Sub: Final (Stage-II) approval of Central Government under Forest (Conservation) Act 1980 for proposed diversion of 0.64 ha of forest land for installation of Passenger Ropeway at Dungeshwari hill in favour of Bihar State Tourism Development Corporation Ltd. in Gaya district of Bihar - reg.

Sir.

I am directed to refer to the State Govt. letter No.Van Bhumi-57/2018-1030(E)/Pa.Va. dated 11.9.2018, wherein prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change for diversion of 0.64 ha of forest land for installation of Passenger Ropeway at Dungeshwari hill in favour of Bihar State Tourism Development Corporation Ltd. in Gaya district of Bihar, was sought in accordance with Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. After due consideration of the proposal of the State Government, the 'in-principle' approval of the Central Government for diversion of the said forest land was accorded vide this office letter of even number dated 7.11.2019 subject to fulfillment of certain conditions.

In this connection, on the basis of the compliance report with request for according final approval furnished by the State Government of Bihar vide letter No.Van Bhumi-57/2018-1022(E)/Pa.Va.Ja.Pa. dated 4.9.2020, final approval of the Central Government is hereby granted under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 0.64 ha of forest land for installation of Passenger Ropeway at Dungeshwari hill in favour of Bihar State Tourism Development Corporation Ltd. in Gaya district of Bihar, subject to the following conditions and stipulations:-

(1) Legal status of the forest land diverted shall remain unchanged.

- (2) Compensatory afforestation: The State Forest Department shall plant 1830 numbers of trees to maintain the green cover at the project cost. Planting site for the purpose shall be identified by the State Forest Department preferably in the vicinity of the project site. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
- (3) The State Government shall ensure that compliance of Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 has been completed in accordance with the relevant Rules and Guidelines issued by the MoEF & CC, Gol in this regard.
- (4) a) User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
 - b) In view of the State Government's recommendation, such number of trees whose removal is unavoidable, but whose translocation (number, girth and species to be decided by SFD) is practicable using modern technology or otherwise, will be translocated to the extent possible at the cost of user agency.
- (5) The height of the ropeways should be maintained with minimum clearance of 5 meters from the highest tree.
- (6) The boundary of the forest land proposed for diversion, shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, DGPS coordinates, forward and back bearing and distance from adjoining pillars etc.
- (7) Wherever possible and technically feasible, the User Agency shall undertake afforestation measures along the segment covered under this approval, in consultation with the State Forest Department at the project cost.
- (8) a) The layout plan of the proposed diversion of the forest land shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
 - b) No labour camp shall be established inside the forest land.
 - c) The User Agency shall provide alternate fuels preferably LPG to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.

- (9) a) The diverted forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
 - b) The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the project-life.
 - c) The diverted forest land shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department, or person without prior approval of the Central Government.
- (10) The User Agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of all the Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, Hon'ble Court Order(s) and National Green Tribunal Order(s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time in force, as applicable to the project.
- (11) Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guideline F. No. 11-42/2017-FC dt 29/01/2018.
- (12) Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests and wildlife.
- 2. As has been mentioned at Para-2 of the Stage-II approval, this approval for diversion of forest land is subject to the fulfillment of stipulated conditions mentioned in this approval letter. Therefore, in the event of non-compliance of any of the conditions laid out in this approval letter, the Regional Office of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change may withdraw the said approval for diversion of the forest land and stop the non-forest activity being carried out in the forest land besides initiating the legal action as per provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
