It is submitted that the Government of India vide reference 6th cited has conveyed Central Government in-principle (Stage.I) approval under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, for diversion of 4.145 ha of forest land in erstwhile Adilabad Division and presently in Adilabad and Echoda forest divisions under Adilabad District, for laying of Pipelines and construction of Structures for Segment-21/1 (Mavala) under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Nirmal. The above orders have been communicated to all the concerned officers with instructions to submit condition-wise compliance report in the matter, vide reference 7th cited.

Accordingly, the District Forest Officer, Adilabad has obtain compliance of conditions from the User Agency and submitted the condition-wise compliance report together with its enclosures through I/c Conservator of Forests, Adilabad, which is received in this office through reference 8^{th} cited. A copy of reference 8^{th} cited together with its enclosures in triplicate are enclosed herewith.
