District-Thane in the State of Maharashtra.







^{4.} The Committee deliberated on the proposal based on the information provided and the presentation made by the Project Proponent (PP). After discussion, the Committee noted that the proposed project

activity is permissible under the CRZ Notification, 2011, and has been duly recommended by the Maharashtra SCZMA. Additionally, the Committee acknowledged that the PP's responses to previous queries were satisfactory and that the Environmental Management Plan (EMP) has been appropriately revised, with an allocated budget of 60.68 crore for effective management of mangroves along the creeks. Furthermore, the Committee suggested that all mitigation measures outlined in the revised EMP report be implemented strictly and in their true spirit, without any deviations. To prevent damage to the mangroves, the Committee emphasized that the road on stilt in the mangrove area should be constructed using the Gantry Launch method. Additionally, the construction of temporary approach roads and the movement of heavy vehicles within the mangrove areas should be prohibited. The Project Proponent (PP) should reassess the number of mangrove trees that will be impacted or felled during the road construction, using the Gantry Launch method, in consultation with the Maharashtra Mangrove Cell. In order to compensate the loss of the mangroves, the plantation of mangrove trees should be carried out under the supervision of the Maharashtra Mangrove Cell as per the extant norms. The status report should be incorporated in six monthly compliance reports. Furthermore, the Committee directed that carbon accounting for the proposed compensatory afforestation activities and carbon neutrality measures should be undertaken to align with the Carbon Credit Trading Scheme (CCTS), in collaboration with reputed organizations or institutions specializing in carbon accounting. The Committee further directed the PP to secure the necessary permissions from the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay for the cutting of 1,546 mangrove trees and for activities within CRZ-IA (Mangrove Buffer) areas. Additionally, in accordance with the MoEFCC order dated 11/04/2022, the Committee advised that the PP must obtain the requisite Forest Clearance under the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980, for the diversion of forest land for non-forestry purposes. The Committee clarified that construction activities on non-forest land may only commence after securing Stage-I Forest Clearance under the aforementioned legislation for the forest land involved in the project. Moreover, no project activities shall be undertaken on forest land without obtaining Stage-II Forest Clearance under the same regulations. In response, PP has agreed the same.

- **5.** The Committee, after detailed deliberations and considering the submissions made by the project proponent, has recommended the proposal for CRZ Clearance as per CRZ Notification, 2011, subject to terms and conditions as stipulated during its 390th meeting held on 31/01/2025.
- 6. The Committee has also noted that a significant portion of the project activities fall in CRZ 1A and CRZ-IA (50m buffer from Mangroves) and involves cutting of more than 9000 mangrove trees. Therefore, the committee directed that prior permission from Hon'ble High Court of Bombay and Forest Clearance under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 should be obtained before commencing the construction work. Further, the Committee has suggested that NOC should be obtained from the Maharashtra Fishery Department and directed the proponent to submit the budget for each component of the proposed Environment Management Plan (EMP). In response, the proponent has agreed on the same and submitted the detailed component-wise EMP budget vide email dated 26/09/2024. The same has been circulated to all EAC Members including Ministry and considered by the EAC Members while approving the said minutes. 3.1.3. Deliberations by the EAC in previous meetings

Deliberations of EAC 1:

The Committee deliberated the proposal and noted that the project activity is permissible as per CRZ Notification, 2011 and MCZMA has recommended the project *vide* letter dated 14/02/2023. Further, EAC has noted that Cut and Cover Tunnel method is proposed due to the conditional NOC provided by Navy. However, it is not a permissible activity in CRZ-IA area. The Committee, thus requested the proponent to consider the road on stilt or via tunnel in discussion with Ministry of Defence. Proponent agreed to explore the options as suggested by the EAC. Accordingly, the EAC has deferred the proposal.

