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It is submitted that the Director of Mines and Geology in the reference 1st cited, has forwarded the application for diversion of 10.72 ha of forest land in compartment no. 120, Turimerla RF, Venkatagiri Range, Nellore Division for grant of Quarry lease for Mica, Quartz & Feldspar in favour of M/s Mica Zone, Mg. partner: Sri G. Krishnam Raju.

While forwarding the application, the DMG has furnished the following information submitted by the applicant through Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Nellore.

- The applied minerals are not available other than forest area.
- The applied area is located at the Northern-Easter boundary area of R.F. land. To the North East of the applied area the applicant / proposed user agency have patta land at a distance of about 100 m from the mining proposed area. As such without causing disturbance of greenery, using existing cart track, the proposed area for mining is approachable.
- It is only the area proposed for mining in this forest block of Thurimerla RF, Maridpudi section which falls in Survey of India Topo Sheet no. 57/N/11.
- With the above information, the Director of Mines and Geology, A.P,

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Ibrahimpattanam has recommended for diversion of 10.72 ha of forest land in Sy. no. 466 of Thurimerla (V), Thurimerla RF of Sydapuram (M), SPSR Nellore for grant of quarry lease for Mica, Quartz & Feldspar in favour of M/s Mica Zone, Mg. Partner Sri G. Krishnam Raju.

Subsequently, in the reference 2nd cited, Sri G. Krishnam Raju, Mg. partner: M/s Mica Zone has uploaded proposals in the ministry's web portal for diversion of 10.72 ha of forest land in compartment no. 120, Thurimerla RF, Venkatagiri Range, Nellore Division for grant of Quarry lease for Mica, Quartz & Feldspar in favour of M/s Mica Zone, Mg. partner: Sri G. Krishnam Raju. The proposal is registered with unique No. FP/AP/QRY/146833/2021, dated: 06.09.2021.

Accordingly, the proposals were forwarded to the District Forest Officer, SPSR Nellore in the reference 3rd cited for processing as per the guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 through the Chief Conservator of Forests, Guntur. Subsequently, the Chief Conservator of Forests, Guntur, in the reference 4th cited, has submitted the proposals duly processed under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, which are as detailed below.

The user agency has furnished the following information in Part-I:

- The proposal is for diversion of 10.72 ha of forest land in compartment no. 120, Thurimerla RF, Venkatagiri Range, Nellore Division for grant of Quarry lease for Mica, Quartz & Feldspar in favour of M/s Mica Zone, Mg. Partner: Sri G. Krishnam Raju
- The user agency has furnished justification letter stating that, the application is filed primarily for grant of quarry lease for Mica, Quartz and Feldspar as the three minerals are associated mineral. In India, Mica is a rare mineral available only in three states i.e. Rajasthan, Bihar and Andhra Pradesh. Even in Andhra Pradesh good quality and size of Mica is very scarcely available in the Mica belt i.e. in Podalakur and Sydapuram Zone of Andhra Pradesh. The applied area falls within the pegmatite vein consisting of Mica, Quartz and Feldspar in Sydapuram Zone.

The other alternative prospecting areas of Mica, Quartz and Feldspar in and around Podalakur and Sydapuram Zones were examined extensively. However, good quality pegmatite vein for Mica, Quartz and Feldspar mining in this area / sector is more than a century old. Even the number of mining leases in Revenue and Reserved forest land for Mica has come down over a period due to limitations in mining after a certain depth and other challenges associated with mining. Consequently, the production of Mica has also come down considerably as fresh / new pegmatite vein areas are not available. In the light of the above, it is very much essential for grant of mining lease for Mica, Quartz and Feldspar in the interest of Mineral development and industrial requirements and there is no other alternative except to locate the project in the Forest area

- The user Agency has furnished the DGPS authenticated maps for the area proposed for diversion and CA land.
- Statement showing the details of forest area involved:

