Subject: Proposal for diversion of 216.33 ha. Zudpi Jungle land of 70 villages in Saoner taluka, Dist. Nagpur under Category I [Zudpi Jungle for Public purpose / public infrastructure prior to 12.12.1996 using simplified procedure] in consolidated form under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in accordance with the procedure prescribed as per Government of India, Ministry of Environment & Forest's letter No. No.8-33/2001-Fc, dt.04/03/2014.

Sir,
Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Nodal Officer, Maharashtra State, Nagpur has submitted proposal for diversion of 216.33 ha. Zudpi Jungle land of 70 villages in Saoner taluka, Dist. Nagpur under Category I [Zudpi Jungle for Public purpose / public infrastructure prior to 12.12.1996 using simplified procedure] in consolidated form under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in accordance with the procedure prescribed as per Government of India, Ministry of Environment & Forest's letter No. No.8-33/2001-FC, dt.04.03.2014. The details of project area are mentioned in Annexure-I.

- 2) The proposal has been scrutinized with reference to the required documentation as enlisted in point B of Annexure – I to the Govt. of India's letter dated 4th March, 2014. The details are as under:
- i) Copies of the Record of Rights are attached.
 - ii) Map indicating boundary and adjoining land use in suitable scale is not attached. However, Geo-referenced (Digital GPS Map) boundary in shape file has submitted by the User Agency.
 - iii) Form A containing part I, II, III and IV u/s 6 of the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003 is enclosed with the proposal.
 - iv) Site Inspection Reports:
 - a) Joint Site Inspection Reports (JSIR – I) of Circle Officer of the District Administration and Forester from Forest Department are enclosed with the proposal.
 - b) Joint Site Inspection Reports (JSIR – II) of Tahsildar, Saoner and Range Forest Officer, Khapa and Kalmeshwar for 5% of the forest land (Zudpi Jungle) proposed for diversion are enclosed for the following area:
 1. Village –Chorkhairi, Taluka-Saoner, Dist. Nagpur (Area – 10.27 ha.)
 2. Village - Joga, Taluka-Saoner, Dist. Nagpur (Area –4.84 ha.)
 - v) The certificate of Collector under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 and the copies of Gram Sabha / Ward Committee Resolutions are attached.

vi) Demarcation certificate is not enclosed.

- 3) Density of forest is 0.1 and Eco class value III. Southern tropical dry deciduous forests as per Site Inspection Report of Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nagpur Forest Division, Nagpur.
- 4) Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Nodal Officer, Maharashtra State and Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Maharashtra State have recommended the proposal for diversion of 216.33 ha. Zudpi Jungle land of 70 villages in Saoner taluka, Dist. Nagpur under Category I [Zudpi Jungle for Public purpose / public infrastructure prior to 12.12.1996 using simplified procedure] in consolidated form under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
- 5) Deputy Conservator of forests, Nagpur Forest Division, Nagpur has certified that the proposed project is beyond 10 km from Protected Area (Sanctuary and National Park). Bor Wildlife Sanctuary is 17.19 km and 45.81 km distance of the Umred-Karhandala Wildlife Sanctuary as per map.
- 6) The map showing distance of these villages from Eco-sensitive zone is attached.
- 7) There are 5865 trees standing in proposed area for diversion. Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nagpur Division, Nagpur has certified that project requires minimum cutting and felling of trees.
- 8) Site Inspection Report of The Chief Conservator of Forests (T), Nagpur Circle, Nagpur and Deputy Conservator of Forest, Nagpur Division, Nagpur is enclosed.
- 9) The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nagpur Division, Nagpur has certified that no suitable alternate land is available and the Zudpi forest land required is the barest minimum.
- 10) There is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980, as certified by The Deputy Conservator of Forest, Nagpur Division, Nagpur.
- 11) The proposed area involved in the project does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Nature Reserve etc. as certified by The Deputy Conservator of Forest, Nagpur Division, Nagpur.
- 12) The Deputy Conservator of Forest, Nagpur Division, Nagpur has certified that the proposal does not affect any monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archaeological or recreational importance.
- 13) The User Agency has submitted the certificate of Collector, Nagpur under Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dweller's (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006 issued vide letter No. Rev/B-I-a/C.R.76/W.s.455/2016, dt.31.08.2017 in prescribed format Form- II. User agency has submitted the copies of Gram Sabha/Ward Committee Resolutions.
- 14) The User Agency has not submitted demarcation certificate of the proposed area.
- 15) The User Agency has submitted consolidated digital maps with proposal.
- 16) The Government of Maharashtra has requested Government of India for exemption of Net Present Value for the regularization of these lands in view of the pre-1980 stand & since they have been erroneously classified as forest these lands are under use of agriculture /non-forest/ village/ Government use etc. hence need to be regularized including the status of forest also needs to be withdrawn.

- 17) The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Maharashtra State, Nagpur has recommended the proposal subject to the conditions, given in his specific recommendations, under Section-2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. His specific recommendations are enclosed in the proposal.
- 18) It is therefore, requested that Government of India may kindly approve the proposal for diversion of 216.33 ha. Zudpi Jungle land of 70 villages in Saoner taluka, Dist. Nagpur under Category I [Zudpi Jungle for Public purpose / public infrastructure prior to 12.12.1996 using simplified procedure] in consolidated form under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in accordance with the procedure prescribed as per Government of India, Ministry of Environment & Forest's letter No. No.8-33/2001-Fc,dt.04/03/2014.

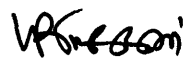
