforest.gov.in)
- 15) The user agency should publish the entire forest clearance granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safeguards imposed by the state government in two widely circulated local daily newspaper one in vernacular language and the other in English language so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non forest purposes.