- The User Agency has submitted the certificate under RoFR Act, 2006, as required under F (C) Act, 1980 and also obtained no objection certificate from local bodies like Gram Sabha etc.
- The user agency has indicated the safety zone area for the proposed mining in the authenticated DGPS map. It is enclosed at Page No. 175 of the booklet.
- The User Agency has submitted undertakings to bear the cost of raising and maintenance of compensatory afforestation in identified CA land, payment of NPV, Additional NPV, Environment Clearance, Reclamation and Afforestation, cost of fencing and regeneration of safety zone area, cost of afforestation over one and half time of the safety zone area in degraded forest elsewhere, as and when the demand is raised by the Forest Department, if any.
- The User Agency has stated that, the proposed for mining lease is having earlier opened pits by old working lease namely by Sri P.V. Subba Reddy in sy. No. 466 for an extent of 43.320 ha. from 14.12.1962 to 13.12.1982 . Further, there are 18 working pits of about 1 to 3 m. Depth.

Now in this proposal it is proposed the same pits will be used for taking up of mining operations, as there is an availability of Mica of muscovite variety having green colour, Quartz is of glassy and granular variety having white colour and the feldspar is of soda Feldspar having white colour.

In this regard, the user agency has furnished an undertaking to reclaim all overburden dumps and the pits left by the erstwhile User Agency i.e. Sri P.V. Subba Reddy from 14.12.1962 to 13.12.1982

- The User Agency has identified non forest land for compensatory afforestation over an extent of 9.42 ha in Survey no.206 & 222 of Thummagunta village and Survey no.11 of Ekunampuram village, C.S. Puram mandal, Prakasam District.
- The User Agency has submitted that the employment likely to be generated due to this project is 15 permanent/ Regular employment and 93600 man days to be generated in the mining activity .
- The User Agency has certified that there is no violation occurred under provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
- The User Agency has furnished certificate on impact of the proposed Mica zone mining on the flora & Fauna in adjoining Reserve forests

The District Forest Officer, SPSR Nellore has furnished the information in Part-II as follows:

- The District Forest Officer has submitted an abstract of Enumeration of Tree growth and mentioned that 396 no. of trees are to be felled in the proposed area.
- The District Forest Officer, SPSR Nellore has inspected the forest area involved in the project proposal on 24.11.2021 and stated that, the proposed quarry lease is in old mined area which was not working for the past 40 years. The density of adjacent RF is 0.40. The area falls in Eco-

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Class IV (Tropical thorn forests) open scrub forest. Field Inspection report of the District Forest Officer , SPSR Nellore along with photographs is enclosed.

- The main Flora observed in the proposed area is Acacia leucocephala, Azadirachta indica, Tamaridus indica, Eucalyputs tereticornis etc. are noticed in the proposed area.
- The area proposed for diversion is not vulnerable to erosion.
- The area proposed for diversion does not forms part of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Corridor, Elephant Corridor etc.,
- No rare / endangered / unique species of flora and fauna found in and around the area proposed for diversion.
- No protected archaeological / heritage site/defense establishment or any other important monument is located in the area proposed for diversion.
- The requirement of the forest land is 10.72 ha as proposed by the User Agency is un-avoidable and barest minimum for the project
- The User Agency has not violated the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

The District Forest Officer, SPSR Nellore has **Recommended** the proposal in part-II.

The Chief Conservator of Forests, Guntur has not inspected the proposed area for diversion, as the area proposed for diversion is less than 40 ha.

The Chief Conservator of Forests, Guntur has agreed with the information given in Part-II by the District Forest Officer, SPSR Nellore and **Recommended** the proposal in Part-III.

