

As per the said report, the proposed area consists mainly of Bevu, Kaggali, Huragalu and other Jungle kind species. The proposed forest area vegetation may be classified as of Eco class-4 (Open forest Class -4)</p> <p>The Forest land is required for the Establishment of 66 KV SC line on DC towers from existing 66/11 KV Harobele Sub-Station to proposed 66 KV Kunuru Sub-Station in Sathnuru Forest Range, Kanakapura Taluk, which is essential for public utility and the forest area required for the purpose is barest minimum and unavoidable. The provisions of Forest Conservation Act 1980 are not violated in this case as no work is carried out in the forest area.</p> <p>Hence recommended that the above proposal may be accepted for further needful action.</p>
