Kind attention is invited to the references cited.

It is submitted that the Government, vide reference 6th cited, has accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval, for diversion of forest land to an extent of 4.158 Ha in Asifabad forest division under Komarambeehm-Asifabad District - for laying of pipelines and construction of other structures in Segment No.22/9 (Asifabad), for providing safe drinking water under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Nirmal. The above orders have been communicated to all the concerned officers with instructions to submit condition-wise compliance report, vide reference 7th cited.

Accordingly, the Conservator of Forests, Adilabad had obtained compliance of conditions from the District Forest Officer / Forest Divisional Officer, KB-Asifabad and User Agency and submitted to this office vide reference 10th cited. A copy of reference 10th cited together with its enclosures in triplicate is enclosed herewith.

The condition-wise compliance report is reproduced with remarks as follows:

No 139 & 147 of Thimmapuram in Chandampet Mandal of Nalgonda District at the cost of User Agency.

The User Agency has deposited an amount of Rs.86,70,190/-which includes an amount of Rs.60,67,282/- towards CA scheme, in to the account of Telangana State CAMPA, New Delhi, Lodhi Complex with UTR No.IDIBH18199162396, Dated: 18-07-2018 against the project FP/TG/WATER/18831/2016, which is reflected at the Ministry's portal. The State Government has (iv) proposed 4.158 Ha of non forest land for Compensatory under the Afforestation subject proposal as part of 187.677 ha of non forest land identified for entire TDWSP project (Mission Bhageeratha CA land Project).
