Sir,

We appreciate for grant of Stage-1 in principle permission via letter no. 6-GJC005/2020-BHO/134-8, Dt.17/04/2020 for laying of Diversion of 22.6756 Ha, Protected Forest land of road side for widening and stranghening up to Four lanning of Kheda-Dholka Road, Km 36/600 to 53/200 in Kheda District, Gujarat State. Further in order to obtain Stage-2 permission for the same proposal we here by submit compliance report as per conditions stipulated in stage-1 permission letter.

Further, data of height, collar girth and survival percentage (species wise) twice a year (April & November month) shall be recorded & records shall be maintained. e) All the live stumps & pollards upto 90 cm Girth shall be dressed from ground level for the purpose of regeneration & record shall be kept in plantation journal. f) Plantation shall be taken up before end of 2021 monsoon.
