

3	b) The non-forest land shall be transferred and mutated in favour of Forest Department.	The User Agency has transferred 11.270 Ha. land at Village Positra in favour of Forest Department, Gujarat. Mutation record including form no.4,6,7 and 8A are attached. (Annexure 4a to 4n)
4	The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wages rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the Project Authority. The CA shall be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.	The User Agency has already transferred an amount of Rs.55,36,275/- towards the cost of Compensatory Afforestation, Survey, Demarcation and Boundary pillars in the CAMPA fund.

5	<p>NPV:-</p> <p>a) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 11.268 ha forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30.10.2002, 01.08.2003, 28.03.2008, 24/04/2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA No. 566 in WP (C) No. 202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No. 5-1/1998-FC (Pt. II) dated 18.09.2003, as well as letter No. 5-2/2006-FC dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007-FC dated 05/02/2009 in this regard.</p>	<p>The User Agency has already deposited an amount of Rs.4,11,28,200/- towards the cost of Net Present Value in the CAMPA fund</p>
	<p>b) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.</p>	<p>The User Agency has already given the undertaking in this regard.</p>
6	<p>All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/ deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal.</p>	<p>Funds from the user agency has been transferred online to the CAMPA fund through e-portal.</p>
7	<p>A detailed plan for the rehabilitation of the present discharge area shall be prepared by Tata Chemical (UA) in consultation with CWLW, Govt. of Gujarat.