3.1.4. Deliberations by the EAC in current meetings

3. The Committee has deliberated the proposal based on the information provided/presented by the proponent. After deliberation, the Committee has noted that PP has revised the alignment and submitted the NOC from Navy as suggested by the EAC in its 340th meeting. However, the Committee has observed that the revised recommendation letter of MCZMA the project activity is permissible under clause 4(i)(g) of CRZ Notification, 2011. However, not clearly mentioned the CRZ classifications [CRZ I-A (50 m Mangrove Buffer Zone), CRZ I-B, CRZ II and CRZ IV-B] permissibility clause for the project as per CRZ Notification 2011. The Committee also suggested that Stage-I Forest Clearance already obtained needs to be submit as record. The PP has proposed for Gantry Launch method but at the same time suggested for construction of temporary road in Mangrove. This is not clear. PP has failed to explain the advantage of Gantry method over the traditional method.

Further, considering the diversion of forest land and mangrove destruction, the Committee has opined that the proposed EMP Cost of ₹5.5 Cr is not appropriate, needs to be submit, item wise physical and financial plan. In this regard, the Committee has also suggested that PP should prepare a separate (i.e., compensation for mangrove cutting and Forest diversion) Management Plan and effectiveness/success rate of such activities needs to be monitored periodically by engaging reputed organization. In order to minimize the carbon foot print of the project, the Committee has suggested that PP should implement the carbon accounting of the proposed compensatory afforestation (terrestrial and mangroves) by engaging reputed organization in the field; in addition, measures also needs to be taken to ensure the carbon neutrality in the proposed project by implementing appropriate activities in line with Carbon Credit Trading Scheme (CCTS).

Accordingly, the Committee suggested the proponent to submit the followings:

Update and submit the revised EIA Report in line of change of new alignment and also intimate baseline period for earlier EIA.

The revised recommendation letter of MCZMA clearly mentioned the CRZ classifications [CRZ I-A (50 m Mangrove Buffer Zone), CRZ I-B, CRZ II and CRZ IV-B] permissibility clause for the project as per CRZ Notification 2011.

The PP shall explain the proposed methodology for use of Gantry for stilt road construction especially when they are constructing a temporary road which causes damages to mangroves due to movement of heavy machineries. Efforts shall be made to avoid construction of roads in mangrove areas by proper use of Gantry launch method.

Clarification on merging points of proposed and existing road *vis-a-vis* drainage / flooding plan as it is proposed at low line area.

Component wise EMP cost (physical and financial) needs to be submitted, including the carbon accounting of the proposed compensatory afforestation and measure for carbon neutrality.

Undertaking for implementation of carbon accounting of the proposed compensatory afforestation activity and carbon neutrality measures in line with Carbon Credit Trading Scheme (CCTS).

The Stage-I Forest Clearance already obtained needs to be submit as record.

In response, proponent agreed to submit the desired documents. Accordingly, the Committee has deferred the proposal.

After deliberation, the Committee has noted that PP has revised the alignment and submitted the NOC from Navy as suggested by the EAC in its 340th meeting. The Hon'ble Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission's rules were followed by Tata Power when they suggested replacing the existing 110 kV double circuit Kalwa-Kalyan line corridor with a 220 kV multi circuit Kalwa-

Further, EAC has noted that Cut and Cover Tunnel method is proposed due to the conditional NOC provided by Navy. However, it is not a permissible activity in CRZ-IA area. The Committee, thus requested the proponent to consider the road on stilt or via tunnel in discussion with Ministry of Defence. Proponent agreed to explore the options as suggested by the EAC. Accordingly, the EAC has deferred the proposal.

