With reference to the above, this is to submit that, in the reference 8th cited, the Government of India have accorded in principle Stage-I approval for diversion of 2.104 Ha of Forest land in Gopalpur Extension Reserve Forest in Compartment No.241 in Yadadri Bhuvanagiri Division for construction of Turkapally Canal system including distributor network in favour of I & CAD Department subject to compliance of conditions stipulated therein and requested to furnish compliance report on the conditions.

Accordingly, in the reference 5th cited, the Prl.Chief Conservator of Forests & (HoFF), requested to take necessary action and submit draft Demand notice for vetting payment of levies as per rules.

Therefore, the following draft demand note is submitted as per the conditions stipulated in the reference 4th cited.

With reference to the subject cited, it is to submit that vide reference 2nd cited, the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, IRO, Hyderabad has accorded Stage-I (in-principle) approval for Diversion of 2.104 Ha of forest land in Yadadri Bhuvanagiri Division for construction of Thurkapally Canal System including distributor network, in favour of I&CADD department.

Vide reference 3rd cited, the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, TS, Hyderabad has instructed this office to issue the demand notice to the User Agency in consultation with Nodal Officer for Forests (Conservation) Act, 1980 for payment of compensatory levies like Net Present Value, compensatory Afforestation, protection structures Etc., only after vetting by the Nodal Officer, the demand shall be raised, and also requested to obtain the compliance report on the conditions stipulated in Stage-I (in-principle) approval from the user Agency and furnish for obtaining Stage II (final) approval from Government of India.

Accordingly, a demand notice (after vetting by the Nodal Officer) is prepared and the following are the amounts to be deposited by the User Agency:

It is further requested that the Engineer in Chief, I&CADD, Gajwel is requested to upload the Demand Notice at Ministry's portal i.e., <http://parivesh.nic.in/> against the proposal number for verification and acceptance of demand notice by the Nodal Officer, FCA for accepting the demand online in the forest clearance portal. After accepting the demand notice by the Nodal Officer, the User Agency shall generate e-challan and deposit the funds into the Telengana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority(CAMPA) account of Telangana against the Challan number. The step-by-step process involved is available at Ministry's portal

Further, the User Agency has to comply with following in accordance with the MoEF&CC, GoI instructions issued vide F.no.7-23-2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P. Hyderabad Rc.No.45921/2001/F4, Dt.23.08.2013:

1. Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the condition and safe-guards imposed by the Central government in two widely circulated daily newspaper one in vernacular language and the other in English granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes.
2. The copies of the forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

Further, the User Agency has to furnish the compliance on the conditions stipulated in the Stage I (in-principle) approval for onward submission to Government for obtaining Stage-II (final) approval.

The transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final (Stage II) approval or working permission.

In view of the above the Engineer in Chief, I&CADD, Gajwel is requested to kindly make the payment and submit the compliance report on the Stage-I approval for obtaining the final (Stage-II) approval.
