With reference to the above subject, in the letter cited under reference (1) & (2) the Government of India, has accorded in - principle (Stage -1) approval under the Forest Conservation

Act 1980 for Submission of Forest Diversion of 22.111 ha. of forest area for Construction of 400 KV Quad D/C Transmission Line in forest land of Kallumudkuru, Thenkamijaru villages in Karkala Taluk of Udupi District Ulipadi Villages in Mangalore Taluk, Veerakamba, Vitlamudnuru villages in Bantwal Taluk, of Dakshina Kannada District for length of 4.806 Km in favour of Udupi – Kasargode, Transmission Limited, New Delhi, subject to the terms and conditions therein.

As per this office letter dated:06-12-2022 (Ref-4) you have already been paid the NPV cost of Raising and maintenance of Compensatory Afforestation and Extraction and Transportation cost of 8145 Trees. And As per this office letter dated:03-10-2024 (Ref-4) you are according permission for commencement of project work on forest land for Linear Projects after Stage-1 approval under PARA 11.2 of FC Guidelines.

Further, it is brought to your notice that, Para No. 1.22(i) of Chapter-1 of the Consolidated Guidelines and Clarification issued under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980, states that,

“(i) 2% of total project cost towards the cost of implementation of the Wildlife Management Plan and/or 0.5% of the project cost towards the cost of implementation of Soil and Moisture Conservation Plan, as the case may be, shall be charged from the user agency and deposited into the account of CAMPA and the same may be intimated to the MoEF&CC for the purpose of obtaining approval under the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980”. “(ii) In respect of linear projects, the stipulated norms of 2% and 0.5% towards the cost of Wildlife Management Plan and Soil and Moisture Conservation Plan, as provided in the Ministry's guidelines dated 8.06.2022, will be proportionate to the extent of forest land involved instead of total project cost or actual cost of implementation of such Plans, whichever is more, should be charged from the user agency;” Circular GOI letter No. -11/43/2021-FC Dated:16-01-2023.

It is mentioned in form No -A of this proposal No. FP/KA/TRANS/115396/2020 proposal total area involved for the project is 22.111 ha. As per second proviso of para 1.22 (i) of Chapter -1 of the consolidated Guidelines and Clarification issued under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980. The stipulated norms of 2% and 0.5% towards the cost of Wildlife Management Plan and soil and Moisture Conservation Plans should be charged from the User Agency to the extent of forest land involved.