As per para 2.3 of Chapter -2 of Comprehensive guidelines issued by the Gol, MoEF & CC, New Delhi in f. No. 5-2/2017-FC, dated: 28.03.2019, the User Agency has identified non-forest land over an extent of 9.42 ha in Survey no.206 & 222 of Thummagunta village and Survey no.11 of Ekunampuram village, C.S. Puram mandal, Prakasham District for compensatory Afforestation purpose.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Giddalur has inspected the non-forest land identified for Compensatory Afforestation on 24.11.2021. As per para 2.8 of Chapter -2 of Comprehensive guidelines issued by the Gol, MoEF & CC, New Delhi in f. No. 5-2/2017-FC, dated: 28.03.2019, the Divisional Forest Officer, Giddalur has prepared CA Scheme to an extent of 9.42 ha with a financial amount of ₹107.00 lakh for a period of 12 years which includes 10 years maintenance commencement from 2022-23 to 2033-34.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Giddalur has issued Land Suitability certificate stating that, the non-forest land to an extent of 9.42 ha identified in survey no.206 & 222 of Thummagunta village and survey no.11 of Ekunampuram village, C.S. Puram mandal, Prakasham District for raising of Compensatory Afforestation is in a compact block and contiguous to forest area and it is suitable for Raising of Compensatory Afforestation from the management and protection point of view.

The authenticated CA land map and Survey of India map in 1: 50,000 is

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enclosed herewith.

As per para 2.6 (ii) of comprehensive guidelines issued by the GoI, MoEF & CC, New Delhi in f. No. 5-2/2017-FC, dated: 28.03.2019, degraded forest land for afforestation measuring one and half time the area of forest land under safety zone has been identified to an extent of 2.10 ha in compartment no.120, Marlapudi Section, Chaganam Beat, Turmeral RF, SPSR Nellore District. The District Forest Officer, SPSR Nellore has prepared CA scheme with a financial outlay of ₹29.20 lakh for a period of 12 years from 2022-23 to 2033-34. Copy of the map along with CA Scheme is enclosed herewith.

The proposal has been uploaded in Ministry's web portal and unique no. FP/AP/QR/146833/2021 generated and the acknowledgement slip generated on the web portal is enclosed.

The Nodal Officer (FCA), Andhra Pradesh has agreed with the information given in Part -II and Part -III by the District Forest Officer, SPSR Nellore and the Chief Conservator of Forests, Guntur and Recommended the proposal in Part -IV.

In view of the above, the proposal for diversion of 10.72 ha of forest land in compartment no.120, Turimerla RF, Venkatagiri Range, Nellore Division for grant of Quarry lease for Mica, Quartz & Feldspar in favour of M/s Mica Zone, Mg. partner: Sri G. Krishnam Raju in (3) sets along with required information and maps duly recommending the proposal in Part-IV is submitted herewith.

The Government are requested to take necessary action for onward submission of the proposal to Government of India, MoEF & CC, IRO, Vijayawada to accord forest clearance under Section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and amendments therein.

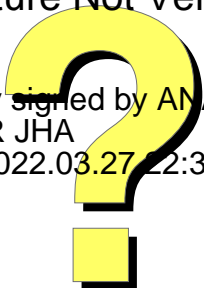

It is submitted that, the omissions as pointed out vide ref 2nd cited has been attended and revised afforestation plan is prepared to a tune of Rs. 27.00 lakhs. It is submitted that, the following information is enclosed herewith for favour of kind perusal.

1. The surveyed map of Safety zone area has been identified in degraded Turimerla RF and superimposed SI sheet with geo co ordinates in two sets are enclosed herewith.
2. As per authenticated map, the SZA area is 1.34 ha. which comes to 2.01 Ha. (one and half times). The surveyed area comes to 2.158 Ha. The afforestation plan is prepared for 2.10 Ha. For rounding of the area.
3. The soil suitability of the identified area is also enclosed in 2 sets.
4. The afforestation scheme is prepared to a tune of Rs. 27.00 lakhs. The year wise and component wise abstracts along with relevant data are enclosed herewith in 2 sets.

