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It is submitted that, the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), TS, Hyderabad vide reference 2nd cited above has communicated that, the Gol vide reference 1st cited above has accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 4.2339 Ha (recommended out of 8.50 Ha proposed) of Forest Land for widening from single lane road to double lane road from Khammampally to Bhupalpally Road from Km 12/2 to 19/6 in Bhupalpally Division in favour of District R&B Officer, Jayashankar Bhupalpally District.

Further, the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, (HoFF), TS, Hyderabad has requested to issue the demand notice to the User Agency as per the condition stipulated and submit through mail for vetting by the Nodal Officer. Accordingly the Chief Conservator of Forests, Kaleshwaram Circle, JS Bhupalpally vide reference 6th cited above has approved the demand notice is as follows.

As per the clarification issued by the Ad-hoc CAMPA wing vide F.No. 13-20/2015-CAMPA, dt: 09.06.2014 and the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, TS, Hyderabad reference 2nd cited above has issued instructions that, the charges for felling, logging, transportation of project affected tress and the funds towards expenditure like boundary

walls, stone pillars, demarcation charges etc., should be deposited with the Divisional Forest Officers (now DFOs/FDOs) concerned and the work should be undertaken departmentally in order to ensure that the task of felling / transportation / stone pillars etc.,

Further, the User Agency has to comply with following in accordance with the instructions issued by the GoI, MoEF&CC, New Delhi, vide F.no.7-23-2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P. Hyderabad Rc.No.45921/2001/F4, Dt.23.08.2013:

1. Publish the entire Forest clearances granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purpose in verbatim along with the condition(s) and safe-guards imposed by the Central government in two widely circulated daily newspaper i.e., one in vernacular language and the other in English.
2. The copies of the Forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same.

The transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final approval or working permission.

Therefore, the User Agency is requested to upload the demand notice online at Ministry's portal i.e., <https://parivesh.nic.in.//> against the project for approval by the Nodal Officer, FCA and upon approval, the User Agency shall generate challan and transfer funds into the account mentioned in the challan generated and the other funds as per the demand notice are to be deposited into the respective accounts mentioned in the demand notice, after payment of compensatory levies, the user agency to submit the condition wise compliance report (5) sets to this office.