4. The Committee deliberated on the proposal based on the information provided and the presentation. made by the Project Proponent (PP). After discussion, the Committee noted that the proposed project activity is permissible under the CRZ Notification, 2011, and has been duly recommended by the Maharashtra SCZMA. Additionally, the Committee acknowledged that the PP's responses to previous queries were satisfactory and that the Environmental Management Plan (EMP) has been appropriately revised, with an allocated budget of ₹60.68 crore for effective management of mangroves along the creeks. Furthermore, the Committee suggested that all mitigation measures outlined in the revised EMP report be implemented strictly and in their true spirit, without any deviations. To prevent damage to the mangroves, the Committee emphasized that the road on stilt in the mangrove area should be constructed using the Gantry Launch method. Additionally, the construction of temporary approach roads and the movement of heavy vehicles within the mangrove areas should be prohibited. The Project Proponent (PP) should reassess the number of mangrove trees that will be impacted or felled during the road construction, using the Gantry Launch method, in consultation with the Maharashtra Mangrove Cell. In order to compensate the loss of the mangroves, the plantation of mangrove trees should be carried out under the supervision of the Maharashtra Mangrove Cell as per the extant norms. The status report should be incorporated in six monthly compliance reports. Furthermore, the Committee directed that carbon accounting for the proposed compensatory afforestation activities and carbon neutrality measures should be undertaken to align with the Carbon Credit Trading Scheme (CCTS), in collaboration with reputed organizations or institutions specializing in carbon accounting. The Committee further directed the PP to secure the necessary permissions from the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay for the cutting of 1,546 mangrove trees and for activities within CRZ-IA (Mangrove Buffer) areas. Additionally, in accordance with the MoEFCC order dated 11/04/2022, the Committee advised that the PP must obtain the requisite Forest Clearance under the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980, for the diversion of forest land for non-forestry purposes. The Committee clarified that construction activities on non-forest land may only commence after securing Stage-I Forest Clearance under the aforementioned legislation for the forest land involved in the project. Moreover, no project activities shall be undertaken on forest land without obtaining Stage-II Forest Clearance under the same regulations. In response, PP has agreed the same.

MINUTES OF THE 390th MEETING OF EXPERT APPRAISAL COMMITTEE FOR PROJECTS RELATED TO COASTAL REGULATION ZONE HELD ON 31/01/2025.

The 390th meeting of the Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC) for projects related to Coastal Regulation Zone held on 31/01/2025 through Hybrid mode. The list of Members presents in the EAC (CRZ) is at **Annexure-I.**

The deliberations held and the decisions taken are as under:

1.0 OPENING REMARKS OF THE CHAIRMAN

At the outset, Shri M. S. Negi, Chairman, EAC (CRZ) welcomed the Members of the EAC and requested Dr. H. Kharkwal, the Member Secretary, EAC to initiate the proceedings of the meeting with a brief account of the activities undertaken by the Ministry under CRZ Division.

2.0 CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

The Committee has confirmed the minutes of the **388**th meeting held on 17/01/2025 with suggestions that in case any typographical/ grammatical errors are noticed in due course, the same may be corrected suitably.

3.0 CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSALS:

The EAC (CRZ) considered proposals as per the agenda adopted for the 390th meeting. The details of deliberations held and decisions taken in the meeting are as follows:

AGENDA 3.1

Proposal for Development of the Balkum to Gaimukh Road, District Thane Maharashtra by M/s Thane Municipal Corporation, PWD-CRZ Clearance [IA/MH/CRZ/419811/2023; F. No. 11/38/2023-IA.III]

"The EAC noted that the Project Proponent has given undertaking that the data and information given in the application and enclosures are true to the best of his knowledge and belief and no information has been suppressed in the EIA / EMP report. If any part of the data / information submitted is found to be false / misleading at any stage, the project will be rejected and Environmental and or CRZ Clearance given, if any, will be revoked at the risk and cost of the project proponent."

The proposal was earlier considered by EAC in its 340th meeting held on 26/09/2023 and 378th meeting held on 28/10/2024. The Committee in its 340th meeting deferred the proposal and noted that Cut and Cover Tunnel method is proposed due to the conditional NOC provided by Navy. However, it is not a permissible activity in CRZ-IA area. The Committee, thus requested the proponent to consider the road on stilt or via tunnel in discussion with Ministry of Defence. Proponent agreed to explore the options as suggested by the EAC.

