2.00 The proposal has been initiated by the Shri. Sandip M. Khedekar Village Guruoli, Tal.Purandar, Dist. Pune in the State of Maharashtra for seeking approval under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for laying of underground pipeline for agricultural water supply in Village Guruoli, Tal.Purandar, Dist. Pune in the State of Maharashtra. The project can be demarcated on Survey of India Top sheet No. 47 J/3 and the forest area lies within Latitude N-18°24'08" and E-74°05.12". The total non forest involved in the project is 0.0800 ha. The site

inspection report of the Sub Divisional Officer, Bhor Forest Division, Bhor is enclosed on page no.38 to 41.

## 4.0 The Sub Divisional Officer, Bhor Forest Division, Bhor has certified that:-

- 4.1 no suitable alternate land is available and the forest land required is minimum.
- 4.2 the area belongs to Eco-value class-III and Density of forest is 0.01 (Open Forest)
- 4.3 there is no cutting and felling of trees is involved in the Project.
- 4.4 the area involved in the project does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Nature Reserve etc.
- 4.5 proposed project is not likely to affect any monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archeological or recreational importance.
- 4.6 there is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980.
- 4.7 the proposed area for the project is not within 10 km from the boundary Sanctuary and National Park.
- 4.8 the non-forest area covered under the project is not under the provision of Maharashtra Private Forest (Acquisition) Act 1975 by virtue of application of Section 35 of Indian Forest Act 1927 and are not recognized as deemed reserved forest as well as not included in the area identified as "forest" as per dictionary meaning of forest as intimated to the expert committee appointed under interim judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 12/12/1996.
- 4.9 and proposed Compensatory Afforestation over 0.50 ha. degraded Forest land in Gut No.1191 at Village Guroli, Tal. Purandar, Dist.Pune and it is contiguous, suitable for afforestation and management purpose and it is free from encroachment and an encumbrances.
- 4.10 The Sub Divisional Officer, Bhor Forest Division, Bhor has submitted the site specific justification to this office are as under:-
  - "The proposal recommended for acceptance as the proposed piece of land is open & barest minimum. There is no other alternative land available and the area is to be diverted is not sensitive and will not have any adverse effect on the ecology of the area. In the present case, the alignment has been decided only after considering such site factors. Hence the proposal is categories as "Site Specific"

## 5.0 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking that:-

- 5.1 to defray the cost of compensatory afforestation.
- 5.2 to defray the cost of Net Present Value of the forest land proposed under diversion.
- 5.3 Government of India vide letter No.11-43/2013-FC, dt.3/12/2018 has issued guidelines regarding compliance of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forests Right) Act, 2006. As per these guidelines:-

'Accordingly, it is clarified that within the time period stipulated for compliance of Stage I condition, Deputy Commissioner shall complete the process of compliance of FRA (including forwarding its findings to be concerned CF), hence for the purpose of the MoEF & CC, as per the provisions under the Forest (Conservation) amendment rules, 2016 the compliance under FRA is not required for consideration of in-principle approval. This has to be furnished by the State Government for consideration of the proposal by the Ministry for final approval'.

Hence, the user agency has given an undertaking regarding the compliance under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 has been applied and is under process and shall be submitted before formal approval.

Three alternatives have been examined in detail and have to come to conclusion that the alternative No. 1 (having 0.16 ha) is most suitable for forestry point of view, i.e. minimum area involved and there is no cutting/felling of trees.

- 6.00 The Sub Divisional Officer, Bhor Forest Division, Bhor and Conservator of Forest (T), Pune have recommended the proposal for diversion of 0.016 ha. of Reserved forest land.
  - 7.00 In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under the section -2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to the following conditions: –
  - 7.1 The legal status of the forest land required will remain unchanged.
  - 7.2 Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the User Agency.

## 7.3 Compensatory Afforestaton :-

- a) Compensatory afforstation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 0.50 ha. degraded Forest land in Gut No.1191 at Village Guroli, Tal. Purandar, Dist.Pune at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
- b) The non forest land which has been transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department.

7.4 The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.

### 7.5 NPV:-

- a) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 0.016 ha. forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in IA No.566 in WP (C) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II), dated 18/09/2003 as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC, dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007-FC, dated 05/02/2009 in this regard.
- b) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
- 7.6 User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
- 7.7 All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<a href="http://parivesh.nic.in/">http://parivesh.nic.in/</a>)
- 7.8 The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.
- 7.9 The pipeline shall be laid down 1.5 meter below the ground and after lying down of pipe line the ground will be leveled.
- 7.10 The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- 7.11 No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- 7.12 Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.

- 7.13 The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- 7.14 No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- 7.15 The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
- 7.16 The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Government of India.
- 7.17 Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guidelines F.No.11-42/2017-FC, dated 29/01/2018.
- 7.18 Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
- 7.19 The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/)
