Sir,

Government of India, MoEF&CC, New Delhi conveyed the 'in-principle' approval for 56.86 ha. forest land for construction of Kotgal Barrage, in favour of Executive Engineer, Minor Irrigation Division, Chandrapur, Maharashtra, under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