- 2. Subsequently, PP has revised alignment and obtained necessary NOC from Navy as suggested by EAC in its 340th meeting. Further, PP has obtained revised MCZMA recommendation *vide* letter dated 23/09/2024. The same has been uploaded on PARIVESH on 23/09/2024. Accordingly, the proposal was considered in the 378th meeting held on 28/10/2024. After deliberation, the Committee again deferred the proposal and directed the proponent to submit the followings:
 - Update and submit the revised EIA Report in line of change of new alignment and also intimate baseline period for earlier EIA.
 - The revised recommendation letter of MCZMA clearly mentioned the CRZ classifications [CRZ I-A (50 m Mangrove Buffer Zone), CRZ I-B, CRZ II and CRZ IV-B] permissibility clause for the project as per CRZ Notification 2011.
 - The PP shall explain the proposed methodology for use of Gantry for stilt road construction especially when they are constructing a temporary road which causes damages to mangroves due to movement of heavy machineries. Efforts shall be made to avoid construction of roads in mangrove areas by proper use of Gantry launch method.
 - Clarification on merging points of proposed and existing road vis-a-vis drainage / flooding plan as it is proposed at low line area.
 - Component wise EMP cost (physical and financial) needs to be submitted, including the carbon accounting of the proposed compensatory afforestation and measure for carbon neutrality.
 - Undertaking for implementation of carbon accounting of the proposed compensatory afforestation activity and carbon neutrality measures in line with Carbon Credit Trading Scheme (CCTS).
 - The Stage-I Forest Clearance already obtained needs to be submit as record
- 3. In response, PP has submitted the desired information on PARIVESH portal on 20/01/2025. Accordingly, the proposal has been considered in the present meeting. The Project Proponent (M/s Thane Municipal Corporation, Maharashtra) along with his EIA consultant (M/s Centre for Envotech & Management Consultancy Private Limited) have made a presentation on above said proposal and informed the following salient features of the proposal, including the details provided in the application of the project, to EAC:

The Committee deliberated on the proposal based on the information provided and the presentation made by the Project Proponent (PP). After discussion, the Committee noted that the proposed project activity is permissible under the CRZ Notification, 2011, and has been duly recommended by the Maharashtra SCZMA. Additionally, the Committee acknowledged that the PP's responses to previous queries were satisfactory and that the Environmental Management Plan (EMP) has been appropriately revised, with an allocated budget of ₹60.68 crore for effective management of mangroves along the creeks. Furthermore, the Committee suggested that all mitigation measures outlined in the revised EMP report be implemented strictly and in their true spirit, without any deviations. To prevent damage to the mangroves, the Committee emphasized that the road on stilt in the mangrove area should be constructed using the Gantry Launch method. Additionally, the construction of temporary approach roads and the movement of heavy vehicles within the mangrove areas should be prohibited. The Project Proponent (PP) should reassess the number of mangrove trees that will be impacted or felled during the road construction, using the Gantry Launch method, in consultation with the Maharashtra Mangrove Cell. In order to compensate the loss of the mangroves, the plantation of mangrove trees should be carried out under the supervision of the Maharashtra Mangrove Cell as per the extant norms. The status report should be incorporated in six monthly compliance reports. Furthermore, the Committee directed that carbon accounting for the proposed compensatory afforestation activities and carbon neutrality measures should be undertaken to align with the Carbon Credit Trading Scheme (CCTS), in collaboration with reputed organizations or institutions specializing in carbon accounting. The Committee further directed the PP to secure the necessary permissions from the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay for the cutting of 1,546 mangrove trees and for activities within CRZ-IA (Mangrove Buffer) areas. Additionally, in accordance with the MoEFCC order dated 11/04/2022, the Committee advised that the PP must obtain the requisite Forest Clearance under the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980, for the diversion of forest land for non-forestry purposes. The Committee clarified that construction activities on non-forest land may only commence after securing Stage-I Forest Clearance under aforementioned legislation for the forest land involved in the project. Moreover, no project activities shall be undertaken on forest land without obtaining Stage-II Forest Clearance under the same regulations. In response, PP has agreed the same.