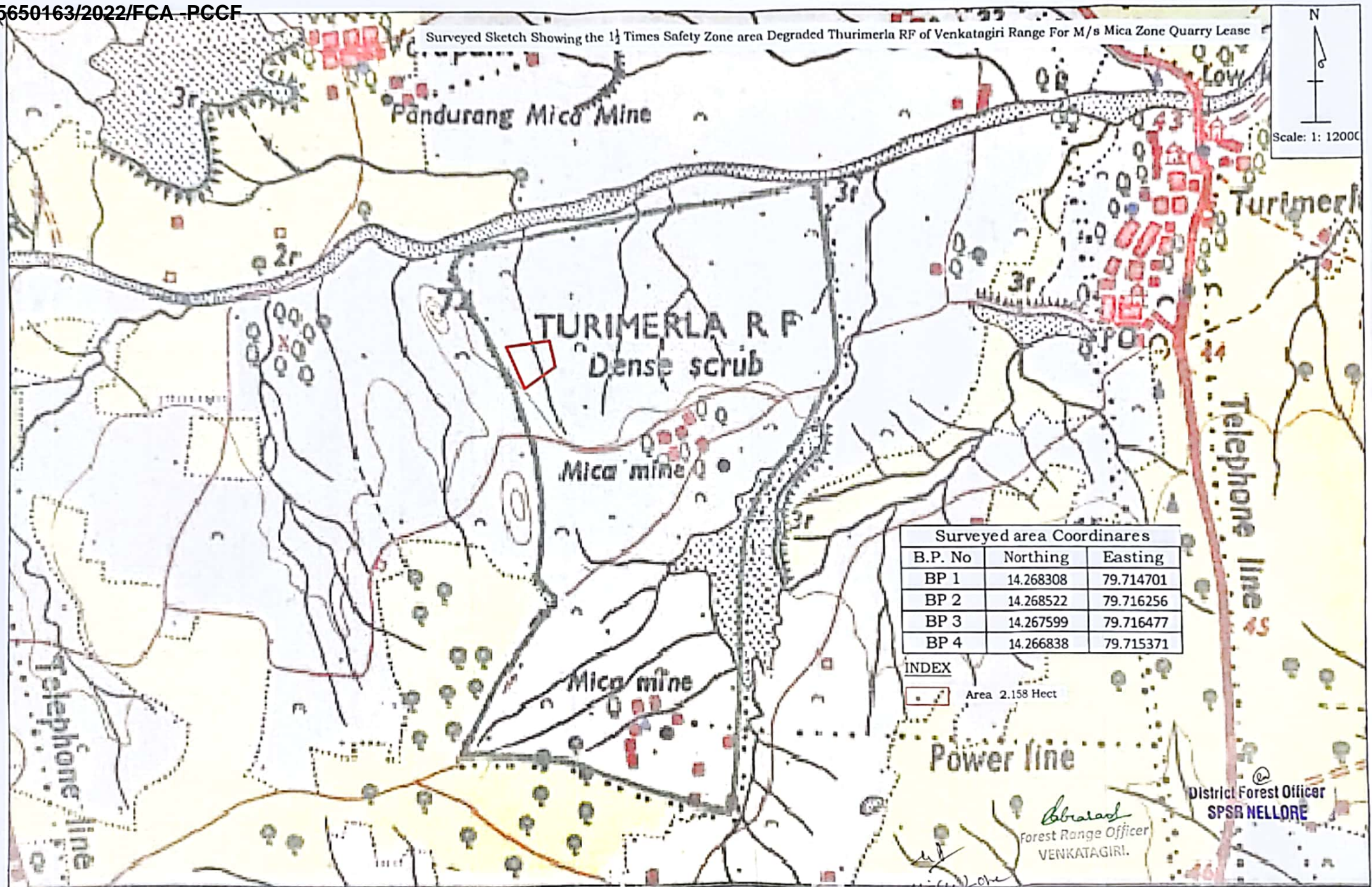

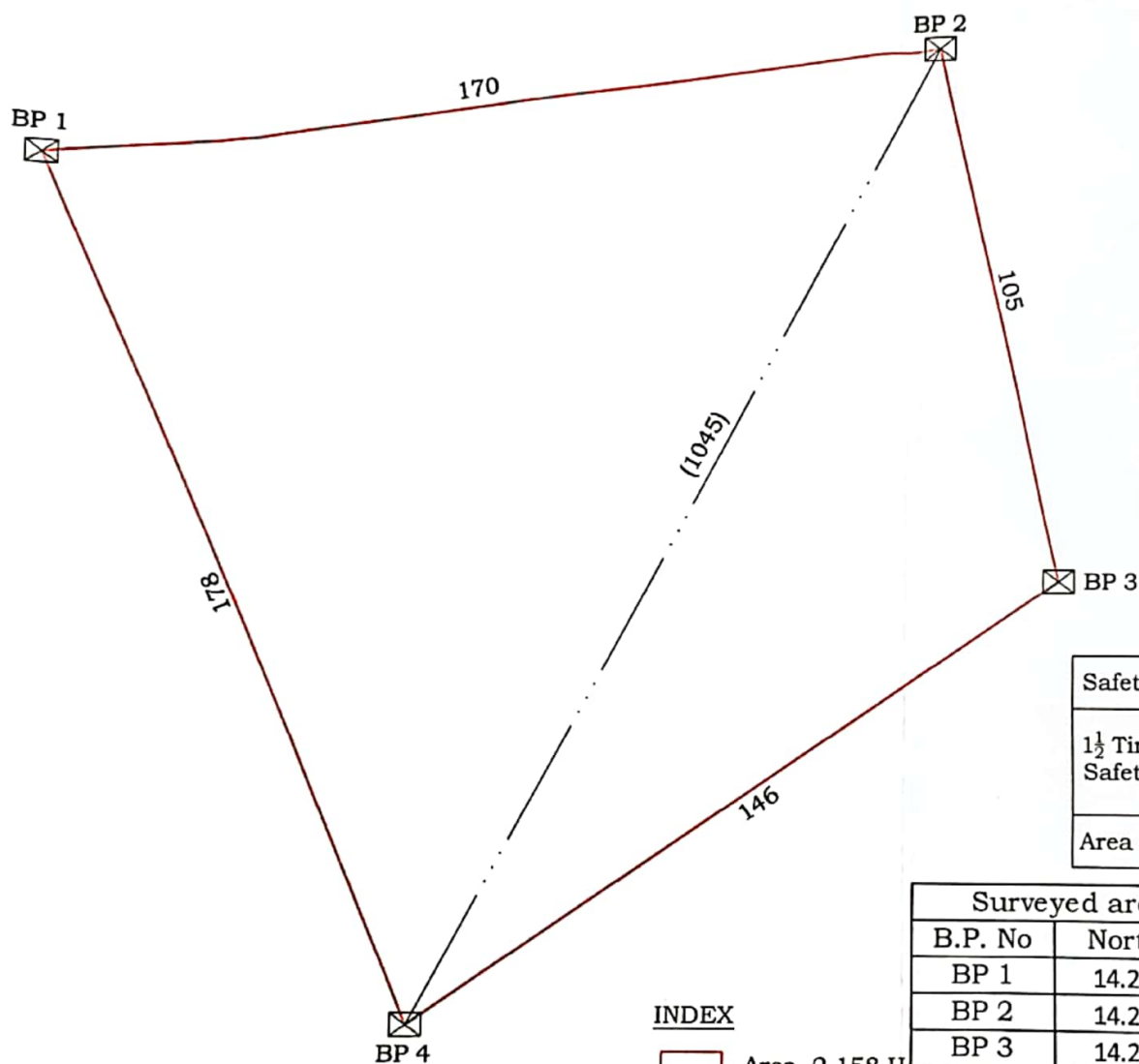


Surveyed Sketch Showing the $1\frac{1}{2}$ Times Safety Zone area Degraded Thurimerla RF of Venkatagiri Range
