Subject: Diversion of 0.38 ha of land in Pulicat Lake Sanctuary of Wildlife Division, Chennai for construction of fish landing centre at Periyamangodu Village in Tiruvallur District in favour of Commissioner of Fisheries Department, Teynampet, Chennai-reg

Sir,

Please refer to the State Government's letter 21947/FR.10/2016-6 dated 24.07.2017 and online Proposal No FP/TN/Others/20328/2016 seeking prior approval of the Central Government for diversion of sanctuary land in accordance with Section '2' of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for the above mentioned project.

After careful consideration of the proposal of the State Government, I am hereby directed to convey Central Government's approval in-principle (*Stage-I*) under Section '2' of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 0.38 ha of land in Pulicat Lake Sanctuary of Wildlife Division, Chennai for construction of fish landing centre at Periyamangodu Village in Tiruvallur District in favour of Commissioner of Fisheries Department, Teynampet, Chennai, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) Legal status of the diverted sanctuary land shall remain unchanged.
- (ii) The demarcation of the proposed area (except lake area) shall be carried out by erecting 4 feet high cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of User Agency.
- (iii) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value of the diverted sanctuary land measuring 0.38 ha from User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA Nos.826 in 566 with related IA's in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995.
- (iv) Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted Sanctuary land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from User Agency.

- (v) The funds received from the User Agency towards Compensatory Afforestation and Net Present Value under this project shall be deposited in the respective bank account of the Tamil Nadu State CAMPA. **The User Agency shall compulsorily deposit the CA and other levies only by generating challan through the Ministry's website.**
- (vi) No tree shall be felled in the proposed area for diversion.
- (vii) The muck generated in the earth cutting if any, will be disposed off at designated dumping sites and in no case the muck/debris will be disposed off in the Sanctuary areas.
- (viii) The Sanctuary land proposed for diversion shall under no circumstances be transferred or subleased to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government.
- (ix) The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
- (x) Minimal disturbance should be ensured by creating labour camps outside the Sanctuary area as far as possible and it will be the responsibility of the UA to ensure that the labourers & staff engaged in execution of work and villagers' / fishermen's who are likely to be used the proposed fish landing centre shall not destruct nearby flora & fauna.
- (xi) The total Sanctuary area utilized for the project shall not exceed 0.38 ha and the area diverted shall not be used for any purpose other than those shown in the diversion proposal.
- (xii) User agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project. The conditions imposed by the Chief Wildlife Warden and the NBWL have to be complied with.
- (xiii) Any other conditions that the Central Government or Addl. PCCF(Central) of Regional Office, Chennai may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency.
- (xiv) The Progress of the Compensatory Afforestation under the jurisdiction of Wildlife, Warden, Chennai shall be monitored by the Circle Head and a copy of such monitoring report shall be forwarded to the Regional Office.

- (xv) In the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the user agency is liable for penal action as decided by the Additional PCCF (Central), Regional Office, Chennai.

After receipt of the compliance report on above mentioned conditions, the proposal will be considered for final approval. Transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be effected prior to the issue of final approval. This in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of 5 years. In the event of noncompliance of the above conditions, this in-principle approval shall automatically stand revoked after 5 years.