Accordingly, the Committee has recommended the proposal for CRZ Clearance under the CRZ Notification, 2011, subject to the following terms and conditions:

PART A- SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:

(i) All construction shall be strictly in accordance with the provisions of the CRZ Notification, 2011, as amended from time to time.

(ii) The stilt road in the mangrove area shall be constructed using the Gantry Launch method. No construction of temporary approach roads or movement of heavy vehicles shall be allowed in mangrove areas to

prevent damage to the mangroves.

(iii) The Project Proponent (PP) should reassess the number of mangrove trees that are actually being affected or felled during the road construction using the Gantry Launch method, in consultation with the Maharashtra Mangrove Cell. In order to compensate the loss the mangroves, the plantation of mangrove trees should be carried out under the supervision of the Maharashtra Mangrove Cell as per the extant norms. The status report should be incorporated in six monthly compliance reports.

(iv) All the mitigation measures listed in the revised EMP report shall be

implemented without any deviations and true spirit.

(v) The construction of the project in non-forest land shall be initiated only after obtaining Stage-I Forest clearance under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 in respect of the forest land involved in the project. Further, no project activity shall be undertaken on the forest land without obtaining Stage-II FC clearance under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980.

- (xi) The combined Environmental Management Plan (EMP) for Balkum-Gaikmukh and Kasarvadavli-Kharbav (New Thane) DP Road, with an allocated budget of ₹60.68 crore, shall be implemented, to overall ecosystem improvement of the creek.
- (xii) During the construction phase as well as operational phase, water flow of adjacent creek should not be diverted or stopped.
- (xiii) PP should ensure the implementation of latest safety features / protocols to be incorporated for safe operations and Proper Standard Operating Procedures during construction and operation.
- (xiv) Any waste generated shall be managed and treated in accordance with prevailing norms and shall not be disposed of in CRZ areas.
- (xv) The necessary clearance shall be obtained from the Ministry of Railways if the alignment crosses railway/metro lines.
- (xvi) The proposed Disaster Management Plan (including the risk management), as submitted by PP shall be implemented in consultation with concerned department and implementation report shall be submitted to concerned IRO of this Ministry as part of six monthly compliance reports.
- (xvii) Topsoil excavated during construction activities shall be stored for use in horticulture/landscape development etc. within the project site.
- (xviii) No groundwater shall be extracted within the CRZ area to meet the water requirements during the construction and/or operation phase of the project.
- (xix) No storage reservoir for sea water shall be permitted.
- (xx) Permanent labour camp, machinery and material storage shall not be set up in the CRZ area.
- (xxi) Temporary toilets will be provided for all construction labour. Suitable toilet fixtures for water conservation shall be provided. Fixtures for showers, toilet flushing and drinking should be of low flow either by use of aerators of pressure reducing devices or sensor based control.
- (xxii) Construction material and structures/scaffoldings erected for construction at site shall be cleared immediately after finishing construction and it shall be ensured that no construction waste, garbage and machinery or equipment are left post construction.
- (xxiii) The Project Proponent shall comply order/direction, if any, issued by Hon'ble Court / tribunal on the project.
- (xxiv) All the conditions stipulated by the Maharashtra Coastal Zone Management Authority for CRZ clearance under CRZ Notification, 2011 *vide* letter No. letter No. IA/MH/CRZ/419811/2023, dated 23/09/2024 and commitments made by the PP before the Maharashtra CZMA and EAC shall be followed in letter and spirit.
- (xxv) All necessary clearance from the concerned authority, as may be applicable should be obtained prior to commencement of project or activity.

