The Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, New Delhi vide Ref (1) has accorded 'in-principle' (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 5.271 hectare of forest land for Existing/Proposed Approach Road, Downhill Pipe Conveyor (DPC), Service Roads, Transmission Line Cable and Water pipeline in Swamymalai (SM) Block Forest, Lakshmipura village, Sandur Taluk, Ballari District in respect of Devadari Iron ore Mine (ML No.2290) in favour of M/s JSW Steel Ltd, Ballari District under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to certain conditions. Accordingly, the User Agency and field officers were directed by this office vide Ref (2) to submit the compliance.

In response, the User Agency vide Ref (3) letter dated 17-09-2019 has submitted the Compliance Report to the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Ballari Division, who after verification has submitted the conditions wise compliance report to Chief Conservator of Forests, Ballari Circle vide Ref (4) who in turn has submitted the same to this office vide Ref (5).

Further, in response to the deficiency in the FRA Certificate issued earlier pointed out by this office vide Ref (2) letter dated 27-01-2020, the User Agency has also obtained the revised FRA Certificate in FORM-I (for linear projects) for entire 5.271 ha of forest land under process of diversion, issued by the Deputy Commissioner, Ballari District vide No. Rev/Mining/FRA/81/2017-18 dated 29-04-2020 and vide Ref (3) letter dated 02-05-2020 has submitted the attested copies to this office.

Based on the above reports, the status of condition-wise compliance to the conditions of Stage-I approval is given below.
