



	ii. **Subject: Issuance of Forest Right Act (FRA) certificate and minimum demand of Forest land certificate for Forest Land coming under the alignment for widening/up-gradation of road from Phinter to Billawar including balance work for Billawar Sukrala road (Length = 9.25 Kms, LUP No. 2687 under Languishing).**

In compliance with the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt) Dated: 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition) of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA,) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes road with MoEF's letter dated: 5<sup>th</sup> February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain exemption/relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 0.15 hectares of forest land is proposed to be diverted in favour of **widening/up-gradation of road from Phinter to Billawar including balance work for Billawar Sukrala road PWD Division Basohli-**, in District Kathua. Detail of the roads/projects is detailed below:


- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire of 0.15 Hectares of forest

area proposed for diversion. As per MoEF letter No. F.No. 11-9/98-FC (pt), Dated: 5<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2013 for linear projects like construction of roads, there is no requirement of resolution (meeting/consent) of Gram Sabha of that area for forest land, use of which is proposed to be diverted. Hence, no such records of all constructions and meetings of the Forest Right Committee(s) Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed.

- (b) Joint verification of the above said road has been conducted by the user agency, PWD (R&B) alongwith concerned Officers/Officials of Forest Department and Revenue Department, wherein, it has been reported by the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Billawar vide his office communication No. ADC/Blr/2022-23/272-74 dated 28-04-2022 submitted that *no ST & OTFD population reside in Forest Land and no claim received in respect of Panchayats falling in the widening/up-gradation of road from Phinter to Billawar including balance work of Billawar Sukrala Road i.e. Dher, Dewal and Billawar Rural. Moreover, there is no probability of receiving any FRA claims in near future as per the report of Chairman and Secretary FRC Panchayat Dher, Dewal and Billawar Rural. Hence, it is presumed that the claims under FRA Act, 2006 may kindly be treated as settled.*

Hence, Forest Rights Act certificate is issued for forest land measuring 0.15 Ha. required for widening/up-gradation of road from Phinter to Billawar including balance work for Billawar Sukrala road PWD Division Basohli-, in District Kathua