PART B - GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- (i) Management of solid waste in accordance with the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 shall be strictly implemented.
- (ii) 'Consent to Establish' and/or 'Consent to Operate' shall be obtained from State Pollution Control Board under the provisions of Air Page 8 of 41



(Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and/or the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, as may be applicable.

(iii) Disposal of muck during construction phase should not create any adverse effect on the neighbouring communities and be disposed taking the necessary precautions for general safety and health aspects of people, only in approved sites with the approval of Competent Authority.

- (iv) All liquid waste arising from the proposed development will be disposed of as per the norms prescribed by Central/State Pollution Control Board. There shall not be any disposal of untreated effluent into the sea/coastal water bodies. It shall be ensured that the wastewater generated is treated in the STP as committed by the project proponent. The treated waste water shall be reused for landscaping, flushing and/or HVAC cooling purposes etc. within the development. The project proponent should also make alternate arrangement for situation arising due to malfunctioning of STP. There shall be regular monitoring of standard parameters of the effluent discharge from STP under intimation to the SPCB.
- (v) Any hazardous waste generated during construction phase, shall be disposed off as per applicable rules and norms with necessary approvals of the State Pollution Control Board.
- (vi) A copy of the clearance letter shall be uploaded on the website of the concerned State Coastal Zone Management Authority/State Pollution Control Board. The Clearance letter shall also be displayed at the Regional Office, District Industries Centre and Collector's Office/Tehsildar's office for 30 days.

(vii) A six-monthly monitoring report shall need to be submitted by the project proponent to the concerned Regional Office of this Ministry regarding the implementation of the stipulated conditions.

(viii) The Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change or any other Competent Authority may stipulate any additional conditions or modify the existing ones, if necessary in the interest of environment and the same shall be complied with.

(ix) Full co-operation shall be extended to the officials from the Regional Office of MoEF&CC, during monitoring of implementation of environmental safeguards stipulated. It shall be ensured that documents/data sought pertinent is made available to the monitoring team. A complete set of all the documents submitted to MoEF&CC shall be forwarded to the concerned Regional Office of MoEF&CC.

(x) In the case of any change(s) in the scope of the project, the project would require a fresh appraisal by this Ministry.

(xi) The Ministry reserves the right to add additional safeguard measures subsequently, if considered necessary, and to take action to ensure effective implementation of the suggested safeguard measures in a time bound and satisfactory manner, including revoking of the environment clearance under the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, for non-compliance.

(xii) All other statutory clearances such as the approvals for storage of diesel from Chief Controller of Explosives, Fire Department, Civil Aviation Department, Forest Conservation Act, 1980 and Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 etc. shall be obtained, as applicable by project proponent from the respective Competent Authorities.

- (xiii) The project proponent should advertise in at least two local Newspapers widely circulated in the region, one of which shall be in the vernacular language informing that the project has been accorded CRZ Clearance and copies of clearance letters are available with the State Pollution Control Board (SPCB) and may also be seen on the website of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change at https://parivesh.nic.in/. The advertisement should be made within Seven days from the date of receipt of the Clearance letter and a copy of the same should be forwarded to the concerned Regional Office of this Ministry.
- (xiv) A copy of the clearance letter shall be sent by the proponent to concerned Panchayat, Zilla Parisad/Municipal Corporation, Urban Local Body and the Local NGO, if any, from whom suggestions/representations, if any, were received while processing the proposal.
- (xv) The proponent shall upload the status of compliance of the stipulated conditions, including results of monitored data on their website and shall update the same periodically. It shall simultaneously be sent to the Regional Office of MoEF&CC, the respective Zonal Office of CPCB and the SPCB.
- (xvi) The environmental statement for each financial year ending 31st March in Form-V as is mandated to be submitted by the project proponent to the concerned State Pollution Control Board as prescribed under the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986, as amended subsequently, shall also be put on the website of the project proponent along with the status of compliance of clearance conditions and shall also be sent to the respective Regional Office of the Ministry by e-mail.








Detail plan revised Alignment
